## 1. General regulation

1.1. This Regulation (hereinafter referred to as the Regulation) regulates the procedure for organizing and conducting the Tax Olympiad among students and young professionals (hereinafter referred to as the Olympiad).

1.2. The Olympiad is held within the framework of the Congress of Economists and Financiers of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter referred to as the EEYF). EEYF website's Internet address [www.eurasia-forum.ru](http://www.eurasia-forum.ru).

1.3. The organizer of the Olympiad:

Ural State University of Economics (USUE), Institute of Finance and Law, and Regional Center for Financial Literacy.

1.4. Olympiad Partners:

- LLC "Ural Business Support Center "Outsourcing";
- LLC "Constructive Partnership" with the support of the Chamber of Tax Consultants of Russia.

1.5. The purpose of the Olympiad is to increase the level of professional competencies of students and young professionals working in the tax field.

1.6. The main tasks of the Olympiad are:

- increasing the social significance of the profession;
- improving the effectiveness of professional skills in using the latest computer technologies of ConsultantPlus reference legal systems as a source of complete and reliable legal information;
- testing the abilities of young specialists to take systematic actions in a professional situation, analyze and design their activities;
- expanding the range of professional skills in the field of taxes and taxation;
- improvement of independent work skills and development of professional thinking;
- increasing responsibility for the work performed, developing the ability to independently and effectively solve problems in the field of professional activity, including tax consulting.

## 2. Conditions for participation in the Olympiad, registration of participants


2.1. The Olympiad is held among two groups of participants:

- the first group – students of educational organizations of higher professional education and students of educational organizations of secondary professional education studying in economic specialties;
- the second group consists of young professionals who have competence in the tax field, are not older than 30 years and have practical experience in the field of taxation.

2.2. Participation in the Olympiad is individual.

2.3. Applications for participation in the Olympiad are accepted through the registration system of the EEYF website (Appendix 1).

2.4. Applications for participation are submitted within the deadline specified on the Olympiad page of the EEYF website.

2.5. There is no registration fee for participation in the Olympiad. Expenses for accommodation of nonresident participants, food and transportation expenses for participation in the full-time stage of the Olympiad are paid by participants themselves, or by sending organizations.

### **3. Stages and dates of the Olympiad**

3.1. The Olympiad is an annual event and is held during the summer semester. Specific dates of the Olympiad, as well as its main stages, are set by the order of the Rector of the Ural State University of Economics (USUE).

3.2. The Olympiad is held in two stages.

3.2.1. The first stage is registration of participants and checking for compliance with the requirements for participants of the Olympiad (section 2 of these Regulations).

The first stage is held by the organizing committee of the Contest within the time limits set by the Directorate of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum and published on the SES website.

All participants who meet the conditions of Section 2 of the Regulations are allowed to participate in the face-to-face round of the Olympiad.

3.2.2. The second stage is held in person at USUE, where the winners and prize-winners of the Olympiad are determined for each group of participants.

### **4. The order of the Olympiad and criteria for evaluating participants ' work**

4.1. The Olympiad includes theoretical and practical tasks developed for each group of participants.

4.1.1. The work completion time is 2 and a half academic hours using the ConsultantPlus SPS.

4.1.2. Tasks consist of three parts:

Part One: It consists of 20 test tasks (questions). 1 point is awarded for each correct answer to the question.


Part two: consists of 1 calculation task; up to 10 points are awarded for the correct solution of the problem.

Part three: consists of resolving a dispute in the field of taxation; up to 20 points are awarded for resolving a dispute.

4.2. Based on the results of the evaluation of the work performed, the Olympiad expert commission draws up and approves the Olympiad protocol. The winners and prize-winners of the Olympiad are determined separately for each group of participants.

4.3. If the number of points scored by the participants of the Olympiad is equal, the decision to recognize the winners and prize-winners of the Olympiad is made at the discretion of the expert commission.

4.4. Special prizes in additional categories may be awarded by a separate decision of the expert commission.

## 5. Managing the Olympiad

5.1. The Olympiad is managed by the EEYF Directorate and the Olympiad Organizing Committee.

5.2. To organize and conduct the Olympiad, an Organizing Committee is formed, approved by the order of the USUE Rector. The Organizing Committee consists of:

- Chairman of the EEYF;
- Co-Chair of the EEYF;

Members of the Organizing committee:

- scientific supervisor of the Olympiad;
- coordinator(s) of the Olympiad;
- Chairman and members of the Olympiad expert Commission;
- representatives of partner organizations of the Olympiad,
- Secretary of the Olympiad.

5.3. The list of the Organizing Committee is published annually on the Olympiad page of the EEYF website.

5.4. The Organizing Committee provides general management of the organization and conduct of the Olympiad.

5.4.1. Chairman of the Organizing Committee:

- approves the Regulations on the Olympiad, signs the order on the conduct of the Olympiad and the composition of the Organizing committee of the Olympiad, the order on the composition of the expert commission;

- provides general management of the organization and conduct of EEYF events, within the framework of which the Olympiad is held.

5.4.2. Co-Chairman of the Organizing Committee:

- directly manages the organization and conduct of the EEYF, together with the academic supervisor of the Olympiad, forms the composition of the expert commission of the Olympiad.

5.4.3. An expert commission is created to conduct an expert assessment of participants.

The Chairman of the Olympiad Expert Committee is the Director of the SES Congress of Financiers. The expert commission consists of highly qualified representatives of the educational, scientific and business community; representatives of the Chamber of Tax Consultants of Russia and the Public Council of the Federal Tax Service of Russia for the Sverdlovsk region. More than half of the members of the expert commission must be representatives of third-party organizations.

The expert commission develops the content of competitive tasks.

Decisions of the expert commission are recorded and signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendix 2).

5.4.4. Academic Supervisor of the Olympiad:

- prepares a draft Regulation on the Olympiad and submits it to the rector for approval, prepares amendments and additions to it;


- Co-chairs the expert commission of the Olympiad;

- selects the composition of the Olympiad expert commission;

- approves tasks for participants of the Olympiad from the chairman of the expert commission.

5.4.5. Olympiad Coordinator(s):

- ensures the invitation of members of the Olympiad expert commission;

- organizes the distribution of informational letters to educational, research and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and foreign countries;
- organizes the final and the work of the expert commission during the final of the Olympiad;
- organizes registration of diplomas and awarding of winners and prize-winners of the Olympiad;
- prepares a report on the conduct of the Olympiad.

## **6. Awarding of winners**

6.1. Summing up the results and awarding is carried out separately for each group of participants:

6.1.1. Winners and prize-winners of the first group of participants (students) are awarded with Diplomas of I, II, III degrees and orders for 1,2, and 3 places, respectively. Winners and prize-winners of this group also receive cash prizes within the framework of the Olympiad prize fund established by the order of the USUE Rector.

Cash prizes (including income tax) are transferred by the organizer To the personal accounts of the winners and prize-winners within 1.5 months according to the details provided to the coordinator of the Olympiad.

Winners and prize-winners of the second group of participants (young specialists) are awarded with Diplomas of I, II, III degrees and valuable prizes from the partners of the Olympiad.
