1. General regulations

1.1 This Regulation (hereinafter referred to as the Regulation) regulates the procedure for organizing and conducting an international competition of research papers in foreign languages (English or Spanish) among young scientists and students "Socio-cultural ties as the basis of trust in the economy" (hereinafter referred to as the Competition).

1.2 The competition is held within the framework of the Congress of Economists and Financiers of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter EEFM). The Internet address of the EEFM website www.eurasia-forum.ru

1.3 Organizer of the Competition:

Ural State University of Economics (USUE); Department of Business Foreign Language.

1.4 The organizers of the Contest:

Universities are the organizers of foreign and regional EEFM sites that have chosen this competition for implementation on their sites. The list of foreign and regional sites that have chosen this Competition is indicated on the Competition page of the Congress of Economists and Financiers of the EEFM website, as well as on the foreign/regional Sites of the EEFM website themselves

1.5 The Partner of the Competition is the University of Siego de Avila, Cuba (Universidad "Máximo Gómez Báez" de Ciego de Ávila).

1.6 The purpose of the Competition is to identify and develop the participants' creative abilities and interest in research activities in the field of culture and its place in the national economy, to promote scientific knowledge and substantiate the importance of socio-cultural ties as a qualitative factor in the economic development of countries and regions, as well as to motivate young people to innovative development aimed at using the results of cultural and creative activities of people in the development of economic ties.

2. Scientific directions of the Competition

Works in foreign languages (English or Spanish) in two scientific areas are accepted for the Competition:

- 1) Historical and cultural ties as a tool for improving mutual understanding and developing economic cooperation.
- 2) The influence of Russian culture on the socio-economic development of countries and regions.

3. Conditions of participation in the Competition

3.1 Students, undergraduates, postgraduates, young scientists of educational organizations, academic institutes and other interested organizations of Russia and foreign countries under the age of 35 are invited to participate in the Competition (hereinafter referred to as Participants).

Works prepared by young scientists - candidates of sciences are not accepted for the competition.

3.2 Completed works in foreign languages (English or Spanish), made individually and in a team of two people, are submitted to the competition.

3.3. One participant/team has the right to submit only one work to the Competition.

3.4. The authors independently make a decision on which scientific direction the work will be presented.

3.5. The works of participants who do not meet these requirements will not be accepted for participation in the Competition.

3.6. There is no registration fee for participation in the competition. The costs of accommodation

of nonresident participants, meals and transportation costs for participation in the full-time stage of the competition are paid by the participants themselves, or by sending organizations.

4. Stages and terms of the Competition

4.1 The competition is an annual event and is held during the summer semester. The final dates of the Competition, as well as its main stages, are established by the order of the Rector of the Ural State University of Economics».

4.2 The competition is held in three stages.

4.2.1. The first stage is the acceptance and registration of competitive research works in the chosen direction of the Competition; verification of works for compliance with the requirements put forward for works in section 5 of the Regulations.

The first stage is held by the organizing committee of the Competition within the time limits set by the Directorate of the Eurasian Economic Forum of Youth.

4.2.2. The second stage is (qualifying) examination of competitive research works registered and admitted to the Competition based on the results of the first stage; determination of the finalists of the Competition.

The second stage, the examination of competitive works, is carried out by the expert commission of the Competition. Lists of Participants who have passed to the final of the Competition are formed. The lists of finalists are published on the Competition page of the EEFM website.

4.2.3. The third stage is the (final) defense and presentation of the finalists' competitive research papers; determination of the winners of the Competition.

The third stage is held between the finalists of the Competition by public defense of the competitive works.

4.3 Following the results of the Competition, a collection of abstracts of the finalists' works is published. The collection is published in the form of the corresponding chapter of the annual collection of EEFM materials no later than 3 months after the Competition. The collection of EEFM materials is posted on the EEFM website.

5. Requirements for submitted documentation and rules for registration of competitive works

5.1 Research papers and projects are submitted to the Competition in the following scientific areas:

1) Historical and cultural ties as a tool for improving mutual understanding and developing economic cooperation.

2) The influence of Russian culture on the socio-economic development of countries and regions.

5.2 Entries must be submitted in English or Spanish.

The works are submitted to the Organizing Committee of the Competition in electronic form through a special registration form on the EEFM website www.eurasia-forum.ru.

5.3 To participate in the Competition, the following set of documents must be submitted:

1) the author's application for participation in the Competition (Appendix 1) is submitted by filling out the participant's registration form on the EEFM website.

2) the text of the work with the title page (appendix 2) - attached as an independent file to the registration form of the participant;



3) abstracts of the work reflecting the main provisions and results of the work - attached as an independent file to the registration form of the participant.

5.4 The competitive work must meet the following requirements:

- 1) the work must be submitted within the deadlines set by the Rector of USUE and published on the EEFM website;
- 2) the work must correspond to the subject of the competition and its scientific directions;
- 3) it is necessary to have reference material: references to sources from which quotations are used, numerical data in the text, tables, graphs, diagrams, references (at least 15 sources);
- 4) scientific work must be author's, the percentage of originality of the text is not less than 60%;
- 5) abstracts of the work should be attached to the scientific work.

The work should be designed as follows: a file in the format *.doc or *.rtf, the name of the file should indicate the surname of the author (s). Font Times New Roman, size - 14 pt, line spacing 1.5. All margins are 20 mm. The text is aligned in width without hyphenation. All charts and tables should be inserted into the text. Paragraph indentation – 1.25. The orientation of the sheet is bookish. Volume of work: 15-20 pages.

The list of references is drawn up in accordance with GOST 7.1-2003. Footnotes on the text are given in square brackets indicating the number of the source in the list of references.

Typical structure of the work: introduction; main part; conclusion and list of references.

Abstracts reflecting the general idea of the work should be prepared for each research work. Abstracts should be designed as follows: 1.5 line spacing on A4 sheets, Times New Roman font, size - 14 pt, margins - 20 mm on each side. The volume of abstracts is no more than 3 pages. Abstracts must be submitted in the same language as the competition paper.

6. Competition Management

6.1 The Competition is managed by the Directorate of the EEFM and the Organizing Committee of the Competition.

6.2 To organize and conduct the competition, an organizing committee is formed, approved by the order of the rector of USUE. The organizing committee consists of:

- Chairman - Rector of USUE;
- co-chairs - Vice-Rector for Social Work of USUE, Vice-Rector for Scientific Work of USUE;
- members of the organizing committee:
 - scientific supervisor of the Competition - teacher of the Department of Business Foreign Language of USUE;
 - coordinator of the Competition - teacher of the Department of Business Foreign Language of USUE;
 - chairman and members of the expert commission of the Competition;
 - representatives of partner organizations of the Competition;
 - secretaries of the Competition - employees of the department-organizer of the Competition.

6.3 The Organizing Committee provides general management of the organization and conduct of the Competition, as well as performs the following functions:

- mailing of information letters to universities and organizations of the Russian Federation and other countries, no later than three months before the final stage;
- acceptance and organization of processing of scientific papers, as well as registration of mandatory



and additional documentation of participants - no later than 15 days before the start of the final, third, stage of the Competition;

- examination of scientific works by the expert commission within the second stage, no later than 10 days before the start of the final, third, stage of the Competition;
- sending informational letters to educational and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and other countries notifying young scientists and students of the third round of the Competition;
- formation and publication of the Competition program and/or the EEFM program with information about the Competition–
- holding of the third stage (final) Competition;
- awarding of winners;
- formation and transfer to the USUE Publishing House of the collection of abstracts of the finalists of the Competition. The collection of EEFM materials is posted on the EEFM website.

6.3.1 Chairman of the Organizing Committee:

- approves the Regulations on the Competition, signs the order on the conduct of the Competition and the composition of the organizing committee of the Competition;
- provides general management of the organization and conduct of the events of the Competition.

6.3.2 Co-Chairman of the Organizing Committee:

- directly manages the organization and conduct of the EEFM, within which the Competition is held, is the chairman of the expert commission of the Competition, together with the scientific director of the Competition, form the composition of the expert commission of the Competition.

6.3.3 The expert commission of the Competition consists of highly qualified teachers, leading scientists and specialists from the organizers of the EEFM, the Competition, as well as invited experts from universities, academic institutes, other organizations and institutions. The number of members of the expert commission is from 5 to 7 people, most of them are representatives of third-party organizations. The members of the expert commission are published on the Competition page of the EEFM website.

6.3.4 Scientific director of the Competition:

- prepares draft Regulations on the Competition and submits it to the rector for approval, prepares amendments and additions to it;
- is the chairman (co-chairman) of the expert commission of the Competition;
- selects the composition of the expert commission of the Competition;

6.3.5 Competition Coordinator:

- provides an invitation to the members of the expert commission of the Competition;
- sends out informational letters to universities of the Russian Federation and Eurasian countries–
- organizes registration and verification of received works according to the established requirements, sends the work to members of the expert commission for evaluation;
- organizes and monitors the progress of the Competition;
- organizes the work of the section and the work of the expert commission during the third stage of the Competition;
- organizes the registration of diplomas and awarding of winners and prize-winners of the Competition;
- organizes the collection of abstracts of the finalists of the Competition and their transfer to the USUE Publishing House for inclusion in the collection of EEFM materials;
- draws up a report on the conduct of the Competition.

7 Procedure and criteria for evaluating works

7.1 The Organizing Committee selects projects for further expert evaluation according to the requirements specified in Section 5 of the Regulations.



An expert commission of the Competition is created to conduct an expert evaluation of the works. All decisions of the expert commission are recorded and signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendix 3, 4).

During the second (qualifying) stage, the expert commission of the Competition conducts an examination of the participants' research projects and determines up to 20 (twenty) finalists of the Competition, including up to five finalists from each foreign/regional site of the Competition.

The lists of finalists are posted on the Contest page. Informational letters about reaching the finals are sent to the finalists. If the finalist for any reason cannot take part in the final in person, according to the decision of the organizing committee of the Competition, he may be allowed to take part online.

Criteria for evaluating competitive works at the second (qualifying) stage:

- 1) registration of the work – up to 10 points;
- 2) relevance of the research topic – up to 15 points;
- 3) novelty and originality of the research – up to 15 points;
- 4) the content of the study: consistency, scientific style and literacy of presentation; validity of conclusions; availability of appendices, illustrations, graphic explanations of appropriate quality – up to 40 points;
- 5) practical significance of the research results – 20 points.

7.2 During the third (final) stage, the members of the expert commission fill out an expert list for each finalist of the Competition.

Criteria for evaluating participants during the face-to-face defense of the work at the third (final) stage:

- 1) relevance of the research topic – up to 20 points;
- 2) novelty and originality of the research – up to 20 points;
- 3) the practical significance of the study and the validity of the conclusions – up to 20 points;
- 4) the skills of the speaker (the ability to vividly and interestingly present the results of the study, to argue their own position) – up to 20 points;
- 5) presentation performance quality (structure, design, slide content) - up to 20 points.

Ability to answer questions, competently and correctly conduct a scientific discussion (additional points) – up to 30 points.

8. Awarding of winners

8.1 According to the results of the face-to-face defense, the winners and prize-winners of the Competition are determined, they are awarded Diplomas of I, II, III degrees and orders for 1,2, and 3rd place, respectively.

All participants of the third stage - public protection of projects - receive certificates of finalists of the Competition.

8.2 The winners and prize-winners of the Competition are awarded with cash prizes within the prize fund of the Competition, established on the basis of the order of the Rector of USUE and in accordance with the protocol of the expert commission of the Competition.

Cash prizes (including payment of income tax) are transferred by the founder of the Competition within 1.5 months to the personal accounts of the winners and prize-winners according to the details provided to the coordinator of the Competition, as well as upon timely provision of copies of other requested documents. Cash prizes for foreign participants are given out at the USUE cash desk on the day of the award.
