1. General provisions

- 1.1. This Regulation (hereinafter referred to as the Regulation) regulates the procedure for organizing and conducting an international competition of research works of young scientists and students "Logistical and commercial challenges in the conditions of creation multipolar reality" (hereinafter referred to as the Competition).
- 1.2. The competition is held within the framework of the Congress of Entrepreneurship and Engineering of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter EEYF). Internet address of the EEYF website www.eurasia-forum.ru
 - 1.3. Contest Organizer:

FSBEI HE "Ural State University of Economics" (USUE), Department of Logistics and Commerce.

1.4. Organizers of the Competition:

Universities-organizers of foreign and regional EEYF sites that have chosen this competition for implementation on their sites. The list of foreign and regional sites that have chosen this Competition is indicated on the Competition page of the Congress of Entrepreneurship and Engineering of the EEYF website, as well as on the foreign/regional Sites of the EEYF website themselves

- 1.5. Competition Partners:
- Institute of Economics of the Ural Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences (Institute of Economics of the Ural Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences),
 - Ural Branch of the Free Economic Society of Russia.
- 1.6. The purpose of the competition is to intensify research work in higher educational institutions, to develop a forecast and recommendations for the development and interstate regulation of the logistics of goods distribution at the global and national level.

2. Scientific directions of the Competition

Research papers are submitted to the Competition in the following scientific areas:

- 1) Introduction of innovative technologies into the commercial and logistics activities of the enterprise;
- 2) Changing logistics corridors in order to develop parallel imports in the conditions of creating a multipolar world;
 - 3) The use of outsourcing and outstaffing of logistics services in a new reality;
 - 4) Development of online sales within the country and abroad

3. Terms of participation in the Contest

3.1. Students, graduate students, young researchers from educational institutions, academic institutions in Russia and foreign countries, as well as employees of other interested organizations aged 18 to 35 are invited to participate in the Competition.

Works prepared by young scientists - candidates of sciences, are not accepted for the competition.

- 3.2. Finished works made individually are submitted to the competition.
- 3.3. One participant has the right to submit only one work to the Competition.

- 3.4. The author independently decides in which scientific direction the work will be presented.
- 3.5. The works of participants that do not meet the requirements of section 5 of these Regulations are not accepted for participation in the competition.
- 3.6. There is no registration fee for participation in the competition. Expenses for accommodation of non-resident participants, food and transportation costs for participation in the full-time stage of the competition are paid by the participants themselves, or by sending organizations.

4. Stages and terms of the Competition

- 4.1. The competition is an annual event and takes place during the summer semester. The final dates for the Competition, as well as its main stages, are established by the order of the rector of the Ural State University of Economics.
 - 4.2. The competition is held in three stages.
- 4.2.1. The first stage is the acceptance and registration of competitive research works in the chosen direction (section) of the Competition; verification of work for compliance with the requirements put forward for work.

The first stage is carried out by the Organizing Committee of the Competition within the time limits set by the Directorate of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum.

4.2.2. The second stage - (qualifying) examination of competitive research papers registered and admitted to the Competition based on the results of the first stage; determination of the finalists of the Competition.

Examination of competitive works is carried out by the expert commission of the Competition. Lists of Participants who have passed to the final of the Contest are being formed. Lists of finalists are published on the Competition page of the EEYF website.

- 4.2.3. The third stage is the (final) defense and presentation of competitive research papers of the finalists; determination of winners and prize-winners of the Contest.
- 4.3. Based on the results of the Competition, a collection of abstracts of the finalists' works is published. The collection is published in the form of the corresponding chapter of the annual collection of EEYF materials no later than 3 months after the Competition. The EEYF collection of materials is posted in the RSCI, on the USUE website and on the EEYF website.

5. Requirements for the submitted documentation and rules for registration of competitive works

- 5.1. Works are submitted to the Organizing Committee of the Competition in electronic form through a special registration form on the EEYF website www.eurasia-forum.ru.
 - 5.2. To participate in the Competition, the following package of documents must be submitted:
- 1) the author's application for participation in the Competition (Appendix 1) submitted by filling out the registration form of the participant on the EEYF website;

For the participants of the Competition, representatives of foreign/regional sites, the application is registered by first choosing the name of the foreign/regional EEYF site;

2) competitive work (with a title page, according to Appendix 2) - attached as a separate file to the participant's registration form;

- 3) abstracts of the work, reflecting the main provisions and results of the work attached as the second file to the registration form of the participant.
- 5.3. All documents are submitted as a single package within the time period specified on the EEYF website.

The absence of any of the documents specified in clause 5.2 within the prescribed period means refusal to participate in the Contest.

- 5.4. The competition work must meet the following requirements:
- 1) the work must correspond to the subject of the competition and its scientific areas specified in section 2 of the Regulations;
 - 2) scientific work must be author's, the percentage of originality of the text is not less than 60%
- 3) it is necessary to have reference material: links to sources from which quotes are used, figures in the text, tables, graphs, diagrams,
- 4) the work must be formatted as follows: file in *.doc or *.rtf format, the name of the author(s) must be indicated in the file name. Font Times New Roman, size 14 pt, line spacing 1.5. All margins are 20 mm. The text is justified in width without hyphenation. All charts and tables must be inserted into the text. Paragraph indent 1.25. Sheet orientation is portrait. Volume of work: 20 25 pages.

Typical structure of work: introduction; three chapters (theoretical, analytical, recommendatory); conclusion and list of used literature.

- 5) the list of literature is drawn up in accordance with GOST R 7.0.100-2018. The list of references should consist of at least 10 sources. Footnotes to the text are given in square brackets, indicating the number of the source in the list of references.
- 5.5. Abstracts reflecting the general idea of the work should be drawn up for the research work. Abstracts should be formatted as follows: line spacing 1.5 on A4 sheets, Times New Roman font, size 14 pt, margins 20 mm on each side. The volume of abstracts is no more than 3 pages. The originality of abstracts is at least 70%.

6. Procedure and criteria for evaluating work

- 6.1. At the first stage of the Competition, the Organizing Committee admits projects for further expert evaluation according to the requirements specified in Section 5 of the Regulations.
- 6.2. During the second (qualifying) stage, the members of the expert commission conduct an examination of the research projects of the participants and determine 15 (fifteen) finalists of the Competition.

Criteria for evaluating competitive works at the second (qualifying) stage:

- 1) design of work ¬– up to 10 points;
- 2) the relevance of the research topic up to 15 points;
- 3) novelty and originality of the research up to 15 points;
- 4) content of the study: scientific, technical and economic feasibility of the proposed solutions; logic, scientific style and literacy of presentation; the presence of applications, illustrations, graphic explanations of appropriate quality up to 40 points;
- 5) the practical significance of the research results, the possibility of testing and implementing the results obtained 20 points.

Lists of finalists are published on the Competition page. Information letters about reaching the finals are sent to the finalists. If the finalist cannot personally take part in the final of the Competition, he is given the opportunity to publicly defend the project remotely, in the form of a webinar. If the finalist cannot take part in the final of the Competition remotely, the participant who took 16th place according to the results of the second (qualifying) stage of the Competition is included in the list of finalists.

- 6.3. Criteria for evaluating participants during full-time defense of work at the third (final) stage:
- 1) the relevance of the research topic up to 15 points;
- 2) novelty and originality of the research up to 15 points;
- 3) the significance of the results of the study up to 20 points;
- 4) presentation up to 20 points;
- 5) defense (answers to experts' questions) up to 30 points.
- 6.4. Priority in the form of additional points (up to 10 points) is given to competitive works completed in the areas of the Competition within the framework of the annual theme of the EEYF.
- 6.5. If the winners and prize-winners of the Competition have the same number of points (equal), the decision to determine the winners and prize-winners remains with the expert commission of the Competition.

7. Contest Management

- 7.1. The Competition is managed by the EEYF Directorate and the Organizing Committee of the Competition.
- 7.2. To organize and conduct the competition, an Organizing Committee is formed, approved by the order of the rector of USUE. The Organizing Committee consists of:
 - Chairman of the EEYF Organizing Committee;
 - co-chairman of the organizing committee of the EEYF;
 - scientific supervisor of the Competition;
 - coordinator(s) of the Competition;
 - Chairman and members of the expert commission of the Contest;
 - representatives of organizations partners of the Competition,
 - Contest secretary
- 7.3. The Organizing Committee carries out general management of the organization and conduct of the Competition.
 - 7.3.1. Chairman of the Organizing Committee:
- approves the Regulations on the Competition, signs the order on holding the Competition and the composition of the Organizing Committee of the Competition, the order on the composition of the expert commission;
- carries out general management of the organization and conduct of EEYF events, within the framework of which the Competition is held.
 - 7.3.2. Organizing committee co-chair:
- carries out direct management of the organization and conduct of the EEYF, together with the scientific supervisor of the Competition, forms the composition of the expert commission of the Competition.
- 7.3.3. An expert commission is created to conduct an expert evaluation of competitive works.

The chairman of the expert commission is the director of the EEYF Congress, in which the competition takes place. The expert commission includes highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers, leading specialists from among the organizers of the EEYF, as well as invited experts. More than half of the members of the expert commission must be representatives of outside organizations. The decisions of the expert commission are recorded, the protocols are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendices 3, 4).

- 7.3.4. Scientific Supervisor of the Competition:
- prepares a draft Regulation on the Competition, prepares amendments and additions to it;
- − is a co-chairman of the expert commission of the Contest;
- selects the composition of the expert commission of the Contest.
- 7.3.5. Contest Coordinator:
- ensures the invitation of members of the expert commission of the Contest;
- organizes the distribution of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and Eurasian countries;
- organizes the registration and verification of the compliance of the received competitive documents with the established requirements, sends the competitive works to the members of the expert commission for evaluation;
 - organizes and controls the course of the Contest;
- organizes the final and the work of the expert commission during the third stage of the
 Competition;
- organizes the issuance of diplomas and the awarding of winners and prize-winners of the Competition;
- organizes the collection of abstracts of the competitive works of the finalists of the
 Competition and their transfer to the USUE Publishing House for inclusion in the collection of materials of the EEYF;
- organizes the collection of documents necessary for the transfer of cash prizes to the winners and prize-winners of the Contest;
 - draws up a report on the Competition.
- 7.4. Information on the composition of the organizing committee and the expert commission of the Competition is published annually on the Competition page of the EEYF website.

8. Awarding of winners

8.1. Based on the results of full-time defense, the winners and prize-winners of the Competition are determined, they are awarded with Diplomas of I, II, III degrees and orders for 1, 2, and 3 places, respectively.

Participants who take 4th and 5th places in the Competition are awarded with Diplomas for 4th and 5th places, respectively. All participants of the third stage - public defense of projects - receive certificates of finalists of the Competition.

8.2. The winners and prize-winners of the Competition are awarded with cash prizes within the prize fund of the Competition, established on the basis of the order of the rector of USUE and in accordance with the protocol of the expert commission of the Competition.

Cash prizes (including income tax) are transferred by the founder of the Contest within 1.5 months to the personal accounts of the winners and prize-winners according to the details provided to the Contest coordinator, as well as upon timely provision of copies of other requested documents. Cash prizes for foreign participants are issued at the USUE box office on the award day.
