1. General provisions

1.1. These Regulations governs the general procedure for organizing and holding of international intellectual and entertaining game "Intellect of Eurasia" (hereinafter referred to as the Game).

1.2. The intellectual and entertaining game "Intellect of Eurasia" is held within the framework of the Congress of Schoolchildren of the XIII Eurasian Economic Youth Forum "A multipolar world in the focus of new reality."

1.3. The Game is organized by Ural State University of Economics, the Fund for Supporting Talented Children of Youth "Golden Section", Yekaterinburg.

2. Aims and objectives

- 2.1. The aim of the Game is to do the groundwork for motivation among high-school students to cognitive and creative activities in various fields of knowledge; to provide support to talented youth in their social and professional self-determination.
- 2.2. The development of intellectual thinking among students of general education institutions.
- 2.3. Development of new forms of social partnership of general education institutions.
- 2.4. Attracting attention of general public, all interested persons and organizations to the issues of international cooperation in the field of education.

3. Registration of participants

3.1. From 1 st of February to 1 st of April 2023, participants should send an application for participation in the Game.

3.2. All team members must personally register on the official website of the Forum www.eurasia-forum.ru for Congress of Schoolchildren. When registering, one must specify the competition (Game).

3.3. Participants are invited to take part in the qualifying round.

4. Procedure for Game organizing and holding

- 4.1. Game topic: "Russia and regions of the world"
- 4.2. The Game participants are students in grades 9-11.
- 4.3. A team consists of 5 persons.
- 4.4. The Game includes 2 stages:

Stage 1. QUALIFYING ROUND.

For teams from the Russian Federation and the CIS countries is held until 15 April 2023.

The qualifying round is held as an individual «Svoya Igra» game. Pupils of one or several grades of the same school take part in the individual game. One can participate in an individual game only once. The game lasts 45 minutes. For each correct answer, a participant gains points corresponding to the value of the question. The game participants with the most points (5 persons) are formed into a team and are invited to participate in the Final. The points scored by the participants are summed up and make up the total number of points for the team.

Stage 2. FINAL (27 April 2023 at 12.00, in house of culture of USUE, Yekaterinburg, Russia) - the final round is held as a team «Svoya Igra» game. The total number of teams in the Final is up to 6 teams with the most points in the qualifying round. Each team consists of 5 members. The task of the teams is to score the most points in the Final.

All teams play in turn; the team with the lowest number of points gained in the qualifying round starts the game. The team selects a question from a list of valued questions. After reading the question, the team gets one minute to think. The answer is presented by pressing the button on the game table. The countdown is carried out automatically on the general screen and begins immediately after the host finishes reading a question. In case of a correct answer, the number of points for the team increases, in case of an incorrect answer, the number of points decreases by the value of the question and the right to answer passes to other teams and is presented by pressing the button on the table.

- 4.5. The host also performs the functions of a judge. The host considers any disputable issues that arise during the Game. As a rule, the host makes decisions based on his knowledge and experience in controversial and complex situations. He has the right to apply to the Expert Commission. The host, together with the Expert Commission, makes the final decision whether the team's answer was correct or not, as well as on the classification of slipups and other minor inaccuracies in answers. The host and members of the Expert Commission should avoid prompting the players, for example, in tone, comments, etc.
 - 4.6. The Game is supervised by the Expert Commission.
- 4.7. The Expert Commission is formed from among the experts of the Congress of Schoolchildren and guests of the XIII Eurasian Economic Youth Forum.

5. Awarding of winners

- 5.1. All participants of the competition are awarded participation certificates.
- 5.2. Participating students in grade 11 will receive certificates of laureates of the XIII EEYF.
- 5.3. Awards of participants will bring additional points for individual achievements to the Unified State Examination when applying for admission to study at USUE bachelor's programs.
- 5.4. Based on the results of the final game, the winner team is determined which takes first place, and the runners-up, who take second and third places.. The

winner and runners-up of the Game are awarded diplomas of I, II, and III degree and special prizes.
