1. General regulations

1.1. This Regulation (hereinafter referred to as the Regulation) regulates the procedure for organizing and holding the International Essay Competition for Young Scientists and Students «Modern Trends in the Economic Development of the World» (hereinafter referred to as the Competition).

1.2. The competition is held within the framework of **the Congress of Strategists** of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter referred to as the EEYF). Internet address of the EEYF website www.eurasia-forum.ru

1.3. Organizer of the Competition: Ural State University of Economics, Institute of Continuous and Distance Education.

1.4. Organizers of the Competition:

Universities-organizers of foreign and regional EEYF sites that have chosen this competition for implementation on their sites. The list of foreign and regional sites that have chosen this Competition is indicated on the Competition page of the Congress of Economists and Financiers of the EEYF website, as well as on the foreign/regional Sites of the EEYF website themselves.

1.5. The purpose of the competition is to create a platform for young scientists and specialists, which provides an opportunity to discuss the problems of improving the quality of training of specialists, increasing the interest of young scientists and students in their chosen profession, identifying gifted youth and building human resources for research, administrative, industrial and entrepreneurial activities.

2. Participants of Competition

2.1. Students of colleges, technical schools, higher educational institutions, graduate students, applicants for the degree of Candidate of Science, young researchers from universities, academic institutions of Russia and the CIS countries, as well as employees of other interested organizations aged 18 to 35 are invited to participate in the Competition.

Essays prepared by young scientists - candidates of sciences, are not accepted for the Competition.

2.2. Individual essays are accepted for the Competition. Essays written by a team of authors are not allowed to participate in the Competition.

2.3. One participant submits only one essay to the Competition.


2.4. There is no registration fee for participation in the Competition. Expenses for accommodation of non-resident participants, food and transportation costs for participation in the full-time stage of the competition are paid by the participants themselves, or by sending organizations.

3. The order of registration and submission of an essay

To participate in the Competition, the following package of documents must be submitted:

1) the author's application for participation in the Competition. The application is submitted by filling out the registration form on the EEYF website from the Competition page or from the main page of the site. In the registration form, first the congress is selected - the Congress of Strategists, then the Competition itself (Annex 1);

2) the participant's essay in electronic form, drawn up in accordance with the requirements specified in clause 5 of the Regulations.

Within three working days, the Organizing Committee sends the author a notification of acceptance of the essay.

4. Essay content requirements

4.1. Essays are accepted for the competition, corresponding to the stated topic: «Modern trends in the economic development of the world.».

Thematic areas of the competition:

- «End-to-end technologies of the digital economy»;
- «A multipolar world in the focus of a new reality»;
- «Actual problems of formation of investment attractiveness of the country».

4.2. The essay must meet the requirements of the genre. The essay is a creative mini-essay (up to 3 A4 pages), in which the participant sets out his vision of the proposed topic, trying to substantiate it, based on existing trends in socio-economic development, as well as referring to facts gleaned from public or personal experience.

4.3. The essay is submitted as an author's product that does not contain either completely or partially elements of plagiarism.

4.4. Citation of the used literature is made in the form of footnotes with all the output data of the sources (author, title of the article, city of publication, publisher (periodical), year of publication (issue number), pages).

4.5. Based on the results of the final events, it is planned to release a collection of materials of the XII EEYF, where abstracts (essays) of the finalists of the Competition will be posted. The collection will be placed in the RSCI and on the website of the Ural State University of Economics.

5. Essay requirements

5.1. The essay must be written in Russian (or English);

5.2. The essay must be formatted in accordance with Annex 2;


5.3. The essay must indicate the main provisions and results of the work. No more than 3 pages. Files in *.doc (*.docx) or *.rtf format, titled with the author(s) surname(s) are accepted for consideration. A4 format. Font Times New Roman, size 14 pt, line spacing - one and a half. All fields - 20 mm. The text is justified in width with automatic hyphenation. Sheet orientation is portrait. Paragraph indent - 1.25. All charts and tables must be inserted into the text. The list of literature is drawn up in accordance with GOST. Footnotes to the text are given in square brackets, indicating the number of the source in the list of references. The initials and surname of the author(s) should be printed at the top of the page, centered. The next line contains the full name of the university (organization), then the city. Below, in the middle of the line, the title is indicated, then the keywords (no more than 5 words or phrases). Then comes the text. At the end, the initials and surname of the supervisor, his academic degree and academic title are indicated.

5.4. Essays submitted for the competition must be owned by the author and not previously published. Responsibility for the originality of the essays submitted for the competition lies with the participants;

5.5. Essays that do not meet these requirements will not be considered. Essays are not reviewed or returned.

6. The procedure for the Competition and the criteria for evaluating essays

6.1. The competition is an annual event and is held within the framework and terms of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum. The final dates for the Competition, as well as its main stages, are established by the order of the rector of the "Ural State Economic University" and are published on the EEYF website.

6.2. At the first stage of the Competition, the Organizing Committee admits essays for further expert evaluation according to the requirements specified in sections 4 and 5 of the Regulations.

6.3. During the second (qualifying) stage, the expert commission examines the essays of the participants and determines 20 (twenty) finalists of the Competition, including 5 finalists from each foreign site of the Competition.

6.4. The lists of finalists are posted on the page of the Competition, the participants-finalists are sent information letters about reaching the final.

If the finalist cannot take part in the final of the competition in person, he is given the opportunity to publicly defend the essay remotely, in the form of a webinar.

6.5. Essay evaluation criteria at the second (qualifying) stage:

1) understanding by the participant of the competition of the problem contained in the title of the topic, and the correspondence of the essay to the chosen topic.

Maximum Points – 2.

2) the personal nature of the perception of the problem and its comprehension (the essay should reveal the personal opinion of the author).

Maximum Points – 3.

3) argumentation of the author's point of view based on the facts of public life and personal social experience.

Maximum Points – 3.

4) clarity of structure, consistency, consistency of key theses and statements.

Maximum Points – 2.

5) literacy, compliance with language norms, diversity of lexical content.

Maximum Points – 10.

6.6. Essay evaluation criteria at the third (final) stage:

1) correspondence of the presentation to the content of the essay.

Maximum Points – 2.

2) quality of the report: structure (presentation in the presentation of all the constituent parts of the essay), logic, accessibility of presentation, literacy and scientific character of the speaker's speech, compliance with the rules.

Maximum Points – 2.

3) level of knowledge of the material: reproductive, productive.

Maximum Points – 2.

4) effectiveness of interaction with the audience: answers to questions, dialogue, debatability.

Maximum Points – 2.

5) the level of multimedia support: the correspondence of the presentation to the content of the essay and the content of the report, the quality of the presentation design.

Maximum Points – 2.


The maximum possible number of points that a participant in the Competition can receive is 30. The decision of the expert commission is made by calculating the sum of points scored in the qualifying round and in the final. In case of equal points, the decision is made by open voting.

7. Competition Management

7.1. The Competition is managed by the EEYF Directorate and the Organizing Committee of the Competition.

7.2. To organize and conduct the competition, an Organizing Committee is formed, approved by the order of the rector of USUE. The Organizing Committee consists of:

- Chairman of the EEYF Organizing Committee;

- co-chairman of the organizing committee of the EEYF;
- scientific supervisor of the Competition, scientific supervisors of the directions of the Competition;

- coordinator(s) of the Competition;
- Chairman and members of the expert commission of the Competition;
- representatives of organizations - partners of the Competition,
- Contest secretary

7.3. The Organizing Committee carries out general management of the organization and conduct of the Competition.

7.3.1. Chairman of the Organizing Committee:

- approves the Regulations on the Competition, signs the order on holding the Competition and the composition of the Organizing Committee of the Competition, the order on the composition of the expert commission;

- carries out general management of the organization and conduct of EEYF events, within the framework of which the Competition is held.

7.3.2. Organizing committee co-chair:

- carries out direct management of the organization and conduct of the EEYF, together with the scientific supervisor of the Competition, forms the composition of the expert commission of the Competition

7.3.3. To conduct an expert assessment of the essay, an expert commission is created.

The chairman of the expert commission is the director of the EEYF Congress, in which the competition takes place. The composition of the expert commission includes scientific supervisors of the competition areas, as well as invited experts, representatives of third-party organizations. The decisions of the expert commission are recorded, the protocols are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (Annexes 3, 4).


7.3.4. Scientific Supervisor of the Competition:

- prepares a draft Regulation on the Competition, prepares amendments and additions to it;
- selects the scientific supervisors of the areas of the Competition and the composition of the expert commission of the Competition;
- together with the Competition coordinator, conducts information work with technical schools, colleges, universities, academic institutions, as well as other organizations and institutions of the Eurasian countries on participation in the Competition.

7.3.5. The scientific supervisor of the Competition direction conducts an examination of the essay at the qualifying stage of the Competition in his own direction, and also works as part of the expert commission of the Competition final.

7.3.6. Competition`s Coordinator:

- ensures the invitation of members of the expert commission of the Competition;
- organizes the distribution of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and Eurasian countries;
- organizes the registration and verification of the compliance of the received tender documents with the established requirements, sends an essay to the members of the expert commission for evaluation;
- organizes and controls the course of the Competition;
- organizes the final and the work of the expert commission during the third stage of the Competition;

– organizes the issuance of diplomas and the awarding of winners and prize-winners of the Competition;

- draws up a report on the Competition.

7.4. The composition of the organizing committee and the expert commission of the Competition is published annually on the Competition page of the EEYF website.

8. Awarding of the winners of the Competition

8.1. According to the results of full-time (including online) public defense, the winners and prize-winners of the Competition are awarded with Diplomas of I, II, III degrees and orders for 1, 2, and 3 places, respectively.

Participants who take 4th and 5th places in the Competition are awarded with Diplomas for 4th and 5th places, respectively. In accordance with the number of points scored, prizes may be divided among several participants of the Competition. All participants of the third stage (final) of the Competition receive certificates of finalists of the Competition. Other participants, upon request, are issued certificates of participation in the Competition. The leaders of the finalists of the Competition are awarded with letters of thanks.

8.2. The winners and prize-winners are awarded cash prizes within the prize fund of the Competition, established on the basis of the order of the rector of USUE and in accordance with the protocols of the expert commissions of the Competition.
