1. General Regulations

1.1. This Regulation (hereinafter referred to as the Regulation) regulates the organization and conduct of the International Competition of Research Papers "Law and Business: Evolution and Innovation" (hereinafter referred to as the Competition).

1.2. The competition is held within the framework of the Congress of Management and Law of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter EEFY). The Internet address of the EEFY website www.eurasia-forum.ru

1.3. Organizer of the Competition:

Ural State University of Economics (USUE), Department of Business Law and Department of Public Law.

1.4. Organizers of the Competition:

Universities-organizers of foreign and regional EEFY sites that have chosen this competition for implementation on their sites. The list of foreign and regional sites that have chosen this Competition is indicated on the Competition page of the Congress of Management and Law of the EEFY website, as well as on the foreign/regional Sites of the EEFY website themselves.

1.5. Partners of the Competition:

– Ural Branch of the Free Economic Society of Russia.

1.6. The purpose of the competition is to increase students' interest in their chosen profession, stimulate interest in research activities in the field of economics and law.


1.7. Objectives of the :

- to identify the analytical potential of young lawyers and financiers;
- to stimulate the exchange of knowledge, ideas, experience in the use of mechanisms of legal regulation of economic processes, current legislation in the field of public and municipal administration;
- to ensure the integration of youth science with the global research environment;
- to form the skills of conducting comparative legal research, developing recommendations for improving legislation;
- assessment of the current situation and strategic thoughts in the field of development of the country and a specific territory.

2. Scientific directions of the Competition

2.1. Competitive papers are submitted for the competition in the following areas:

- State regulation of entrepreneurship

- Financial and legal aspects of regulation of entrepreneurial activity
- Commercial, tax and banking secrets as a subject of criminal encroachments
- Popularization of entrepreneurship among young people.
- Legal problems of regulation of certain types of activities of state and municipal bodies
- Popularization of the state and municipal service in the youth environment
- Fight against corruption by means of criminal law
- The arbitration manager as a subject of crimes related to bankruptcy.

2.2. The choice of the topic is determined on the basis of the approximate subject of the competition works (Appendix 1). The topic can also be proposed independently, taking into account the scientific direction of the competition "Law and Business: evolution and innovation", comparative legal analysis of the legislation of the Russian Federation, Asian countries, Africa, Latin America on the chosen topic (3-5 countries).

It is also possible to conduct a comparative legal analysis of the legislation of the EAEU and BRICS countries


2.3. Based on the results of the study, recommendations should be proposed to improve the legislation of the Russian Federation, taking into account the experience of foreign countries. The result of the study may be proposals for the harmonization of legislation that will contribute to the development of the economy and the law of the future.

2.4. The study is divided into the following structural units: introduction, analytical part, conclusion, bibliographic list.

Introduction - the choice of the research topic, its relevance and novelty is justified, the purpose and objectives of the study are formulated. When determining the relevance, it should be borne in mind that this is nothing more than identifying the degree of development of the topic, determining the place of research among similar ones in this area. In other words, it is necessary to show what has already been done in this area by others and what the author of this work has to do. The establishment of novelty involves showing the difference between the results obtained and those already known.

The purpose of the study is the main direction of research activity. This is what, in the most general form, should be achieved as a result of working on the study. The formulation of the goal allows you to answer the question "Why is the research being conducted?".

Tasks are sequential steps that ensure the achievement of the set goal. Research objectives specify the purpose, determine the main content of the work.

The analytical part is a comparison of the legislation of different countries on the chosen topic. An analytical review of the literature on the topic is carried out, an analysis of certain scientific phenomena in the aspect of the research problem is given. The analytical part can be divided into chapters.

Conclusion - the essence of the research results of the work is briefly stated, the data obtained are summarized in the form of conclusions, theses. At the same time, it is necessary that the content of the conclusion correlate with the tasks and content of the work. Another important point: conclusions should be formulated in a meaningful way, i.e. not just the results of the study are called, but their essence is also concisely revealed.

3. Conditions of participation in the Competition

3.1. Students, undergraduates of educational organizations, academic institutes and other interested organizations of Russia and foreign countries under the age of 35 are invited to participate in the Competition (hereinafter referred to as Participants).

The works prepared by young scientists - postgraduates and candidates of sciences are not accepted for the competition.

3.2. Completed works made individually or by a team of authors (teams of up to 3 people) are submitted to the competition.

3.3. One participant (one team) has the right to submit only one work to the Competition.

3.4. The works of the participants that do not meet these requirements will not be accepted for participation in the competition.


3.5. There is no registration fee for participation in the competition. The costs of accommodation of nonresident participants, meals and transportation costs for participation in the full-time stage of the competition are paid by the participants themselves, or by sending organizations.

4. Procedure and terms of the Competition

The competition is held in three stages.

The first stage, acceptance of works and verification of compliance with the requirements for participants and competitive works. The first stage is held by the organizing committee of the Competition within the time limits set by the Directorate of the Eurasian Economic Forum of the Youth.

The second stage, the examination of competitive works, is carried out by the expert commission of the Competition. According to the results of the examination, lists of Participants who have passed to

the final of the Competition are formed. The lists of finalists are published on the Competition page of the EEFY website. The second stage is (qualifying), conducted remotely.

The third stage is the (final) defense and presentation of the competitive research papers of the finalists, the determination of the winners of the Competition. It is conducted in person at USUE, between the finalists of the Competition by public defense of the competitive works.

Participation in the final is also possible with the use of remote technologies - registered participants and experts get access to USUE cloud resources based on the MS Office 365 platform and connect to interactive sessions within the framework of events through teams created in Microsoft Teams.

According to the results of the Competition, a collection of abstracts of the finalists' works is published. The collection is published in the form of the corresponding chapter of the annual collection of EEFY materials no later than 3 months after the Competition. The collection of EEFY materials is posted on the EEFY website.

5. Requirements for submitted documentation and rules for registration of competitive works

5.1. The works are submitted to the Organizing Committee of the Competition in electronic form through a special registration form on the EEFY website www.eurasia-forum.ru.

5.2. To participate in the Competition, the following set of documents must be submitted:


1) the author's application for participation in the Competition (Appendix 3) is submitted by filling out the participant's registration form on the EEFY website. If the work is prepared by a team of authors, one of the authors registers as the team captain and attaches the work, the other participants register as team members, without attaching the work;

Participants, representatives of foreign/regional sites of the Competition, applications for the competition are submitted through the registration form of the foreign/regional site page.

2) the text of the paper with the title page (appendix 4) is attached as an independent file to the registration form of the participant;

3) abstracts of the paper reflecting the main provisions and results of the work - attached as an independent file to the registration form of the participant.

5.3. The competitive paper must meet the following requirements:

1) the work must be submitted within the deadlines set by the Rector of USUE and published on the EEFY website;

2) the paper must correspond to the subject of the competition;

3) it is necessary to have reference material: references to sources from which quotations are used, numerical data in the text, tables, graphs, diagrams, references (at least 10 sources);

4) the scientific work must be author's, the percentage of originality of the text is not less than 60%;

5) abstracts of the work should be attached to the scientific work. The work should be formatted as follows: a file in the format *.doc or *.rtf, the name of the file should indicate the surname of the author(s). Font Times New Roman, size - 14 pt, line spacing 1.5. All margins are 20 mm. The text is aligned to the width without hyphenation. All charts and tables should be inserted into the text. Paragraph indentation – 1.25. The orientation of the sheet is bookish. Volume of work: 10-45 pages.

The list of references is drawn up in accordance with GOST R 7.0.100-2018. Footnotes on the text are given in square brackets indicating the number of the source in the list of references.

Typical structure of the work: introduction; three chapters (theoretical, analytical, recommendation); conclusion and list of references.


Abstracts reflecting the general idea of the work should be prepared for each research work. Abstracts should be designed as follows: 1.5 line spacing on A4 sheets, Times New Roman font, size - 14 pt, margins - 20 mm on each side. The volume of abstracts is no more than 3 pages. The text of the abstracts should have an abstract, keywords, information about the supervisor

6. Procedure and criteria for evaluating papers

6.1. The Organizing Committee selects projects for further expert evaluation according to the requirements specified in clause 5 of the Regulations.

To conduct an expert evaluation of the works, an expert commission of the Competition is created, as well as an expert commission of the Competition on the site of the Republic of Tajikistan. All decisions of expert commissions are recorded and signed by the chairman, secretary and members of expert commissions (Appendix 4,5).

6.2. During the second (qualifying) stage, expert commissions conduct an examination of the participants' research projects and determine the finalists of the Competition. The 15 best works are selected for the final, including 5 works from each foreign/regional site of the Competition.

6.3. The lists of finalists are published on the page and informational letters about reaching the final are sent to the finalist participants. If the finalist for any reason cannot take part in the final in person, according to the decision of the organizing committee of the Competition, he may be given the opportunity to participate in the competition using remote technologies (online). If the finalist cannot take part in the final of the Competition online, the participant who took the next place according to the results of the qualifying round is entered into the finalists.

Criteria for evaluating competitive works at the second (qualifying) stage:

- 1) registration of the paper - up to 10 points;
- 2) the accuracy of the research topic and its compliance with the EEFY topic – up to 10 points;
- 3) the content of the study: the presence of a detailed comparative legal analysis, consistency, scientific style and literacy of presentation - up to 40 points;
- 4) the tactical significance of the research results, the availability and validity of recommendations for improving the current legislation – 20 points.
- 5) the level of originality of the text - up to 20 points

The maximum score is 100 points

6.4. During the third (final) stage, the members of the expert commissions fill out an expert list for each finalist of the Competition.

Criteria for evaluating participants during the face-to-face defense of the work at the third (final) stage:

- 1) logical and convincing presentation - 10 points
- 2) presentation – 10 points;
- 3) defense (answers to experts' questions) - 30 points.


6.5. To determine the results, the points of the qualifying and final stages are summed up. The maximum total score is 150 points.

7. Competition Management

7.1. The Competition is managed by the Directorate of the EEFY and the organizing Committee of the Competition.

7.2. To organize and conduct the competition, an organizing committee is formed, approved by the order of the rector of USUE. The organizing committee consists of:

- Chairman - Rector of USUE;

– Co-Chairs - USUE Vice-Rector for Social Work, USUE Vice-Rector for Scientific Work members of the organizing committee:

– scientific director of the Competition – Head of the Department of Public Law, Head of the Department of Business Law;

– The coordinator of the Competition is a lecturer of the Department of Public Law; a lecturer of the Department of Business Law.

– chairman and members of the expert commission of the Competition;

– representatives of partner organizations of the Competition,

– the secretary of the Competition is an employee of the Department of Business Law.

7.3. The Organizing Committee provides general management of the organization and conduct of the Competition, as well as performs the following functions:

– mailing of information letters to universities and organizations of the Russian Federation and other countries, no later than three months before the final stage;

– acceptance and organization of processing of scientific papers, as well as registration of mandatory and additional documentation of participants - no later than 15 days before the start of the final, third, stage of the Competition;

– examination of scientific papers by expert commissions within the second stage, no later than 10 days before the start of the final, third, stage of the Competition;

– sending informational letters to educational and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and other countries notifying young scientists and students of the third round of the Competition;

– formation and publication of the Competition program and/or the EEFY program with information about the Competition;


– conducting the third stage (final) Competition;

– awarding of winners;

– formation and transfer to the USUE Publishing House of the collection of abstracts of the finalists of the Competition. The collection of EEFY materials is posted on the EEFY website.

7.3.1. Chairman of the Organizing Committee:

– approves the Regulations on the Competition, signs the order on the conduct of the Competition and the composition of the organizing committee of the Competition, the order on the composition of the expert commissions of the directions of the Competition;

– carries out the general management of the organization and conduct of the events of the Competition.

7.3.2. Co-Chairman of the Organizing Committee:

– carries out direct management of the organization and conduct of the EEFY, within which the Competition is held, is the chairman of the expert commission of the Competition (directions of the Competition), together with the scientific supervisor of the Competition, form the composition of the expert commission of the Competition (directions of the Competition).

7.3.3. The expert commission of the Competition (the direction of the Competition) consists of highly qualified teachers, leading scientists and specialists from the organizers of the EEFY, the Competition, as well as invited experts from universities, academic institutions, other organizations and institutions. The number of members of expert commissions is from 3 to 5 people, including more than half of them are representatives of third-party organizations. The members of the expert commissions are published on the Competition page of the EEFY website.

7.3.4. Scientific director of the Competition:

– prepares the draft Regulations on the Competition and submits it to the rector for approval, prepares amendments and additions to it;

– he is the co-chairman of the Competition;

– selects the composition of the expert commission of the Competition (directions of the Competition);

7.3.5. The coordinator of the Competition, together with his assistant and the working group:

– ensures the invitation of the members of the expert commission of the Competition;

– sends out informational letters to universities of the Russian Federation and Eurasian countries;

– organizes registration and verification of the received works according to the established requirements, sends the works to the members of the expert commission for evaluation;


– organizes and monitors the progress of the Competition;

–organizes the work of the expert commission during the third stage of the Competition;

– organizes the registration of diplomas and awarding of winners and prize-winners of the Competition;

– organizes the collection of abstracts of the finalists of the Competition and their transfer to the USUE Publishing House for inclusion in the collection of materials of the EEFY;

– draws up a report on the conduct of the Competition.

8. Awarding of winners

8.1. According to the results of the face-to-face defense, the winners and prize-winners of the competition are determined, they are awarded Diplomas of I, II, III degrees and orders for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, respectively.

The participants who took the 4th and 5th places are awarded with Diplomas for the 4th and 5th places, respectively. All participants of the third stage of public protection of projects receive certificates of finalists of the Competition, scientific supervisors receive letters of thanks.

8.2. The winners and prize-winners of each thematic area are awarded with cash prizes within the prize fund of the Competition, established on the basis of the order of the rector of USUE and in accordance with the protocol of the expert commission of the competition.

8.3. If the winner or prize-winner of the turns out to be the author's team (team), the cash prize is distributed among all members of the team (team) in equal shares.

8.4. If, according to the decision of the expert council, several participants took the prize, the cash prize is distributed among them.

8.5. Cash prizes (including payment of personal income tax) are transferred by the founder of the Competition within 1.5 months to the personal accounts of the winners and prize-winners according to the details provided to the coordinator of the Competition, as well as upon timely provision of copies of other requested documents. Cash prizes for foreign participants are issued at the USUE cash desk on the day of the award.
