#### 1. General regulations

1.1. This Regulation (hereinafter referred to as the Regulation) regulates the procedure for organizing and conducting the international competition of scientific research insight projects "Boiling Point: Analytics, Expertise, audit" (hereinafter referred to as the Competition).

1.2. The competition is held within the framework of the Congress of Management and Law of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter EEYF). Internet address of the website <u>www.eurasia-forum.ru</u>

1.3. Organizer of the Competition:

Ural State University of Economics (USUE) Department of Competition Law and Antimonopoly Regulation.

1.4. Co-organizers of the Competition:

Universities-organizers of foreign and regional EEFM sites that have chosen this competition for implementation on their sites. The list of foreign and regional sites that have chosen this Competition is indicated on the Competition page of the Congress of Management and Law of the EEFM website, as well as on the foreign/regional Sites of the EEFM website themselves

1.5. Partners of the Competition:

- Department of the Federal Antimonopoly Service for the Sverdlovsk Region

- Federal Treasury Department for the Sverdlovsk Region

– Ural Branch of the Free Economic Society of Russia.

1.6. Purposes of the Competition:

• formation of a positive image of expert-analytical and auditing activities;

• identification of young specialists and scientists with a set of personal qualities and competencies that provide a high level of professional growth in the field of expert-analytical and auditing activities;

• involvement of contestants and laureates in the activities of the professional community;

• stimulating the activities of young specialists in a comprehensive and in-depth understanding of current socio-economic and technical-technological processes and others.

1.7. Objectives of the Competition:

• identify talented young people and determine further prospects for their professional development;

• to identify the analytical and expert potential of young lawyers and economists;

• stimulate the process of sharing knowledge, ideas, experience in the use of control, supervision, business analysis tools, etc.

• to ensure the integration of youth science with the global research environment;

• ability to evaluate decisions made within the framework of analytical, supervisory and expert activities;

• ability to predict the actions of state and non-state institutions in the field of solving expertanalytical tasks, in the field of compliance with the legality of financial activities.



## 2. Scientific fields of the Competition

Scientific and applied papers are submitted to the Competition in the following areas and topics within these areas:

#### Analytical activity

- 1. Business analytics for change management.
- 2. Building a business process management system.
- 3. Building business architectures and complex business models.
- 4. Managing the implementation of the strategy and evaluating its effectiveness.
- 5. Corporate information systems.

#### Expert activity

- 1. Examination of the current state of the elements of the political and legal system.
- 2. Expert assessment of the effectiveness of industry legislation.
- 3. Law in the conditions of digital reality: expert assessments.
- 4. Forensic economic expertise: problems and prospects.

#### Audit activity

- 1. External and internal state financial control (audit) in the budgetary and financial sphere.
- 2. Municipal financial control.
- 3. Treasury control.
- 4. Audit and control in the field of procurement.
- 5. Responsibility for violations in the budgetary and financial sphere.

## 3. Conditions of participation in the Competition

3.1 Students (bachelor's and specialist's degrees) and undergraduates of universities of Russia and foreign countries, as well as employees of interested organizations under the age of 35 (hereinafter referred to as Participants) are invited to participate in the Competition).

3.2. Both individual participants and groups of up to 3 people corresponding to the categories of participants can take part in the Competition.

3.2.1. Applications for participation in the Competition, competitive and abstracts of are submitted until **March 20, 2023** through the registration system of the website.

3.2.2. When registering a team: one of the team members registers as a "team captain" by specifying the name of the team in the "work topic" field; the rest of the team members register as a "team member" by specifying the name of the team in the "work topic" field.

3.2.3. When registering an individual participant: the participant registers as a "participant", indicating in the "topic of work" field – there is no team.

3.3. There is no registration fee for participation in the competition. The costs of accommodation of nonresident participants, meals and transportation costs for participation in the full-time stage of the competition are paid by the participants themselves, or by sending organizations.



#### 4. Stages and dates of the Competition

4.1. The competition is an annual event and is held during the summer semester. The final date of the Competition is set by the order of the Rector of the Ural State University of Economics. There are 3 stages:

*The first stage* is held by the organizing committee of the Competition within the time limits set by the Directorate of the Eurasian Economic Forum of the Youth.

*The second stage* (qualifying) is held remotely. Examination of competitive is carried out by the expert commission of the Competition. According to the results of the examination, lists of Participants who have passed to the final of the Competition are formed. The lists of finalists are published on the Competition page of the EEFY website.

The lists of the finalists of the contest, invited to the full-time defense of and to participate in the final events of the Forum, will be published on the competition page **from April 1 to April 10, 2023.** 

*The third stage (final)* is the defense and presentation of the competitive research papers of the finalists, the determination of the winners of the Competition. It is conducted full-time at USUE. If the borders between a number of countries are not open by the beginning of the forum, participation is also possible with the use of remote technologies. The third stage is held between the finalists of the Competition by public defense of the competitive . The defense will take place **on April 26, 2023**, and the award ceremony will take place on **April 27, 2023**.

According to the results of the Competition, a collection of abstracts of the finalists' is published. The collection is published in the form of the corresponding chapter of the annual collection of EEFY materials no later than 3 months after the Competition. The collection of EEFY materials is posted on the EEFY website.

## **5.** Requirements for the competitive work and theses of the work

1.1 The are submitted to the Organizing Committee of the Competition in electronic form through a special registration form on the EEFY website www.eurasia-forum.ru .

1.2 To participate in the Competition, the following set of documents must be submitted:

1) the author's application for participation in the Competition (Appendix 1– is submitted by filling out the participant's registration form on the EEFY website. If the work is prepared by a team of authors, one of the authors registers as the team captain and attaches the work, the other participants register as team members, without attaching the work;

2) the text of the work with the title page (appendix 2) - attached as an independent file to the registration form of the participant;

3) abstracts of the work reflecting the main provisions and results of the work - attached as an independent file to the registration form of the participant.

1.3 The competitive work must meet the following requirements:

1) the work must be submitted within the deadlines set by the Rector of USUE and published on the EEFY website;

2) the work must correspond to the subject of the competition;

3) it is necessary to have reference material: references to sources from which quotations are used, numerical data in the text, tables, graphs, diagrams, references (at least 20 sources);

4) scientific paper must be author's, the percentage of uniqueness of the text is not less than 60%;

5) abstracts of the paper should be attached to the scientific work The work should be formatted as follows: a file in the format \*.doc or \*.rtf, the name of the file should indicate the surname of the author(s). Font Times New Roman, size - 14 pt, line spacing 1.5. All margins are 20 mm. The text is aligned to the width without hyphenation. All charts and tables should be inserted into the text. Paragraph indentation -1.25. The orientation of the sheet is bookish. Volume of work: 20-45 pages.

The list of references is drawn up in accordance with GOST R 7.0.100-2018. Footnotes on the text are given in square brackets indicating the number of the source in the list of references.

Typical structure of the work: introduction; three chapters (theoretical, analytical, recommendation); conclusion and references.

Abstracts reflecting the general idea of the work should be prepared for each research work. Abstracts should be designed as follows: 1.5 line spacing on A4 sheets, Times New Roman font, size - 14 pt, margins - 20 mm on each side. The volume of abstracts is no more than 3 pages. The text of the abstracts should have an abstract, keywords, information about the scientific director.

#### 6. Procedure and criteria for evaluating papers

6.1. he Organizing Committee selects projects for further expert evaluation according to the requirements specified in clause 5 of the Regulations.

An expert commission is created to conduct an expert assessment of the work. All decisions of expert commissions are recorded and signed by the chairman, secretary and members of expert commissions.

6.2. During the second (qualifying) stage, the expert commission conducts an examination of the participants' research projects and determines 15 finalists.

6.3. The lists of finalists are displayed on the page and information letters about reaching the final are sent to the finalist participants. If a finalist for any reason cannot take part in the final in person, according to the decision of the organizing committee of the Competition, he may be allowed to participate online or excluded from the finalists by entering into the final the participant who took the next place according to the results of the qualifying round.

Criteria for evaluating competitive at the second (qualifying) stage:

1) registration of work – up to 20 points;

2) relevance of the research topic and its compliance with the EEFY topic - up to 10 points;

3) the content of the study: the presence of a detailed comparative legal analysis, consistency, scientific style and literacy of presentation; the presence of appendices, illustrations - up to 40 points;

4) the practical significance of the research results, the availability and validity of recommendations for improving the current legislation -20 points.

5) the level of originality of the text - up to 10 points

The maximum score is 100 points

6.4. During the third (final) stage, the members of the expert commissions fill out an expert list for each finalist of the Competition.



Criteria for evaluating participants during the face-to-face defense of the work at the third (final) stage:

1) logical and convincing presentation - up to 10 points

2) presentation – up to 10 points;

3) defense (answers to experts' questions) - up to 30 points.

6.5. To determine the results, the points of the qualifying and final stages are summed up. The maximum total score is 150 points.

6.6. If the winners and prize-winners of the Competition have the same number of points scored (equal), the decision on determining the winners and prize-winners remains with the expert commission of the Competition.

#### 7. Competition Management

7.1. The management of the Competition is carried out by the Directorate of the EEFY and the Organizing Committee of the Competition.

7.2. For the organization and conduct of the competition, an Organizing Committee is formed, approved by the order of the Rector of USUE. The Organizing Committee consists of:

- chairman;

- co-chairman.

Members of the Organizing Committee:

- scientific director of the Competition;

- coordinators;

- chairman and members of the expert commission of the Competition;

- representatives of the partner organizations of the Competition,

- the secretary of the Competition.

7.3. The Organizing Committee carries out the general management of the organization and conduct of the Competition and also performs the following functions:

- mailing of information letters to universities and organizations of the Russian Federation and other countries, no later than three months before the final stage;

- acceptance and organization of processing of scientific papers, as well as registration of mandatory and additional documentation of participants - no later than 15 days before the start of the final, third, stage of the Competition;

- examination of scientific papers by expert commissions within the second stage, no later than 10 days before the start of the final, third, stage of the Competition;

- sending informational letters to educational and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and other countries notifying young scientists and students of the third round of the Competition;

- formation and publication of the Competition program and/or the EEFY program with information about the Competition;

- holding of the third stage (final) Competition;

- awarding of winners;

- formation and transfer to the USUE Publishing House of the collection of abstracts of the finalists of the Competition. The collection of EEFY materials is posted on the EEFY website.

7.3.1. Chairman of the Organizing Committee:

- approves the Regulations on the Competition, signs the order on the conduct of the Competition and the composition of the organizing committee of the Competition, the order on the composition of the expert commission;

- provides general management of the organization and conduct of the events of the Competition.

7.3.2. Co-Chairman of the Organizing Committee:

- carries out direct management of the organization and conduct of the EEFY, within the framework of which the Competition is held, together with the scientific director of the Competition, forms the composition of the expert commission of the Competition.

7.3.3. An expert commission is created to conduct an expert evaluation of competitive .

The Chairman of the expert commission is the Director of the EEFY Congress, in which the competition is held. The expert commission consists of highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers, leading specialists of the organizers of the EEFY, as well as invited experts. More than half of the members of the expert commission must be representatives of third-party organizations. The decisions of the expert commission are recorded, the protocols are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendix 3.4).

7.3.4. Scientific director of the Competition:

- prepares the draft Regulations on the Competition and submits it to the rector for approval, prepares amendments and additions to it;

- is the chairman (co-chairman) of the expert commission of the Competition;

- selects the composition of the expert commission of the Competition.

7.3.5. Competition Coordinator:

- ensures the invitation of the members of the expert commission of the Competition;

- sends out informational letters to universities of the Russian Federation and Eurasian countries;

- organizes the master class and the final of the Competition, the work of the expert commission of the Competition;

- organizes the registration of diplomas and awarding of winners and prize-winners of the Competition;

- organizes the collection of abstracts of competitive of the finalists of the Competition and their transfer to the USUE Publishing House for inclusion in the collection of materials of the EEFY;

- draws up a report on the conduct of the Competition.

## 8. Awarding of winners

8.1. According to the results of the full-time defense of the , the winners and prize-winners of the Competition are determined, they are awarded Diplomas of I, II, III degrees and orders for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, respectively.

All participants receive certificates of participants of the Competition.

8.2. The winners and prize-winners of the Competition are awarded with cash prizes within the prize fund of the Competition, established on the basis of the order of the Rector of USUE and in accordance with the minutes of the meeting of the expert commission of the Competition.

The winners and prize-winners of the Competition are awarded with diplomas, orders and cash prizes:

- 15 000 rubles for the 1 place
- 10 000 rubles for the 2nd place
- 5 000 rubles for the 3rd place

The winners of the Competition, awarded with a Diploma of the 1st degree, are awarded points for individual achievements when applying for master's degree programs at USUE (5 points). Points are awarded within 2 years following the year of awarding.

8.3. If the winner or prize-winner of the is a team of participants, the cash prize is distributed among all members of the team in equal shares.

8.4. Cash prizes (including payment of income tax) are transferred by the organizer of the Competition within 1.5 months to the personal accounts of the winners and prize-winners according to the details provided to the coordinator of the Competition, as well as upon timely provision of copies of other requested documents. Cash prizes for foreign participants are given out at the USUE cash desk on the day of the award.
