1. General regulation

- 1.1 This Regulation (hereinafter referred to as the Regulation) regulates the procedure for organizing and conducting the Competition of scientific and educational projects of young foreign teachers "Creative educational technologies in higher education" (hereinafter referred to as the the Competition).
- 1.2 The competition is held within the framework of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter referred to as the EEYF). The Internet address of the EEFM website www.eurasia-forum.ru
- 1.3 Organizer of the Competition: Ural State University of Economics (USUE), Departmentsa of Economic Theory and Corporate Governance.
 - 1.4. Purpose and objectives of the Contest:
 - 1.4.1. The objectives of the Competition are:
- support and stimulation of innovative activity of young foreign teachers, identification of new educational technologies, their application and dissemination in teaching;
- search and recruitment of promising young foreign teachers to work at USUE on the terms of employment in the main position or on an external part-time basis.
 - 1.4.2. The objectives of the Contest are:
 - increasing the motivation of young university teachers to teach;
 - identification of talented young foreign teachers of institutions of higher education and science on the basis of competitive selection;
 - creation of a platform for the exchange of experience and modern, effective forms and methods of teaching in higher education for young teachers;
 - creating additional conditions for the realization of the scientific and creative potential of young teaching staff, their self-realization and further professional growth;
 - identification and dissemination of promising and innovative technologies in the organizational and methodological activities of young teachers;
 - identification of young innovative teachers, and providing them with support in innovative teaching activities;
 - to identify the research potential of young scientists.

2. Scientific directions of the Competition

- 2.1 The competition is held in the following scientific and educational areas:
- 1) the use of information and communication technologies in the educational process;
- 2) introduction of open and digital education technologies;
- 3) development and implementation of innovative pedagogical technologies (including interactive learning technologies);
 - 4) introduction of educational technologies that form students' research skills.

3. Conditions of participation in the Competition

3.1. Young foreign teachers of educational organizations, academic institutes and other interested organizations of Russia and foreign countries under the age of 35 are invited to participate in the Competition (hereinafter referred to as Participants). Having a Candidate's degree or PhD degree is welcome. A young foreign teacher should be fluent in Russian.

- 3.2. 3.2. Scientific and educational projects (developed educational technologies) can be submitted to the Competition only from individual authors.
 - 3.3. One participant has the right to submit only one work to the Competition.
- 3.4. The authors independently make a decision on which scientific direction the work will be presented.
- 3.5. Works of participants that do not meet the requirements of clause 5 of these Regulations are not accepted for participation in the competition.
 - 3.6. There is no registration fee for participation in the contest.

4. Procedure and terms of the Contest

- 4.1. The competition is an annual event. The final terms of the Competition, as well as its main stages, are established by the order of the Rector of the Ural State University of Economics.
 - 4.2. The competition is held in three stages.
- 4.2.1. The first stage acceptance and registration of competitive research projects in the chosen field (category) Competition; checking projects for compliance with project requirements.

The first stage is held by the organizing committee of the Contest, within the time limits set by the Directorate of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum.

4.2.2. The second stage – (selection) examination of competitive research projects registered and admitted to the Competition based on the results of the first stage; determination of the finalists of the Competition.

Expertise of competitive projects is carried out by the expert commission of the Competition, as well as by the expert commission of the Competition platform of the Republic of Tajikistan. Lists of Participants who have reached the final stage of the Contest are formed. Lists of finalists are published on the Contest page of the SES website.

4.2.3. The third stage – (final) holding of an open lecture, a master class, a seminar on the declared topic with the use of promising and innovative technologies.

5. Requirements for submitted documentation and rules for registration of competitive works

- 5.1. The works are submitted to the Organizing Committee of the Competition in electronic form through a special registration form on the EEFM website www.eurasia-forum.ru
 - 5.2. To participate in the Competition, the following set of documents must be submitted:
- 1) the author's application for participation in the Competition (Appendix 1) is submitted by filling out the participant's registration form on the EEFM website.
- 2) the text of the competition paper with the title page (appendix 2) attached as an independent file to the registration form of the participant;
- 3) the project of a lecture, a master class, a seminar class, which will be held in the final of the Competition.
 - 5.3. The competition work must meet the following requirements:
- The paper must be submitted within the time limits set by the USUE Rector and published on the EEYF website.
- the author's application for participation in the Competition (Appendix 1) is submitted by filling out the participant's registration form on the EEFM website.

- the text of the competition paper with the title page (appendix 2) attached as an independent file to the registration form of the participant;
- the project of a lecture, a master class, a seminar class, which will be held in the final of the Competition. the scientific work (project) should be accompanied by theses of the work.

The work should be formatted as follows: a file in *.doc or *.rtf format, and the name of the author(s) should be indicated in the file name. Font Times New Roman, size-14 pt, line spacing 1.5. All margins are 20 mm. The text is aligned in width without hyphenation. All charts and tables must be inserted in the text. Paragraph indent – 1.25. The page orientation is portrait. Volume of work: 20-45 pages.

The list of references is drawn up in accordance with GOST R 7.0.100-2018. Footnotes on the text are given in square brackets with the number of the source in the list of references.

The volume of the competition work (essay) no more than 3 pages.

5.4. The project of a lecture, master class, seminar class, which will be held in the final of the Competition in Russian. In agreement with the management of the Competition, the lecture can be conducted in English. Information about the final lecture can be provided in the essay itself with a link to the material posted on the Internet.

6. Contest Management

- 6.1 The Competition is managed by the Directorate of the EEFM and the Organizing Committee of the Competition.
- 6.2 To organize and conduct the competition, an organizing committee is formed, approved by the order of the rector of USUE. The organizing committee consists of:
 - Chairman Rector of USUE;
 - co-chairs Vice-Rector for Social Work of USUE, Vice-Rector for Scientific Work of USUE; members of the organizing committee:
- scientific supervisor of the Competition teacher of the Department of Business Foreign Language of USUE;
- coordinator of the Competition teacher of the Department of Business Foreign Language of USUE;
 - chairman and members of the expert commission of the Competition;
 - representatives of partner organizations of the Competition;
 - secretaries of the Competition employees of the department-organizer of the Competition.
- 6.3 The Organizing Committee provides general management of the organization and conduct of the Competition, as well as performs the following functions:
- mailing of information letters to universities and organizations of the Russian Federation and other countries, no later than three months before the final stage;
- acceptance and organization of processing of scientific papers, as well as registration of mandatory and additional documentation of participants no later than 15 days before the start of the final, third, stage of the Competition;
- examination of scientific works by the expert commission within the second stage, no later than 10 days before the start of the final, third, stage of the Competition;

- sending informational letters to educational and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and other countries notifying young scientists and students of the third round of the Competition;
- formation and publication of the Competition program and/or the EEFM program with information about the Competition—
 - holding of the third stage (final) Competition;
 - awarding of winners;
- formation and transfer to the USUE Publishing House of the collection of abstracts of the finalists of the Competition. The collection of EEFM materials is posted on the EEFM website.
 - 6.3.1 Chairman of the Organizing Committee:
- approves the Regulations on the Competition, signs the order on the conduct of the Competition and the composition of the organizing committee of the Competition;
 - provides general management of the organization and conduct of the events of the Competition.
 - 6.3.2 Co-Chairman of the Organizing Committee:
- directly manages the organization and conduct of the EEFM, within which the Competition is held, is the chairman of the expert commission of the Competition, together with the scientific director of the Competition, form the composition of the expert commission of the Competition.
- 6.3.3 The expert commission of the Competition consists of highly qualified teachers, leading scientists and specialists from the organizers of the EEFM, the Competition, as well as invited experts from universities, academic institutes, other organizations and institutions. The number of members of the expert commission is from 5 to 7 people, most of them are representatives of third-party organizations. Information about the members of the expert commission are published on the Competition page of the EEFM website.
 - 6.3.4 Scientific director of the Competition:
- prepares draft Regulations on the Competition and submits it to the rector for approval, prepares amendments and additions to it;
 - is the chairman (co-chairman) of the expert commission of the Competition;
 - selects the composition of the expert commission of the Competition;
 - 6.3.5 Competition Coordinator:
 - provides an invitation to the members of the expert commission of the Competition;
- sends out informational letters to universities of the Russian Federation and Eurasian countries-
- organizes registration and verification of received works according to the established requirements, sends the work to members of the expert commission for evaluation;
 - organizes and monitors the progress of the Competition;
- organizes the work of the section and the work of the expert commission during the third stage of the Competition;
- organizes the registration of diplomas and awarding of winners and prize-winners of the Competition;
- organizes the collection of abstracts of the finalists of the Competition and their transfer to the USUE Publishing House for inclusion in the collection of EEFM materials;
 - draws up a report on the conduct of the Competition.

7. Managing the Contest

- 7.1 At the first stage of the Competition, the organizing committee admits works and projects for further expert evaluation according to the requirements specified in clause 5 of the Regulations.
- 7.2 During the second (qualifying) stage, the expert commission of the Competition conducts an examination of the participants' research projects and determines up to 20 (twenty) finalists of the Competition, including up to five finalists from each foreign/regional site of the Competition.

The lists of finalists are posted on the Contest page. Informational letters about reaching the finals are sent to the finalists. If the finalist for any reason cannot take part in the final in person, according to the decision of the organizing committee of the Competition, he may be allowed to take part online.

Criteria for evaluating competitive works at the second (qualifying) stage:

- 1) registration of the work up to 10 points;
- 2) relevance of the research topic up to 15 points;
- 3) novelty and originality of the research up to 15 points;
- 4) the content of the study: consistency, scientific style and literacy of presentation; validity of conclusions; availability of appendices, illustrations, graphic explanations of appropriate quality up to 40 points;
- 5) practical significance of the research results -20 points.
- 7.3. During the third (final) stage, the members of the expert commission fill out an expert list for each finalist of the Competition.

Criteria for evaluating participants during the face-to-face defense of the work at the third (final) stage:

- 1) relevance of the research topic up to 20 points;
- 2) novelty and originality of the research up to 20 points;
- 3) the practical significance of the study and the validity of the conclusions up to 20 points;
- 4) the skills of the speaker (the ability to vividly and interestingly present the results of the study, to argue their own position) up to 20 points;
 - 5) presentation performance quality (structure, design, slide content) up to 20 points.

Ability to answer questions, competently and correctly conduct a scientific discussion (additional points) – up to 30 points.

7.4. If the finalists of the Competition have the same number of points (equal), the decision to determine the winner and prize-winners remains with the expert commission of the Competition.

8. Awarding of winners

8.1. Based on the results of the face-to-face defense, I, II, III places are determined for each category of the Competition and then I, II, III places are determined for the Competition as a whole.

The winners and prize-winners of the Competition are generally awarded with Diplomas of I, II, III degrees, orders and cash prizes, within the framework of the prize fund of the Competition established on the basis of the order of the USUE Rector and in accordance with the minutes of the meeting of the expert commission of the Competition.

All participants of the third (final) stage receive certificates of finalists of the Contest.

8.2. The winner of the Competition, who is not on the staff of USUE at the time of participation in the Competition, receives a grant for further employment in USUE for the upcoming academic year.
