1. General Regulations

1.1. These Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) regulate the procedure for organizing and conducting the International Online Olympiad "Economy and Finance of a Polycentric World" (hereinafter referred to as the Olympiad).

1.2. The Olympiad is held within the framework of the Congress of Economists and Financiers of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter referred to as the EEYF) and is implemented at the main site of the EEYF - at the Ural State University of Economics (hereinafter referred to as the USUE site); as well as on foreign and regional EEFF platforms that have chosen this Olympiad.

The list of foreign and regional sites that have chosen this Olympiad is indicated on the Olympiad page of the Congress of Economists and Financiers of the EEYF website, as well as on the pages of the foreign and regional sites themselves on the EEYF website.

The Internet address of the EEYF website is www.eurasia-forum.ru

1.3. Organizer of the Olympics:

Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education "Ural State University of Economics" (Ural State University of Economics), Institute of Economics and Finance, Department of World Economy and Foreign Economic Activity.

1.4. Co-organizers of the Olympics:

Foreign and regional sites of the EEYF that have chosen this Olympiad for implementation on their sites.

1.4. Olympic partners:

- Rostov State Economic University, Rostov-on-Don;
- Ural branch of the Free Economic Society of Russia, Yekaterinburg.

1.5. The goal of the Olympiad is to increase the interest of young people in obtaining and increasing economic knowledge by revealing their abilities for economic analysis and aptitude for economic thinking, making meta-subject connections between economic, political and social processes.

1.6. Objectives of the Olympics:

- stimulate young people to new ideas, proposals, dialogue between countries and peoples;
- stimulate the interest of young people in the economic processes taking place in the world;
- promote the formation of motivation to acquire systematic knowledge in the field of economics and finance.

2. Thematic areas of the Olympics

All tasks of the Olympiad include assessment of the implementation of professional competencies within the disciplines: "World Economy", "Foreign Economic Activity", "National Economy", "Regional Economy", "Macroeconomics", "Money, Credit, Banking", "Finance", "Political Science" etc.

Registration of participants

3.1. Students (students, graduate students) and persons interested in modern problems of economics and finance under the age of 35 are invited to participate in the Olympiad (hereinafter referred to as Participants).

3.2. Participation in the Olympiad is **individual and remote, via the Internet**.

3.3. Applications for participation in the Olympiad are accepted through the registration system of the EEYF website www.eurasia-forum.ru. The application form is specified in Appendix 1.

Participants, representatives of foreign/regional Olympiad sites, select the appropriate site when registering for participation in the Olympiad, all other participants choose the USUE site.

3.4. Applications for participation are submitted within the deadline specified on the Olympiad page of the EEYF website.

3.5. There is no registration fee for participation in the Olympics.

4. Stages and timing of the Olympics

4.1. The Olympiad is an annual event and is held during the summer semester. The final dates for the Olympiad, as well as its main stages, are established by order of the chairman of the EEYF organizing committee, the rector of USUE and are published on the Olympiad pages of the EEYF website.

4.2. The Olympics are held in three stages.

4.2.1. **First stage (until April 1, 2024 inclusive)** – registration of participants and verification of compliance with the requirements for participants in the Olympiad (section 3 of these Regulations).

The first stage is carried out by the organizing committees of the Olympiad (USUE sites and foreign/regional sites that have chosen this Olympiad) within the time frame established by the Directorate of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum and published on the EEYF website.

4.2.2. **Second (preparatory) stage (from April 1 to April 10, 2024)** – the address of the specialized Olympiad website and instructions for completing tasks are sent to the email addresses of all Olympiad participants specified when registering on the EEYF website.

Information letters are sent by the organizing committees of the site where the participant is registered.

There is no qualifying round for participants in this Olympiad. All participants who meet the requirements of Section 3 of these Regulations participate in the finals of the Olympiad.

4.1.3. **The third (final) stage (April 24-25, 2024)** is held remotely, on the main competition day of the EEYF, in the form of testing performed by participants on a specialized website of the Olympiad. Access to tasks opens. Time to complete test tasks is 60 minutes. Number of questions – 40. Number of attempts to pass – 1.

Based on the testing results, the winner and prize-winners of the Olympiad are determined, who took 1st, 2nd and 3rd places, respectively, by the number of points scored, as well as participants who took 4th and 5th places in the International Online Olympiad as a whole.

At the same time, the winners and prize-winners of each foreign/regional Olympic site are determined. They are determined by the number of points scored among site participants.

On April 25, 2024, the in-person awards ceremony for the winners and prize-winners of the Olympics as a whole and the qualifying rounds of foreign/regional venues will take place. The simultaneous awards ceremony will be broadcast via video conferencing.

5. Order for the finals and criteria for evaluating participants' Olympiad assignments

5.1. To conduct the finals of the Olympiad, the academic supervisors of the Olympiad prepare test tasks on economic and financial issues related to modern economic, political and social development trends and transformational changes in world economic processes.

5.2. Number of questions – 40. Number of attempts to pass the test – 1. The correctness of answers to the test questions is assessed. 1 point is given for the correct answer to each question, the maximum number of points is 40. In the case of scoring the same number of points, the time taken to complete the test will be taken into account; priority will be given to the participant who completes the test faster.

5.3. All assignments include assessment of the implementation of professional competencies within the disciplines: "World Economy", "Foreign Economic Activity", "National Economy", "Regional Economy", "Macroeconomics", "Money, Credit, Banking", "Finance", "Political Science" etc.

5.4. To conduct an expert assessment of the results of testing of participants, an Olympic expert commission is created. All decisions of the expert commission are recorded and signed by the chairman, members and secretary of the expert commission (Appendix 2).

5.5. The list of participants who took 1st to 5th places in the overall standings of the Olympiad and the participants who took 1st to 3rd places within one site are published on the Olympiad pages of the EEFY website. Information letters on the results of the Olympiad are sent by e-mail to participants.

6. Winner's reward ceremony


6.1. Based on the results of the final round, the winner and medalists of the Olympics are determined. They are awarded Diplomas of 1st, 2nd, 3rd degree and large orders "Star of Eurasia" for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, respectively. The participants who took 4th and 5th places are also determined. They are awarded certificates for 4th and 5th places.

All Olympiad participants who receive more than 50% correct answers to Olympiad tasks receive electronic certificates of Olympiad participants.

Additionally, among the participants who participated through foreign/regional sites, 1st to 3rd places of foreign/regional sites are determined. They are awarded certificates for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in the corresponding Olympic venues, as well as commemorative small orders "Star of Eurasia"

6.2. The winner and runners-up (2nd and 3rd place) of the final round of the Olympiad are awarded cash prizes within the framework of the Olympiad prize fund established by order of the USUE Rector and in accordance with the protocol of the Olympiad expert commission.

Cash prizes (including payment of income tax) are transferred by the organizer of the Olympiad within 1.5 months to the personal accounts of the winner and prize-winners using the details provided to the coordinator of the Olympiad, subject to the submission of the following documents to the organizer of the competition:

– printout from the bank’s personal account: bank details and personal account number for transferring money;

- a copy of the passport page 1, 2 and page with registration;
- a copy of the TIN or a printout of the TIN data from the website.

Cash prizes for foreign participants participating in the finals via online communication are transferred according to the details of the bank that is a partner bank of the Russian bank.

6.3. The awarding of all finalists of the Olympiad will take place as part of the final events of the XIV EEYF **on April 25, 2024** simultaneously at the USUE site and at foreign/regional venues of the Olympiad using online communication.

7. Management of the Olympics at the USUE site

7.1. The management of the Olympiad is carried out by the organizing committee of the EEYF and the organizing committee of the Olympiad.

7.2. Chairman of the EEYF organizing committee, rector of USUE:

– approves the Regulations on the Olympics, signs the order on holding the Olympics and the composition of the organizing committee of the Olympics, the order on the composition of the expert commission;

– carries out general management of the organization and conduct of EEYF events, within the framework of which the Olympiad is held.

7.3. To organize and conduct the Olympics, an Olympic organizing committee is formed, which includes:

- scientific director(s) of the Olympiad;
- Olympic coordinator;
- members of the Olympic expert commission;
- representatives of organizations - partners of the Olympics,
- Secretary of the Olympics.

7.4. Scientific director(s) of the Olympiad:

- prepares the draft Regulations on the Olympics, amendments and additions to it;
- is the chairman (co-chairman) of the expert commission of the Olympiad;
- selects the composition of the Olympic expert commission;
- prepares test tasks for the Olympics.

7.5. Olympics Coordinator:

– ensures the invitation of members of the Olympiad expert commission;

– organizes the distribution of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and Eurasian countries;

– organizes registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of compliance of received applications with established requirements;

– organizes and monitors the progress of the Olympics;

– organizes the registration of diplomas and certificates; awarding the winners and prize-winners of the Olympics;

– organizes the collection of necessary documents for issuing cash prizes to the winners and medalists of the Olympics;

– compiles a report on the Olympics.

7.6. An expert commission is created to conduct an expert assessment of the participants' testing results.

The chairman of the expert commission of the Olympiad is the director of the EEF Congress, where the Olympiad is taking place. The expert commission includes highly qualified representatives of the scientific and business community; Russian and foreign experts in the field of economics and finance from higher educational institutions of the Russian Federation, academic science, audit companies; business practitioners. More than half of the members of the expert commission must be representatives of third-party organizations.

The expert commission may also include representatives of co-organizing countries that have chosen this Olympiad for implementation at their foreign/regional sites.

All decisions of the expert commissions are recorded and signed by the chairman (co-chairman), secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendix 2).

Information on the composition of the organizing committee and expert commission of the Olympiad is published annually on the Olympiad page of the EEF website.

8. Management of the Olympiad at foreign/regional venues of the EEF

8.1. The Olympiad is managed by the organizing committee of the foreign/regional EEF site and the Olympiad coordinator of the EEF site.

8.2. EEF Olympiad coordinator:

- organizes the distribution of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations in their country/region of Russia;
- organizes registration (through the registration system of the EEF website) and verification of compliance of received applications with established requirements;
- organizes participants who applied for participation in the Olympiad through a foreign/regional site to timely complete the final stage of the Olympiad remotely;
- sends information letters to the winners of the site, who took 1st to 3rd place among the site participants, about participation in the award procedure, which will take place on the territory of the site's head university on **April 25, 2024**.


