1. General Regulations

1.1 . These Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) regulate the procedure for organizing and conducting the International Competition of Applied Projects for Young Scientists and Students “ City: Open the Future ” (hereinafter referred to as the Competition).

1.2 . The competition is held within the framework of the Congress of Economists and Financiers of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter referred to as EEYF) and is implemented at the main site of EEYF - at the Ural State University of Economics (hereinafter referred to as the USUE site); as well as on foreign and regional EEYF platforms that have chosen this Competition.

The list of foreign and regional sites that have chosen this Competition is indicated on the Competition page for the Congress of Economists and Financiers on the EEYF website, as well as on the pages of the foreign/regional sites themselves on the EEYF website.

1.3 . Organizers of the Competition:

1.4 . Competition partner: Ural branch of the Free Economic Society of Russia.

1.5 . Goal and objectives of the Competition:

1.5.1. The purpose of the Competition is to develop analytical, managerial, research, and creative competencies and to facilitate the implementation of initiatives of young professionals in the field of forecasting and strategic planning of urban development.

1.5.2 . Competition objectives:

- identifying the analytical potential of young economists and creating conditions for their further development;
- updating the interest of young economists in the problems of our time through the analysis of future opportunities and prospects for the development of the city of the future;
- exchange of knowledge, ideas and experience in the field of strategic planning, territory marketing and forecasting;
- demonstration of original approaches and mechanisms for solving current problems, as well as the formation of a vision of the “City of the Future”;

- forming an idea of trends and prospects for urban development - “ Cities of the future - creative, comfortable, attractive and safe.”

2. Thematic areas of the Competition

The competition is held in 6 thematic areas:

1) City of the future: comfortable.

Within the framework of the thematic direction “City of the Future: Comfortable”, the following is considered: the formation of a comfortable urban environment; formation of city infrastructure; development of the city's transport system; efficient and rational use of urban land; planning structure of the city of the future; rational use of undeveloped land within the city, etc.

2) City of the future: environmentally friendly.

Within the framework of the thematic direction “City of the Future: Eco-Friendly”, the following is considered: the environmental safety of the city; creating an environmentally friendly urban environment; improvement of the urban environment; reduction of noise pollution in the city; restoration and improvement of natural objects of cities, etc.

3) City of the future: attractive.

Within the framework of the thematic direction “ City of the Future: Attractive” the following is considered: improvement of urban areas, landscaping of the city; what is the city today and tomorrow?; optimal city; post-industrial transformation of cities; ensuring the quality and accessibility of municipal services; sustainable development of the city, etc.

4) City of the future: safe.

Within the framework of the thematic direction “ City of the Future: Safe”, the formation of a safe and tolerant urban environment is considered; formation of mechanisms for creating a clean and safe city; improving the quality and ensuring the safety of life of the urban population; issues of creating a safe living environment, etc.

5) City of the future: creative.


Within the thematic area “City of the Future: Creative” the following is considered: city branding, city image; creative industry of the city; cultural worldview in urban development, etc.

6) City of the future: technologically advanced .

Within the thematic area “ City of the Future: Technological”, the following is considered: new technologies or smart urban technologies; smart city; city of high technologies; environmental conservation, energy saving, waste recycling and innovative technologies in urban construction, etc.

3. Conditions of participation in the Competition

3.1 . Students, graduate students, young scientists and specialists from educational organizations, academic institutions and other interested organizations in Russia and foreign countries under the age of 25 are invited to participate in the Competition (hereinafter referred to as the Participants).

Works prepared by young scientists - candidates of sciences are not accepted for the competition.

3.2. Research works for the Competition can be sent from individual authors or from creative teams (teams of up to 5 people).

3.3. One participant has the right to submit only one work to the Competition.

3.4. The authors independently decide on which thematic area the work will be presented.

3.5. The works of participants that do not satisfy Section 5 of these Regulations will not be accepted for participation in the Competition.

3.6. There is no registration fee for participation in the competition. Expenses for accommodation of non-resident participants, food and transportation costs for participation in the full-time stage of the competition are paid by the participants themselves or by sending organizations.

4. Stages and timing of the Competition

4.1 . The competition is an annual event and takes place during the summer semester. The final dates for the Competition, as well as its main stages, are established by order of the rector of the chairman of the EEYF organizing committee - the rector of USUE and are published on the Competition pages of the EEYF website.

4.2 . The competition is held in three stages:

4.2.1. **The first stage (until March 20, 2024 inclusive)** – acceptance and registration of competitive research works on the selected topic of the Competition; checking the work for compliance with the requirements for the work.

The first stage is carried out by the organizing committees of the Competition of the relevant sites:


- Organizing Committee of the USUE Main Site Competition;
- organizing committees of the Competition of foreign/regional sites.

If less than 10 competitive works are received at a foreign/regional site, then the Competition at this site is considered not to have taken place, and the received works participate in the competition of the main site of USUE on a general basis.

4.2.2. **The second stage (qualifying) (from March 21 to April 1, 2024)** – examination of competitive research works registered and admitted to the Competition based on the results of the first stage. Determining the finalists of the Competition from the USUE site and the finalists of the Competition from foreign/regional sites.

– Conducting the qualifying stage at the USUE site

The examination of competitive works received through the USUE site is carried out by the expert commission of the Competition of the USUE site. The commission selects up to 10 finalists (10 projects) in absentia. The final number of finalists from the USUE site depends on the actual number of finalists from foreign/regional sites of the Competition. Lists of finalists who made it to the finals of the

Competition are published on the Competition page of the Congress of Economists and Financiers of the EEIF website.

– Conducting qualifying stages at foreign/regional competition sites

The examination of competitive works at the EEIF sites is carried out by expert commissions of foreign/regional Competition sites with the participation of a representative of the expert committee of the USUE Competition site. Expert commissions select 5-10 best participants in the national/regional round of the Competition. **On April 1, 2024**, the organizing committee and the expert commission of the foreign/regional site of the Competition will conduct a full-time defense of the selected works and determine the winner and prize-winners of the national/regional round of the Competition.

The winner (first place) of the national/regional round of the Competition becomes a finalist in the international final of the Competition. He is given the opportunity to participate in the finals of the Competition and other final events of the XIV EEIF **on April 23-25, 2024 in person.** Payment for travel and accommodation is provided by the main organizer of the EEIF - USUE.

Participants who took 2nd and 3rd place in the Competition will be solemnly presented with certificates and memorable gifts at a foreign/regional site on April 25, 2024.

The general list of finalists of the international final of the Competition is formed from finalists from the USUE site and winners of foreign/regional sites that have chosen this Competition. The general list of finalists of the Competition is published on the EEIF website, on the page of the Competition of the Congress of Economists and Financiers **from April 1 to April 10, 2024**

4.2.3. **The third stage (final) (April 24-25, 2024)** – defense of competitive projects of the international final of the Competition; determination of the winners of the Competition; rewarding
Defense of projects remotely using online communication is carried out by decision of the Organizing Committee of the Competition.

Defense of competition works is carried out:

– official protection of the project with a layout or visualization;

4.3. Based on the results of the Competition, a collection of abstracts of the finalists' works is published. The collection is published in the form of the corresponding chapter of the annual collection of EEIF materials no later than 3 months after the Competition. The collection of EEIF materials is posted in the RSCI, on the USUE website and on the EEIF website.

5. Requirements for submitted documentation and rules for registration of competitive works

5.1. Research works and projects are submitted to the Competition in one of the 6 thematic areas listed in Section 2 of these Regulations.

5.2. Works are submitted to the Organizing Committee of the Competition in electronic form through a special registration form on the EEIF website www.eurasia-forum.ru:

– participants of the main site of the Competition, when registering, choose: USUE Site – Congress of Economists and Financiers – competition “City: Open the future ” ;

– participants of foreign/regional sites, when registering, select the Name of the corresponding site – “City: Open the future ” .

5.3. To participate in the Competition the following package of documents must be submitted:

1) the author's statement about participation in the Competition (Appendix 1) – is submitted by filling out the participant's registration form on the EEYF website.

If the work is prepared by a team of authors, one of the authors is registered as the team captain and attaches the work, the remaining participants are registered as team members. A team member can attach empty files to complete registration.

2) competitive work (with a title page, according to Appendix 2, the recommended structure of the work is indicated in Appendix 3) - attached as a separate file to the registration form of the participant/team captain;

3) abstracts of the work reflecting the main provisions and results of the work (according to the form of Appendix 4) - attached as a second separate file to the registration form of the participant/team captain.

5.4. All documents must be submitted in a single package by **March 20, 2024** or as otherwise specified on the EEYF website.

The absence of any of the documents specified in clause 5.3. within the prescribed period means refusal to participate in the Competition.

5.5. The competition entry must meet the following requirements:

1) the work must correspond to the thematic areas of the Competition and be aimed at solving one of the theoretical or practical problems;

2) the work must be original, the percentage of originality of the text is at least 60%;

3) design time range - no more than 10 (ten) years;

4) the project must be developed for a specific city;

5) reference material is required: links to sources from which quotes are used, digital data in the text, tables, graphs, diagrams, bibliography (at least 15 sources);

6) the work must be formatted as follows: a file in *.doc or *.rtf format, the name of the file must indicate the surname of the author(s). Font Times New Roman, font size – 14 pt, line spacing 1.5. All margins are 20 mm. The text is justified without hyphenation. All charts and tables must be inserted into the text. Paragraph indent – 1.25. Sheet orientation is portrait. Volume of work: from 15 to 20 pages.


The list of references is drawn up in accordance with GOST R 7.0.100-2018. Footnotes to the text are given in square brackets indicating the source number in the list of references.

The recommended structure of the competition work is indicated in Appendix 3.

5.6. Research work must include abstracts that reflect the general idea of the work. Abstracts should be formatted as follows: line spacing 1.5 on A4 sheets, font Times New Roman, size 14 pt, margins 20 mm on each side. The volume of abstracts is no more than 3 pages. A sample design is given in Appendix 3.

5.7. For the final protection of the project, a mock-up or visualization of the project is presented:

– the layout must meet the following requirements: a mobile structure with protected elements of the project (model of the future park, alleys, waste recycling systems, etc.)

– requirements for project visualization: participants must prepare material that is an element of promotion and implementation of the project (brochure, video, website, products, etc.)

5.8. The working languages of the Competition are Russian and English.

6. Criteria for evaluating competition works

6.1. At the first stage of the Competition, the organizing committee admits projects for further expert evaluation according to the requirements specified in Section 5 of the Regulations.

6.2. Criteria for evaluating competitive works at the second (qualifying) stage of the Competition:

- 1) Definition of the problem and its relevance - 5 points.
- 2) Availability of an analysis of the socio-economic development of the territory - 5 points.
- 3) Analysis of public opinion - 5 points.
- 4) Availability of SWOT analysis - 5 points.
- 5) Identification of factors constraining the development of the city - 5 points.
- 6) Setting the goals and objectives of the project - 5 points.
- 7) Description of methods (tools, technologies) and stages of implementing the project idea - 20 points.
- 8) Availability of an analysis of resource support for project implementation - 10 points.
- 9) Identification of stakeholders, distribution of functions between them, justification of their interest in the implementation of the project - 10 points.
- 10) Assessment of project risks that impede the achievement of results - 5 points.
- 11) Justification of the results of the implementation of this project - 10 points.
- 12) Availability of a mechanism for monitoring changes in the territory under the influence of the project (substantiation of feedback from the population) - 5 points.
- 13) The realism of this project is 10 points.

Lists of finalists are published on the Competition page. Information letters about reaching the finals are sent to the finalist participants. If a finalist (team of finalists) cannot personally take part in the final of the Competition, he is given the opportunity to publicly defend the project remotely, in the form of a webinar. If the finalist cannot take part in the final of the Competition remotely, the participant (team) who took 16th place according to the results of the second (qualifying) stage of the Competition is included in the finalists.

6.3. Criteria for evaluating participants during the full-time defense of work at the third (final) stage:

- 1) relevance of the research topic – up to 15 points;
- 2) novelty and originality of the research – up to 15 points;
- 3) significance of the research results – up to 20 points;
- 4) presentation, incl. layout development or visualization – up to 20 points;
- 5) defense (answers to expert questions) – up to 30 points.

6.4. If the winners and prize-winners of the Competition have the same number of points (equal), the decision to determine the winners and prize-winners remains with the Expert Commission of the Competition.

6.5. The expert commission has the right to select special nominations.

7. Awarding the winners

7.1. Based on the results of the international final of the Competition, the winners and prize-winners of the Competition are determined. Winners and runners-up are awarded Diplomas of 1st, 2nd, 3rd degree and large orders "Star of Eurasia" for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, respectively.

Participants who took 4th and 5th places in the Competition are awarded Certificates for 4th and 5th places, respectively.

All participants of the Competition receive certificates of Competition finalists in electronic form.

7.2. Winners and runners-up (1st, 2nd and 3rd place) of the Competition are awarded cash prizes within the framework of the Competition prize fund, established on the basis of the order of the USUE Rector and in accordance with the protocols of the Expert Commissions of the Competition.

Cash prizes (including payment of income tax) are transferred by the organizer of the Competition within 1.5 months to the personal accounts of winners and prize-winners using the details provided to the Competition coordinator, subject to the submission of the following documents:

- printout from the bank's personal account: bank details and personal account number for transferring money;

- a copy of the passport page 1, 2 and page with registration;

- a copy of the TIN or a printout of the TIN data from the website.

If the winner or prize-winner of the Competition turns out to be a group of authors (team), the cash prize is divided among all members of the team (team) in equal shares.

Cash prizes for foreign participants participating in the finals in person are issued at the USUE cash desk on the day of the award.

7.3. Participants who take 1st, 2nd and 3rd place at a foreign/regional site are awarded certificates for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in the national/regional round and small orders "Star of Eurasia".

7.4. The awarding of all finalists of the Competition will take place as part of the final events of the XIV EEYF **on April 25, 2024** simultaneously at the USUE site and at foreign/regional Competition sites using online communication.

8. Management of the Competition on the USUE site

8.1. The Competition is managed by the EEYF Organizing Committee and the Competition Organizing Committee.

8.2. Chairman of the EEYF Organizing Committee - Rector of USUE:

- approves the Regulations on the Competition, signs the order on holding the Competition and the composition of the organizing committee of the Competition, the order on the composition of the expert commission of the Competition;

– carries out general management of the organization and conduct of EEYF events within the framework of which the Competition is held.

8.3. To organize and conduct the Competition, an organizing committee of the Competition is formed, consisting of:

- scientific director of the Competition;
- Competition coordinator;
- members of the expert committee of the Competition;
- representatives of organizations - partners of the Competition,
- Secretary(s) of the Competition.

8.4. Scientific director of the Competition:

- prepares the draft Regulations on the Competition, prepares amendments and additions to it;
- is the chairman (co-chairman) of the expert commission of the Competition;
- selects the composition of the expert commission of the Competition.

8.5. Competition Coordinator:

– ensures the invitation of members of the Expert Commission of the Competition;

– organizes the distribution of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and Eurasian countries;

– organizes registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of compliance of received competition documents with established requirements, sends competition works to members of expert commissions for evaluation;

– organizes and monitors the progress of the Competition;

– organizes the work of the expert commission during the international finals of the Competition;

– organizes the registration of diplomas, certificates and awarding of the winners and prize-winners of the Competition;

– organizes the collection of abstracts of competitive works of the Competition finalists and their transfer to the USUE Publishing House for inclusion in the collection of EEYF materials;

– organizes the collection of necessary documents for issuing cash prizes to the winners and prize-winners of the Competition;

– draws up a report on the Competition.

8.6. An expert commission of the Competition is created to conduct an expert assessment of competitive works.

The Chairman of the Expert Commission of the Competition is the Director of the EEYF Congress, where the competition is taking place. The co-chairman of the Expert Committee of the Competition is the scientific director of the Competition. The expert commission includes highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers, leading specialists from among the organizers of the EEYF, as well as invited experts. More than half of the members of the expert commission must be representatives of third-party organizations. Decisions of the expert commission are made by open voting, by a simple majority of votes of the members of the expert commission present, minutes are recorded, the minutes are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendices 5, 7).

Information on the composition of the organizing committee and expert commissions of the Competition is published annually on the Competition page of the EEYF website.



9. Management of the Competition at foreign/regional sites of the EEYF

1.1. The Competition is managed by the organizing committee of the foreign/regional EEYF site and the organizing committee of the Competition of the EEYF site.

1.2. The organizing committee of the EEYF Competition includes:

- Competition coordinator;
- an expert commission of the Competition consisting of at least 3 people from among highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers of the university organizing the site, as well as invited experts, including the scientific director of the Competition of the USUE site;
- Secretary of the Competition.

1.3. Competition Coordinator:

- ensures the invitation of members of the expert commissions of the Competition;
- organizes the distribution of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations in their country or region of Russia;
 - organizes registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of compliance of received competition documents with established requirements, sends competition works to members of expert commissions for evaluation;
 - organizes the work of expert commissions during the qualifying round of the Competition;
 - together with the organizing committee of the USUE site, organizes the departure of the winner of the qualifying round of the Competition to USUE to participate in the international final of the Competition (1st place), as well as the participation of the contestants who took 2nd and 3rd place in the national/regional round of the Competition in the ceremony awards on its site on April 25, 2024;
 - organizes the transfer of the thesis of the winner of the national/regional round to the coordinator of the Competition at the USUE site for inclusion in the collection of EEYF materials.


9.4. To conduct an expert assessment of the competition entries, an expert commission is created at the foreign/regional site of the Competition.

The composition of the expert foreign/regional commission of the Competition is approved by the organizing committee of the foreign/regional site. The expert commission includes highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers, leading specialists from among the organizers of the EEYF site, as well as invited experts. Decisions by the expert commission are made by open voting, by a simple majority of votes of the members of the expert commission present, minutes are recorded, the minutes are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendix 6).

1. Introduction (maximum 1 page):

- a brief description of the key blocks of the project;
- summary of the project chapters.

2. Formulation of the problem:

- assessment of the socio-economic situation of the city: characteristics of the current socio-economic development of the city, analysis of statistical information. Results of a microsociological survey of selected target groups of consumers to clarify one or another aspect of the study;
- SWOT analysis of the city: initial table, final table, threat and opportunity matrices, conclusions. Formulation of problems hindering the development of the city.
- description of the problem under study: Justification of the relevance of the study, clearly defined point by point.

3. Strategic vision of the facility:

- the main idea of the project;
- the target audience;
- project goal tree;
- the role of the project in the future life of the city;
- description of methods, tools, technologies for project implementation;
- project structure; stages of project implementation with identification of activities at each stage and justification of resource provision.


4. Stakeholders, risk assessment:

- circle of responsible project participants (stakeholders);
- the functions and interests of each stakeholder in the implementation of the project;
- the main risks of the project that impede the achievement of results.

5. Expected results of the project:

- formulation and substantiated results of a socio-economic nature for the city.
- forecast for the development of the city without taking into account the implementation of the project and a forecast taking into account the effects of the implementation of the project (i.e. develop 2 options for the city of the future - pessimistic and optimistic).

* The structure of the work is advisory in nature and may change due to the specifics of the problem being studied.

Requirements for the preparation of abstracts of competitive works

The competition work must be accompanied by abstracts in which it is necessary to indicate main provisions and results of the work. Abstracts *should not exceed 3 pages* .

entitled with the author's last name , are accepted for consideration . A4 format. Times font New Roman , font size 14 pt, line spacing – one and a half. All margins are 20 mm. The text is aligned in width with automatic hyphenation. Sheet orientation is portrait. Paragraph indent – 1.25. All charts and tables must be inserted into the text. The list of references is drawn up in accordance with GOST. Footnotes to the text are given in square brackets indicating the source number in the list of references.

The author's initials and surname should be printed at the top center of the page. The next line indicates the full name of the university (organization), then the city. Below, in the middle of the line, indicate the title, then keywords (no more than 5 words or phrases). Then the text is placed. At the end, the initials and surname of the scientific supervisor, his academic degree and academic title are indicated.

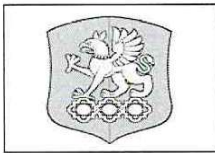
