1. General provisions

1.1 These Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) regulate the procedure for organizing and conducting the International Competition of Student Articles “Modern Economic Theory and Social Development: Fundamental and Interdisciplinary Research” (hereinafter referred to as the Competition).

1.2 The competition is held within the framework of the Congress of Economists and Financiers of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter referred to as EEYF) and is implemented at the main site of EEYF - at the Ural State University of Economics (hereinafter referred to as the USUE site); as well as on foreign and regional EEYF platforms that have chosen this Competition.

The list of foreign and regional sites that have chosen this Competition is indicated on the Competition page for the Congress of Economists and Financiers on the EEYF website, as well as on the pages of the foreign/regional sites themselves on the EEYF website.

1.3 Organizer of the competition:

Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education "Ural State University of Economics" (Ural State University of Economics), Department of Economic Theory and Applied Sociology.

1.4 Co-organizers of the Competition:

Universities-organizers of foreign and regional EEYF platforms that have chosen this competition for implementation at their sites.

1.5 partners :

Institute of Economics, Ural Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences;

Ural branch of the Free Economic Society of Russia.

1.6 The purpose of the competition is to create an information platform for students to exchange opinions and experience in the field of solving economic problems from the perspective of various schools and directions, in particular, neoclassical economics and current trends in heterodox economic theory, considering the prospects for the interaction of modern economics with the achievements of psychological, legal, mathematical, sociological sciences.

1.7 Objectives of the Competition:


- attracting the attention of young people to the new requirements placed on specialists in the context of increasing complexity of scientific knowledge and growing demand for interdisciplinary approaches to solving social problems;
- generalization of various areas of practical application of modern economic theory;
- generalization of problems and development of recommendations on the possibility of using the theoretical provisions of modern economic science in the analysis and assessment of real socio-economic processes and phenomena .

2. Scientific directions of the Competition

Thematic areas of the Competition are determined annually in accordance with the topic(s) of the EEYF and are published on the Competition page on the EEYF website (www.eurasia-forum.ru).

Scientific articles for the 2024 Competition are sent in the following areas:

- Current issues of modern economic theory.

3. Conditions of participation in the Competition

3.1. Bachelor's, specialist's and master's degree students studying in educational organizations in Russia and foreign countries under the age of 35 are invited to participate in the Competition (hereinafter referred to as the Participants).

Articles prepared by young scientists - graduate students and candidates of sciences - are not accepted for the competition. All participants submit applications through the main platform of the EEYF - USUE.

3.2. Scientific articles for the Competition can only be submitted from **individual authors** _

3.3. One participant has the right to submit only one article to the Competition.

3.4. The author of the article independently decides in which scientific area of the Competition the work will be presented.

3.5. Articles of participants that do not meet the requirements of clause 5 of these Regulations will not be accepted for participation in the Competition.

3.6. There is no registration fee for participation in the Competition. Expenses for accommodation of non-resident participants, food and transportation costs for participation in the full-time stage of the competition are paid by the participants themselves or by sending organizations. The exception is the winners of foreign/regional competition sites.

4. Stages and timing of the Competition

4.1. The competition is an annual event and is held during the summer semester. The final dates for the Competition, as well as its main stages, are established by order of the chairman of the EEYF organizing committee, the rector of USUE and are published on the Competition pages of the EEYF website .

4.2. The competition is held in three stages.


4.2.1. **The first stage (until March 20, 2024 inclusive)** – acceptance and registration of competitive research works of the Competition; checking the work for compliance with the requirements for the work.

The first stage is carried out by the organizing committees of the Competition of the relevant sites:

- Organizing Committee of the USUE Main Site Competition;
- organizing committees of the Competition of foreign/regional sites.

If less than 10 competitive works are received at a foreign/regional site, then the Competition at this site is considered not to have taken place, and the received works participate in the competition of the main site of USUE on a general basis.

4.2.2. **The second stage (qualifying) (from March 21 to April 1, 2024)** – examination of competitive research works registered and admitted to the Competition based on the results of the first

stage. Determining the finalists of the Competition from the USUE site and the finalists of the Competition from foreign/regional sites.

– Conducting the qualifying stage at the USUE site

The examination of competitive works received through the USUE site is carried out by the expert commission of the Competition of the USUE site. The commission selects **10 to 15** finalists in absentia . The final number of finalists from the USUE site depends on the actual number of finalists from foreign/regional sites of the Competition. Lists of finalists who made it to the finals of the Competition are published on the Competition page of the Congress of Economists and Financiers on the EEYF website.

– Conducting qualifying stages at foreign/regional competition sites

The examination of competitive works at the EEYF sites is carried out by expert commissions of foreign/regional Competition sites. Expert commissions select 5-10 best participants in the national/regional round of the Competition. On April 1, 2024, the organizing committee and the expert commission of the foreign/regional site of the Competition will conduct a full-time defense of the selected works and determine the winner and prize-winners of the national/regional round of the Competition.

The winner (first place) of the national/regional round of the Competition becomes a finalist in the international final of the Competition . He is given the opportunity to participate in the finals of the Competition and other final events of the XIV EEYF **on April 23-25, 2024 in person.** Payment for travel and accommodation is provided by the main organizer of the EEYF - USUE.

Participants who took 2nd and 3rd place in the Competition will be solemnly presented with certificates and memorable gifts at a foreign/regional site on April 25, 2024.


The general list of finalists of the international final of the Competition is formed from finalists from the USUE site and winners of foreign/regional sites that have chosen this Competition. The general list of finalists of the Competition is published on the EEYF website, on the page of the Competition of the Congress of Economists and Financiers **from April 1 to April 10, 2024.**

4.2.3. The third stage (final) (April 24-25, 2024) – defense of competitive works (scientific articles) of the international final of the Competition; determination of the winners of the Competition; rewarding _

The third stage is held between the finalists of the international final of the Competition through a public in-person defense of competitive works at a special meeting in the presence of members of the expert commission of this Competition. Defense of works remotely, using online communication, is carried out in agreement with the organizing committee of the Competition.

4.3. Based on the results of the Competition, the main organizer of the EEYF publishes a collection of scientific articles by the Competition finalists. The collection is published in the form of the corresponding chapter of the annual collection of EEYF materials no later than 4 months after the Competition. The collection of EEPM materials is posted in the RSCI, on the USUE website and on the EEPM website.

5. Registration of participants, requirements for submitted documentation and rules for registration of competitive works (scientific articles)

5.1 Scientific articles are submitted to the Competition in one of the areas of the competition:

- Current issues of modern economic theory.
- Macroeconomic analysis.
- Behavioral economics and economic psychology.
- Economic sociology.
- Economic Analysis of Law .

Competition works (scientific articles) are submitted to the Organizing Committee of the Competition in electronic form through a special registration form on the EEYF website [www . eurasia - forum . ru](http://www.eurasia-forum.ru) :

– participants of the main site of the Competition, when registering, choose: USUE Site – Congress of Economists and Financiers – competition “Modern Economic Theory and Social Development: Fundamental and Interdisciplinary Research” ;

– participants of foreign/regional platforms during registration choose: The name of the corresponding platform is the competition “Modern economic theory and social development: fundamental and interdisciplinary research.”

5.2. To participate in the Competition the following package of documents must be submitted:

- 1) the author’s application for participation in the Competition (Appendix 1) - submitted by filling out the participant’s registration form on the EEYF website;
- 2) competition work (scientific article), drawn up in accordance with the requirements of Appendix 2 - attached as a separate file to the participant’s registration form;


5.3. All documents must be submitted in a single package by **March 20, 2024** , or as otherwise indicated on the Competition page of the EEYF website.

The absence of any of the documents specified in clause 5.2. within the prescribed period is grounds for refusal of admission to participate in the Competition.

5.4. The competition entry must meet the following requirements:

- 1) the scientific article must correspond to the problems of the Competition and its thematic areas, corresponding to section 2 of the Regulations;
- 2) in a scientific article, it is necessary to have a reference apparatus: links to sources from which quotes are used, digital data in the text, tables, graphs, diagrams, bibliography (at least 5 sources);
- 3) the scientific article must be original, the percentage of originality of the text must be at least 70%;
- 4) the work must be formatted as follows: file in *.doc or *.rtf format, the name of the file must indicate the name of the author(s); line spacing 1.5 on A4 sheets, font Times New Roman, size – 14 pt, margins – 20 mm on each side; Sheet orientation is portrait. The text should be aligned in width without hyphenation. The length of the article is no more than 5 pages.

All charts and tables must be inserted into the text. The list of references (bibliography) is drawn up in accordance with GOST R 7.0.100-2018. Footnotes to the text are given in square brackets indicating the source number in the list of references.

Typical structure of a work (scientific article): introduction; purpose of the study; brief literature review; research methods; research results; conclusions; list of used literature.

The author's initials and surname should be printed at the top center of the page. The next line indicates the full name of the university (organization), then the city. Below, in the middle of the line, the title is indicated, then the abstract (at least 3 sentences) and keywords (no more than 5 words and phrases). Next is the text of the scientific article. At the end of the article, the initials and surname of the scientific supervisor, his academic degree and academic title are indicated.

6. Criteria for evaluating competition works (articles)

6.1. At the first stage of the Competition, the expert commission of the Competition admits competitive works (scientific articles) to participation in the qualifying round in accordance with the requirements specified in clause 5 of the Regulations.

6.2. Criteria for evaluating competitive works at the second (qualifying) stage:

- 1) paperwork – up to 10 points;
- 2) relevance of the research topic – up to 15 points;
- 3) novelty and originality of the research – up to 15 points;
- 4) content of the study: scientific, technical and economic feasibility of the proposed solutions; logic, scientific style and literacy of presentation; presence of applications, illustrations, graphic explanations of appropriate quality – up to 40 points;
- 5) practical significance of the research results, the possibility of testing and implementing the results obtained – 20 points.

Lists of finalists are posted on the Competition page. Information letters about reaching the finals are sent to the finalist participants.

If the finalist cannot personally take part in the final of the Competition, he is given the opportunity to publicly defend the competition work remotely, in the form of a webinar. If the finalist cannot take part in the final of the Competition remotely, the participant who took 16th place at the end of the second (qualifying) stage of the Competition is included in the finalists.


6.3. Criteria for evaluating participants during the full-time defense of a competitive work (scientific article) at the third (final) stage:

- 1) relevance of the research topic – up to 15 points;
- 2) novelty and originality of the research – up to 15 points;
- 3) significance of the research results – up to 20 points;
- 4) presentation – up to 20 points;
- 5) defense (answers to expert questions) – up to 30 points.

6.4. If the winners and prize-winners of the Competition have the same (equal) number of points, the decision to determine the winners and prize-winners is made by the Expert Commission of the Competition.

7. Winner's reward ceremony

7.1. Based on the results of the international final of the Competition, winners and prize-winners for the Competition as a whole are determined, they are awarded Diplomas of I, II, III degrees and large orders “Star of EurAsia” for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, respectively.

Participants who took 4th and 5th places in the Competition are awarded Certificates for 4th and 5th places, respectively.

All participants of the Competition receive certificates of Competition finalists in electronic form.

7.2. The winners and runners-up (2nd and 3rd place) of the international finals of the Competition are awarded cash prizes within the framework of the Competition prize fund, established on the basis of the order of the USUE Rector and in accordance with the minutes of the meetings of the Expert Commissions of the Competition.

Cash prizes (including payment of income tax) are transferred by the organizer of the Competition within 1.5 months to the personal accounts of winners and prize-winners using the details provided to the Competition coordinator, subject to the provision of copies (scans) of the following documents:

- printout from the bank’s personal account: bank details and personal account number for transferring money;
- a copy of the passport of the 1st and 2nd pages and the page with registration;
- a copy of the TIN or a printout of the TIN data from the website.

Cash prizes for foreign participants participating in the finals in person are issued at the USUE cash desk on the day of the award.

7.3. Participants who take 1st, 2nd and 3rd place at a foreign/regional site are awarded certificates for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in the national/regional round and small orders “Star of Eurasia”.

7.4. The awarding of all finalists of the Competition will take place as part of the final events of the XIV EEYF **on April 25, 2024** simultaneously at the USUE site and at foreign/regional Competition sites using online communication.

8. Management of the Competition on the USUE site

8.1. The Competition is managed by the EEYF Organizing Committee and the Competition Organizing Committee.

8.2. Chairman of the EEYF Organizing Committee - Rector of USUE:


- approves the Regulations on the Competition, signs the order on holding the Competition and the composition of the organizing committee of the Competition, the order on the composition of the expert commission of the Competition;
- carries out general management of the organization and conduct of EEYF events within the framework of which the Competition is held.

8.3. To organize and conduct the Competition, an organizing committee of the Competition is formed, consisting of:

- scientific director of the Competition;
- Competition coordinator;
- members of the expert committee of the Competition;
- representatives of organizations - partners of the Competition,
- Secretary(s) of the Competition.

8.4. Scientific director of the Competition:

- prepares the draft Regulations on the Competition, prepares amendments and additions to it;
- is the chairman (co-chairman) of the expert commission of the Competition;

– selects the composition of the expert commission of the Competition.

8.5. Competition Coordinator:

- ensures the invitation of members of the Expert Commission of the Competition;
- organizes the distribution of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and Eurasian countries;
- organizes registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of compliance of received competition documents with established requirements, sends competition works to members of expert commissions for evaluation;
- organizes and monitors the progress of the Competition;
- organizes the work of the expert commission during the international finals of the Competition;
- organizes the registration of diplomas, certificates and awarding of the winners and prize-winners of the Competition;
- organizes the collection of abstracts of competitive works of the Competition finalists and their transfer to the USUE Publishing House for inclusion in the collection of EEYF materials;
- organizes the collection of necessary documents for issuing cash prizes to the winners and prize-winners of the Competition;
- draws up a report on the Competition.

8.6. An expert commission of the Competition is created to conduct an expert assessment of competitive works.

The Chairman of the Expert Commission of the Competition is the Director of the EEYF Congress, where the competition is taking place. The co-chairman of the Expert Committee of the Competition is the scientific director of the Competition. The expert commission includes highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers, leading specialists from among the organizers of the EEYF, as well as invited experts. More than half of the members of the expert commission must be representatives of third-party organizations. Decisions of the expert commission are made by open voting, by a simple majority of votes of the members of the expert commission present, minutes are recorded, the minutes are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendices 4, 6).

Information on the composition of the organizing committee and expert commissions of the Competition is published annually on the Competition page of the EEYF website.

9. Management of the Competition at foreign/regional sites of the EEYF


1.1. The Competition is managed by the organizing committee of the foreign/regional EEYF site and the organizing committee of the Competition of the EEYF site.

1.2. The organizing committee of the EEYF Competition includes:

- Competition coordinator;
- an expert commission of the Competition consisting of at least 3 people from among highly qualified teaching and research workers of the university organizing the site, as well as invited experts.
- Secretary of the Competition.

1.3. Competition Coordinator:

- ensures the invitation of members of the expert commissions of the Competition;
- organizes the distribution of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations in their country or region of Russia;

– organizes registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of compliance of received competition documents with established requirements, sends competition works to members of expert commissions for evaluation;

– organizes the work of expert commissions during the qualifying round of the Competition;

– together with the organizing committee of the USUE site, organizes the departure of the winner of the qualifying round of the Competition to USUE to participate in the international finals of the Competition (1st place); as well as the participation of the contestants who took 2nd and 3rd place in the award procedure on April 25, 2024 at their Competition site;

– organizes the transfer of the thesis of the work of the winner of the national/regional round of the Competition to the Competition coordinator of the USUE site for inclusion in the collection of EEYF materials.

9.4. To conduct an expert assessment of the competition entries, an expert commission is created at the foreign/regional site of the Competition.

The composition of the expert foreign/regional commission of the Competition is approved by the organizing committee of the foreign/regional site. The expert commission includes highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers, leading specialists from among the organizers of the EEYF site, as well as invited experts. Decisions by the expert commission are made by open voting, by a simple majority of votes of the members of the expert commission present, minutes are recorded, the minutes are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendix 5).

Times font New Roman , font size 14 pt, line spacing – one and a half. All margins are 20 mm. The text is aligned in width with automatic hyphenation. Sheet orientation is portrait. Paragraph indent – 1.25. All charts and tables must be inserted into the text. The list of references is drawn up in accordance with GOST. Footnotes to the text are given in square brackets indicating the source number in the list of references.

The author's initials and surname should be printed at the top center of the page. The next line indicates the full name of the university (organization), then the city. Below, in the middle of the line, indicate the title, then keywords (no more than 5 words or phrases). Then the text is placed. At the end, the initials and surname of the scientific supervisor, his academic degree and academic title are indicated.
