1. General Provisions

1.1 These Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) govern the organisation and conduct of the International Essay Contest of young scientists and students "Modern Trends in Economic Development of the World" (hereinafter referred to as the Contest).

1.2 The Competition is held within the framework of the **Congress of Strategists** of the Eurasian Economic Forum for Youth (hereinafter referred to as EEYF) and is implemented at the main EEYF site - at the Ural State Economic University (hereinafter referred to as USUE site), as well as at foreign and regional EEYF sites that have chosen this Competition. The list of foreign and regional sites that have chosen this Contest is indicated on the page of the Contest of the Congress of Strategists of the EEYF website, as well as on the pages of the foreign/regional sites of the EEYF website.

The Internet address of the EEYF website is www.eurasia-forum.ru.

1.3 Organiser of the Competition: "Ural State University of Economics", Institute of Continuing and Distance Education (hereinafter referred to as the Organiser).

1.4 Co-organisers of the Competition:

Universities-organisers of foreign and regional EEYF sites that have chosen this Competition for implementation at their sites (hereinafter referred to as the Co-Organiser).

1.5 The aim of the competition is to create a platform for young scientists and specialists to discuss the problems of improving the quality of specialist training, increasing the interest of young scientists and students in their chosen profession, identifying gifted young people and forming human resources for research, administrative, industrial and entrepreneurial activities.

2. Scientific directions of the Competition

1.«Cross-cutting technologies of the digital economy».

2.«Multipolar world in focus of new reality».

3.«Current issues of forming the investment attractiveness of the country».

3. Participation conditions in the Competition

3.1. Students (students of colleges, technical schools, higher education institutions, postgraduate students) and young scientists (candidates for the degree of Candidate of Sciences, young researchers of universities, academic institutions of Russia and foreign countries) aged 18 to 35 are invited to participate in the Competition.

Essays prepared by young scientists - candidates of sciences are not accepted for the Competition.

3.2 **Individual essays are accepted for the Competition.** Essays written by a team of authors are not allowed to participate in the Competition.

3.3 One participant submits only one essay to the Competition.

3.4 There is no organisational fee for participation in the Competition. Accommodation, meals and transport costs for participants from other countries are paid by the participants themselves or by the sending organisations. Exceptions are the winners of foreign/regional venues of the Competition.

4. Stages and deadlines of the Competition



1. General Provisions

1.1 These Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) govern the organisation and conduct of the International Essay Contest of young scientists and students "Modern Trends in Economic Development of the World" (hereinafter referred to as the Contest).

1.2 The Competition is held within the framework of the **Congress of Strategists** of the Eurasian Economic Forum for Youth (hereinafter referred to as EEYF) and is implemented at the main EEYF site - at the Ural State Economic University (hereinafter referred to as USUE site), as well as at foreign and regional EEYF sites that have chosen this Competition. The list of foreign and regional sites that have chosen this Contest is indicated on the page of the Contest of the Congress of Strategists of the EEYF website, as well as on the pages of the foreign/regional sites of the EEYF website.

The Internet address of the EEYF website is www.eurasia-forum.ru.

1.3 Organiser of the Competition: "Ural State University of Economics", Institute of Continuing and Distance Education (hereinafter referred to as the Organiser).

1.4 Co-organisers of the Competition:

Universities-organisers of foreign and regional EEYF sites that have chosen this Competition for implementation at their sites (hereinafter referred to as the Co-Organiser).

1.5 The aim of the competition is to create a platform for young scientists and specialists to discuss the problems of improving the quality of specialist training, increasing the interest of young scientists and students in their chosen profession, identifying gifted young people and forming human resources for research, administrative, industrial and entrepreneurial activities.

2. Scientific directions of the Competition

1.«Cross-cutting technologies of the digital economy».

2.«Multipolar world in focus of new reality».

3.«Current issues of forming the investment attractiveness of the country».

3. Participation conditions in the Competition

3.1. Students (students of colleges, technical schools, higher education institutions, postgraduate students) and young scientists (candidates for the degree of Candidate of Sciences, young researchers of universities, academic institutions of Russia and foreign countries) aged 18 to 35 are invited to participate in the Competition.

Essays prepared by young scientists - candidates of sciences are not accepted for the Competition.

3.2 **Individual essays are accepted for the Competition.** Essays written by a team of authors are not allowed to participate in the Competition.

3.3 One participant submits only one essay to the Competition.

3.4 There is no organisational fee for participation in the Competition. Accommodation, meals and transport costs for participants from other countries are paid by the participants themselves or by the sending organisations. Exceptions are the winners of foreign/regional venues of the Competition.

4. Этапы и сроки проведения Конкурса



4.1 The Competition is an annual event and is held during the summer term. The final terms of the Competition, as well as its main stages, are set by the order of the Chairman of the EEYF Organising Committee, the Rector of USUE and are published on the Competition pages of the EEYF website.

4.2 The Competition shall be held in three stages.

4.2.1 **The first stage (until March 20, 2024 inclusive)** - acceptance and registration of competitive essays on the chosen direction of the Contest; checking of the works for compliance with the requirements to the works.

The first stage is conducted by the organising committees of the respective sites:

- the organising committee of the head site of UrSEU;
- Organising committees of foreign/regional sites.

If a foreign/regional site receives less than 10 competition essays, the Competition at this site is considered not to have taken place, and the received works participate in the competition of the head site of the USUE on general grounds.

4.2.2 **The second stage (selection stage) (from March 21 to April 1, 2024)** - examination of competitive essays registered and admitted to the Competition according to the results of the first stage. Determination of the Competition finalists from the USUE site and the Competition finalists from foreign/regional sites.

- Organisation of the qualifying stage at the USUE site

The examination of the competition essays submitted through the USUE site is carried out by the expert commission of the Competition of the USUE site. The Commission selects 15 to 20 finalists of the Competition in absentia. The lists of the finalists who have passed to the final of the Competition are published on the page of the Competition of the Congress of Strategists of the EEYF website.

- Organisation of qualifying stages at foreign/regional sites of the Competition

Expertise of competition essays at the EEYF sites is carried out by the expert commissions of the foreign/regional sites of the Competition. The expert commissions select 5-10 best participants of the national/regional round of the Competition. **On April 1, 2024**, the Organising Committee and the expert commissions of the foreign/regional sites of the Contest will hold an in-person defence and determine the winner and prize-winners of the national/regional round of the Contest.

The winner (first place) of the national/regional round of the Competition becomes a finalist of the international final of the Competition. He/she is given the opportunity to participate in the Competition Final and other final events of the XIV EEYF on **23-25 April 2024 in person**. Travel and accommodation expenses are provided by the main organiser of the EEYF - UrSEU.

The participants who took the 2nd and 3rd place at the foreign/regional venue will be solemnly awarded with certificates and memorable gifts on **April 25, 2024**.

The total list of finalists of the international final of the Competition is formed of the finalists from the USUE site and the winners of the foreign/regional sites that have chosen this Competition. The general list of finalists of the Competition is published on the EEYF website, on the page of the Congress of Strategists Competition.

4.2.3 **The third stage (final stage) (24-25 April 2024)** - defence of competitive essays of the international final of the Competition; determination of the winners of the Competition; awarding.



The third stage is held between the finalists of the international final of the Competition by means of a public in-person defence of the Competition essays. The defence of works remotely, using online communication, shall be held in agreement with the Competition Organising Committee.

4.3 According to the results of the final events, the collection of materials of the XIV EEYF will be published, where the essays of the Competition finalists will be placed. The collection will be published not later than 4 months after the Competition. The collection will be placed in RINC and on the website of the Ural State University of Economics (search at <https://science.usue.ru/nauchnye-meropriyatiya/sborniki-i-itogi>).

5. Registration of participants, requirements to the submitted Requirements for the documentation to be submitted and the rules of drawing up competition works (essays)

5.1 Works are submitted to the Competition in electronic form via a special registration form on the EEYF website www.eurasia-forum.ru.

5.1.1 The participants of the main site of the Competition choose during registration: USUE platform - Congress of Strategists - Competition "Modern Trends in Economic Development of the World";

5.1.2. Participants of foreign/regional sites when registering choose:
The name of the corresponding site - the competition "Modern Trends of Economic Development of the World".

5.2 To participate in the Contest, the following package of documents should be submitted:

1) the author's application for participation in the Competition (Annex 1) - submitted by filling in the registration form of the participant on the EEYF website.

2) competition work (essay) (according to the form of Appendix 2) - attached as a separate file to the participant's registration form;

5.3 All documents shall be submitted in a single package by 20 March 2024, or other deadline specified on the Competition page of the EEYF website.

5.4 The Competition work shall comply with the following requirements:

5.4.1. Essays corresponding to the declared theme: "Modern Trends of Economic Development of the World" and thematic directions of the Competition shall be accepted for the Competition:

– «Cross-cutting technologies of the digital economy».

– «Multipolar world in focus of new reality».

– «Current issues of forming the investment attractiveness of the country».

5.4.2. The essay must meet the requirements of the genre. The essay is a creative mini-essay (up to 3 A4 pages), in which the participant sets out his vision of the proposed topic, trying to substantiate it, based on existing trends in socio-economic development, as well as referring to facts gleaned from public or personal experience.

5.4.3. The essay is submitted as an author's product that does not contain either completely or partially elements of plagiarism.

5.5. Essay requirements

5.5.1. The essay must be written in Russian (or English);

5.5.2. The essay must be formatted in accordance with Annex 2;

5.5.3. The essay must indicate the main provisions and results of the work. No more than 3 pages. Files in *.doc (*.docx) or *.rtf format, titled with the author(s) surname(s) are accepted for consideration. A4 format. Font Times New Roman, size 14 pt, line spacing - one and a half. All fields - 20 mm. The text is justified in width with automatic hyphenation. Sheet orientation is portrait. Paragraph indent - 1.25. All charts and tables must be inserted into the text.



The initials and surname of the author(s) should be printed at the top of the page, centered. The next line contains the full name of the university (organization), then the city. Below, in the middle of the line, the title is indicated, then the keywords (no more than 5 words or phrases). Then comes the text. At the end, the initials and surname of the supervisor, his academic degree and academic title are indicated.

The list of literature is drawn up in accordance with GOST. Footnotes to the text are given in square brackets, indicating the number of the source in the list of references).

5.6. Essays that do not meet these requirements will not be considered. Essays are not reviewed or returned.

6. Criteria for evaluation of competition works (essays)

6.1 Essay evaluation criteria at the second (qualifying) stage:

1) understanding by the participant of the competition of the problem contained in the title of the topic, and the correspondence of the essay to the chosen topic.

Maximum Points – 2.

2) the personal nature of the perception of the problem and its comprehension (the essay should reveal the personal opinion of the author).

Maximum Points – 3.

3) argumentation of the author's point of view based on the facts of public life and personal social experience.

Maximum Points – 3.

4) clarity of structure, consistency, consistency of key theses and statements.

Maximum Points – 2.

5) literacy, compliance with language norms, diversity of lexical content.

Maximum Points – 10.

6.2. Essay evaluation criteria at the third (final) stage:

1) correspondence of the presentation to the content of the essay.

Maximum Points – 2.

2) quality of the report: structure (presentation in the presentation of all the constituent parts of the essay), logic, accessibility of presentation, literacy and scientific character of the speaker's speech, compliance with the rules.

Maximum Points – 2.

3) level of knowledge of the material: reproductive, productive.

Maximum Points – 2.

4) effectiveness of interaction with the audience: answers to questions, dialogue, debatability.

Maximum Points – 2.

5) the level of multimedia support: the correspondence of the presentation to the content of the essay and the content of the report, the quality of the presentation design.

Maximum Points – 2.

6.3. The maximum possible number of points that a participant in the Competition can receive is 30. The decision of the expert commission is made by calculating the sum of points scored in the qualifying round and in the final. In case of equal points, the decision is made by open voting.



7. Awarding of the Competition winners

7.1. According to the results of the final stage, the winners and prize-winners of the Competition are determined. Winners and prize-winners of the Competition are awarded Diplomas of I, II, III degree and large orders "Star of EurAsia" for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place respectively.

Participants who took the 4th and 5th places of the Competition are awarded with Diplomas for the 4th and 5th places respectively.

All participants of the Competition final will receive electronic certificates of the Competition finalists.

Other participants, if they wish, receive certificates of the Contest participant. The leaders of the Competition finalists are awarded with letters of thanks.

7.2 The winners and runners-up are awarded with money prizes within the Contest prize fund established on the basis of the order of the Rector of USUE and in accordance with the final protocol of the Contest expert committee.

Cash prizes (including income tax) are transferred by the Competition organiser within 1.5 months to the personal accounts of the winners and prize-winners according to the details provided to the Competition coordinator, provided that the following documents are submitted to the Competition organiser :

- printout from the bank's personal cabinet: bank details and personal account number, for money transfer;
- copy of the passport 1st, 2nd page and the page with residence registration;
- copy of Taxpayer Identification Number or printout of Taxpayer Identification Number data from the Internet site.

Cash prizes for foreign participants are given at the cash desk of USUE on the day of awarding.

8. Competition management at the USUE site

8.1. Management of the Competition is carried out by the EEYF Organising Committee and the Competition Organising Committee.

8.2. The Chairman of the EEYF Organising Committee - Rector of UrSEU:

- approves the Regulations on the Competition, signs the order on holding the Competition and the composition of the Competition Organising Committee, the order on the composition of the Competition Expert Commission;

- carries out general management of the organisation and conduct of EEYF events, within the framework of which the Competition is held.

8.3 To organise and conduct the Competition, the Competition Organising Committee shall be formed, consisting of:

- the scientific director of the Competition;
- Competition coordinator;
- members of the expert commission of the Competition;
- representatives of organisations - partners of the Competition,
- Secretary of the Competition.



8.4 The Scientific Director of the Competition:

- prepares a draft of the Competition Regulations, amendments and additions thereto;
- is the Chairman (co-chairman) of the Competition Expert Committee;
- selects the composition of the Competition Expert Commission.

8.5 The Competition Coordinator:

- ensures the invitation of members of the Competition expert committee;
- organises distribution of information letters to educational, research and scientific organisations of the Russian Federation and Eurasian countries;
 - organises registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of the compliance of the received competition documents with the established requirements, sends the competition works to the members of the expert committee for evaluation;
 - organises and controls the course of the Competition;
 - organises the work of the expert commission during the international final of the Competition;
 - organises the drawing up of diplomas, certificates and awarding of the winners and prize-winners of the Competition;
 - organises the submission of the finalists' essays to the USUE Publishing House for inclusion in the EEYF collection of materials;
 - organises the collection of necessary documents for issuing cash prizes to the winners and prize-winners of the Competition;
 - draws up a report on the Competition.

8.6. An expert commission of the Competition shall be set up to carry out the expert evaluation of the competition works.

The Chairman of the Competition Expert Committee is the Director of the EEYF Congress, where the Competition takes place. The Co-Chairman of the Competition Expert Commission is the Scientific Director of the Competition. The Expert Commission consists of highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers, leading specialists from among the EEYF organisers, as well as invited experts. More than half of the members of the Expert Commission shall be representatives of external organisations. The decisions of the Expert Commission are taken by open voting, by a simple majority of votes of the present members of the Expert Commission, are recorded, the minutes are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the Expert Commission (Annexes 3, 5).

Information on the composition of the Competition Organising Committee and Expert Commission is published annually on the Competition page of the EEYF website.

7.1. Management of the Competition on foreign/regional EEYF sites

8.1. The Competition is managed by the Organising Committee of the foreign/regional EEYF site and the Organising Committee of the Competition of the EEYF site.

8.2. The EEYF site Competition Organising Committee shall consist of:

- the coordinator of the Competition;
- the expert commission of the Competition consisting of at least 3 persons from among highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers of the university-organiser of the site, as well as invited experts.– секретарь Конкурса.



9.3 The Competition Coordinator:

- ensures the invitation of members of the Competition expert committee;
- organises mailing of information letters to educational, research and scientific organisations of his/her country or region of Russia;
- organises registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of the compliance of the received competition documents with the established requirements, sends the competition works to the members of the expert commissions for evaluation;
- organises the work of expert commissions during the qualifying round of the Competition;
- together with the USUE site organising committee organises the departure of the winner of the national/regional round of the Competition to USUE to participate in the international final of the Competition (1st place);
- organises the transfer of the abstracts (essay) of the winner's work (essay) to the Competition coordinator of the USUE site for inclusion in the EEYF collection of materials.

9.4. An expert commission of the Foreign/Regional Site Competition shall be established to carry out expert evaluation of the competition entries.

The composition of the expert commission of the foreign/regional competition is approved by the Organising Committee of the foreign/regional site. The expert commission includes highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers, leading specialists from among the organisers of the EEYF platform, as well as invited experts, including, upon agreement, the scientific director of the Competition.

Decisions of the Expert Commission shall be taken by open voting, by a simple majority of votes of the present members of the Expert Commission, shall be recorded, the minutes shall be signed by the Chairman, Secretary and members of the Expert Commission (Annex 4).
