1. General Provisions

1.1. These Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) govern the procedure for organizing and conducting the International Contest of scientific essays "Ways to protect human and civil rights and freedoms" (hereinafter referred to as the Contest).

1.2. The Contest shall be held within the framework of the Congress of Strategists of the Eurasian Economic Forum for Youth (hereinafter referred to as EEYF) and shall be realized at the main EEYF site - at the Ural State Economic University (hereinafter referred to as USEU site), as well as at foreign and regional sites that have chosen this Contest. The list of foreign and regional sites, which have chosen this Contest, is indicated on the page of the Contest of the Congress of Strategists of the EEYF site, as well as on the pages of foreign/regional sites of the EEYF site.

The Internet address of the EEYF website is www.eurasia-forum.ru.

1.3. Organizer of the Contest Ural State University of Economics (USEU), Department of Constitutional and International Law.

1.4 Co-organizers of the Competition:

Universities-organizers of foreign and regional EEYF sites that have chosen this competition for implementation at their sites.

1.4. Partners of the Competition:

- The Charter Court of the Sverdlovsk Region;
- Novosibirsk State University of Economics and Management "NINH" (NSUEM).

1.5. The purpose of the competition is to realize the creative potential of young people in solving the problems of improving and developing the current legislation; to increase the interest of young people in the problems of protecting the rights and freedoms of citizens; to promote the realization of the rights of citizens to judicial protection; to involve young people in public administration through their participation in the discussion of current legal problems; to promote the dissemination and development of legal culture among young people; to select promising projects for the preparation of lawmaking initiatives; to select the first legal drafts of lawmaking initiatives.

1.6. Objectives of the competition:

- To identify the analytical potential of young lawyers, economists and managers;
- to stimulate the process of exchange of knowledge, ideas and experience in the use of mechanisms of legal regulation of social relations;
- to ensure the integration of youth science with the global research environment.

2. Competition Scientific directions

2.1. The contest accepts essays that correspond to the theme of the Competition: "Ways to protect human and civil rights and freedoms" and the scientific direction of the Competition.

2.2. Competition Scientific directions:

1. "Realization and protection of the rights of citizens in the field of education".
2. "Tactics of working with a client in human rights activities."
3. "Realization and protection of the rights of juveniles on the Internet".



3. Participation conditions in the Competition

3.1. Students of educational organizations, academic institutions and other interested organizations in Russia and foreign countries under the age of 35 years old (hereinafter referred to as Participants) are invited to participate in the Competition.

Works prepared by young scientists - graduate students and candidates of sciences, are not accepted for the competition.

3.2. One participant (one team) has the right to submit only one essay to the Competition.

3.3. Essays of participants who do not meet these requirements will not be accepted for participation in the competition.

3.4. There is no registration fee for participation in the competition. Expenses for accommodation of non-resident participants, food and transportation costs for participation in the full-time stage of the competition are paid by the participants themselves, or by sending organizations.

4. Stages and deadlines of the Competition

4.1 The Competition is an annual event and is held during the summer term. The final terms of the Competition, as well as its main stages, are set by the order of the Chairman of the EEYF Organising Committee, the Rector of USUE and are published on the Competition pages of the EEYF website.

4.2 The Competition shall be held in three stages.

4.2.1 **The first stage (until March, 20 2024)** - acceptance and registration of competitive essays on the chosen direction of the Contest; checking of the works for compliance with the requirements to the works.

The first stage is conducted by the organising committees of the respective sites:

- the organising committee of the head site of UrSEU;
- Organising committees of foreign/regional sites.

If a foreign/regional site receives less than 10 competition essays, the Competition at this site is considered not to have taken place, and the received works participate in the competition of the head site of the USUE on general grounds.


4.2.2 **The second stage (selection stage) (from March 211 to April 1, 2024)** - examination of competitive essays registered and admitted to the Competition according to the results of the first stage. Determination of the Competition finalists from the USUE site and the Competition finalists from foreign/regional sites.

- Organisation of the qualifying stage at the USUE site

The examination of the competition essays submitted through the USUE site is carried out by the expert commission of the Competition of the USUE site. The Commission selects 15 to 20 finalists of the Competition in absentia. The lists of the finalists who have passed to the final of the Competition are published on the page of the Competition of the Congress of Strategists of the EEYF website.

- Organisation of qualifying stages at foreign/regional sites of the Competition

Expertise of competition essays at the EEYF sites is carried out by the expert commissions of the foreign/regional sites of the Competition. The expert commissions select 5-10 best participants of the national/regional round of the Competition. On **April 1, 2024**, the Organising Committee and the expert

commissions of the foreign/regional sites of the Contest will hold a face-to-face defence and determine the winner and prize-winners of the national/regional round of the Contest.

The winner (first place) of the national/regional round of the Competition becomes a finalist of the international final of the Competition. He/she is given the opportunity to participate in the Competition Final and other final events of the XIV EEYF on **April 23-25, 2024** in person. The main organiser of the EEYF - USUE - will provide travel and accommodation expenses.

The participants, who **took the 2nd and 3rd place** at the foreign/regional venue, will be solemnly awarded with certificates and memorable gifts on **April 25, 2024**.

The total list of finalists of the international final of the Competition is formed of the finalists from the USUE site and the winners of the foreign/regional sites that have chosen this Competition. The general list of finalists of the Competition is published on the EEYF website, on the page of the Congress of Strategists Competition.

4.2.3 The third stage (final stage) (April 2024 24-25) - defence of competitive essays of the international final of the Competition; determination of the winners of the Competition; awarding.

The third stage is held between the finalists of the international final of the Competition by means of a public in-person defence of the Competition essays. The defence of works remotely, using online communication, shall be held in agreement with the Competition Organising Committee.

4.3 According to the results of the final events, the collection of materials of the XIV EEYF will be published, where the essays of the Competition finalists will be placed. The collection will be published not later than 4 months after the Competition. The collection will be placed in RINC and on the website of the Ural State University of Economics (search at <https://science.usue.ru/nauchnyemeropriyatiya/sborniki-i-itogi>).

5.Registration of participants, requirements for the documentation to be submitted

Documentation requirements and essay rules

5.1. Essays are submitted to the Organizing Committee of the Competition in electronic form through a special registration form on the EEYF website www.eurasia-forum.ru.

5.1.1. Participants of the main site of the Competition choose during registration:

USUE platform - Congress of Strategists - Competition "Modern Trends in Economic Development of the World";

5.1.2. Participants of foreign/regional platforms choose when registering:

The name of the relevant site - the competition "Modern Trends in Economic Development of the World".

5.2. The following package of documents should be submitted for participation in the Competition:

1) the author's application for participation in the Competition (Annex 1) - submitted by filling in the registration form of the participant on the EEYF website.

2) competition work (essay) (title page in the form of Annex 2) - attached as a separate file to the registration form of the participant;

5.3. All documents shall be submitted in a single package by March 20, 2024, or other deadline specified on the Competition page of the EEYF website

5.4. The essay must meet the following requirements:

– Essay volume - from 2 to 3 pages of computer text, no more than 2500 characters with spaces;



- the essay must correspond to one of the topics;
- the essay written by the participant should reveal the issues, as well as contain practical innovative ideas for the development of the protection of human and civil rights and freedoms within the framework of the chosen topic.

6. Criteria for evaluation of competition works (essays)

6.1. Criteria for evaluating competitive works at the second (qualifying) stage:

- 1) Correspondence of the content to the chosen topic - 10 points;
- 2) Completeness of disclosure of the chosen topic - 10 points;
- 3) The presence in the work of the position of its author - 10 points;
- 4) Argumentation of the proposed thesis of the work - 10 points;
- 5) The presence in the work of practical ideas for the development of a system for protecting the rights and freedoms of human and citizen - 10 points;
- 6) General erudition, knowledge in the field of law - 10 points;
- 7) Creativity - author's elements in the work, original approach to the presentation of material - 10 points;
- 8) Clarity and consistency of presentation - 10 points;
- 9) Validity of conclusions - 10 points;
- 10) Speech design of the essay and semantic integrity - 10 points

6.2. During the third (final) stage, members of the expert commissions fill out an expert list for each finalist of the Competition.

Criteria for evaluating participants during full-time defense of work at the third (final) stage:

- 1) logical and persuasive presentation - up to 10 points
- 2) presentation - up to 10 points;
- 3) defense (answers to experts' questions) - up to 30 points.

6.3. To determine the results, the scores of the qualifying and final stages are summed up. The maximum total score is 150 points.

7. Rewarding the winners

7.1. According to the results of the in-person defence, the winners and prize-winners of the Competition are determined, they are awarded Diplomas of I, II, III degree and orders for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place respectively.

Participants who took 4th and 5th places are awarded with Diplomas for 4th and 5th places respectively.

All participants of the Competition final receive electronic certificates of the Competition finalists.

Other participants will be sent electronic certificates of the Competition participant.

Supervisors of the Competition finalists are awarded with letters of thanks..



7.2. Winners and prize-winners of the Competition are awarded with money prizes within the framework of the Competition prize fund established on the basis of the order of the Rector of USUE and in accordance with the final protocol of the Competition Expert Committee.

Cash prizes (including income tax) are transferred by the Competition organiser within 1.5 months to the personal accounts of the winners and prize-winners according to the details provided to the Competition coordinator, provided that the following documents are submitted to the Competition organiser:

- printout from the bank's personal cabinet: bank details and personal account number, for money transfer;
- copy of the passport 1st, 2nd page and the page with residence registration;
- copy of Taxpayer Identification Number or printout of Taxpayer Identification Number data from the Internet site.

Cash prizes for foreign participants are given at the cash desk of USUE on the day of awarding.

8. Management of the Competition at the USUE site

8.1. Management of the Competition is carried out by the EEYF Organising Committee and the Competition Organising Committee.

8.2. The Chairman of the EEYF Organising Committee - Rector of UrSEU:

- approves the Regulations on the Competition, signs the order on holding the Competition and the composition of the Competition Organising Committee, the order on the composition of the Competition Expert Commission;

- carries out general management of the organisation and conduct of EEYF events, within the framework of which the Competition is held.

8.3 To organise and conduct the Competition, the Competition Organising Committee shall be formed, consisting of:

- the scientific director of the Competition;
- Competition coordinator;
- members of the expert commission of the Competition;
- representatives of organisations - partners of the Competition,
- Secretary of the Competition.

8.4 The Scientific Director of the Competition:

- prepares a draft of the Competition Regulations, amendments and additions thereto;
- is the chairman (co-chairman) of the Competition Expert Committee;
- selects the composition of the Competition Expert Commission.

8.5 The Competition Coordinator:

- ensures the invitation of members of the Competition expert committee;
- organises distribution of information letters to educational, research and scientific organisations of the Russian Federation and Eurasian countries;
- organises registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of the compliance of the received competition documents with the established requirements, sends the competition works to the members of the expert committee for evaluation;
- organises and controls the course of the Competition;
- organises the work of the expert commission during the international final of the Competition;

- organises the drawing up of diplomas, certificates and awarding of the winners and prize-winners of the Competition;
- organises the submission of the finalists' essays to the USUE Publishing House for inclusion in the EEYF collection of materials;
- organises the collection of necessary documents for issuing cash prizes to the winners and prize-winners of the Competition;
- draws up a report on the Competition.

8.6. An Competition Expert Committee shall be established to carry out expert evaluation of the Competition entries.

The Chairman of the Expert Committee of the Competition is the Director of the EEYF Congress, where the Competition is held. The co-chairman of the Competition Expert Commission is the scientific director of the Competition. The Expert Commission consists of highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers, leading specialists from among the EEYF organisers, as well as invited experts. More than half of the members of the Expert Commission shall be representatives of external organisations. The decisions of the Expert Commission are taken by open voting, by a simple majority of votes of the present members of the Expert Commission, are recorded, the minutes are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the Expert Commission (Annexes 3, 5).

Information on the composition of the Competition Organising Committee and Expert Commission is published annually on the Competition page of the EEYF website.

9. Competition management at foreign/regional EEYF sites

9.1 The Competition is managed by the Organising Committee of the foreign/regional EEYF site and the Organising Committee of the EEYF site Competition.


9.2. The Organising Committee of the EEYF platform Competition consists of:

- the Coordinator of the Competition;
- the expert commission of the Competition consisting of at least 3 persons from among highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers of the university-organiser of the site, as well as invited experts.

- Secretary of the Competition.

9.3 The Coordinator of the Competition:

- ensures the invitation of the members of the expert commission of the Competition;
- organises the mailing of information letters to educational, research and scientific organisations in his/her country or region of Russia;
- organises registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of the compliance of the received competition documents with the established requirements, sends the competition works to the members of the expert commissions for evaluation;
- organises the work of expert commissions during the qualifying round of the Competition;
- together with the USUE site organising committee organises the departure of the winner of the national/regional round of the Competition to USUE to participate in the international final of the Competition (1st place);
- organises the transfer of the thesis (essay) of the winner of the Competition to the coordinator of the Competition of the USUE site for inclusion in the collection of materials of the EEFM.

9.4. An Expert Commission of the Foreign/Regional Site Competition shall be established to carry out expert evaluation of the competition entries.

The composition of the expert commission of the foreign/regional competition is approved by the Organising Committee of the foreign/regional site. The expert commission includes highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers, leading specialists from among the organisers of the EEYF platform, as well as invited experts, including, upon agreement, the scientific director of the Competition.

Decisions of the Expert Commission shall be taken by open voting, by a simple majority of votes of the present members of the Expert Commission, shall be recorded, the minutes shall be signed by the Chairman, Secretary and members of the Expert Commission (Annex 4).
