REGULATIONS

For the student competitions in the field of computer sports
«Eurasia Student E-sports 2025»

**Yekaterinburg
2025**

1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

1.1 The student computer sport competition "Eurasia Esports 2025" (hereinafter referred to as the Competition) is held as part of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum with the aim of further promoting and developing the sport of computer sports among students.

1.2 The competitions are conducted in accordance with the rules of the sport of computer sport, approved by the Order of the Ministry of Sport of the Russian Federation No. 22 dated January 22, 2020, as amended by Orders of the Ministry No. 335 dated April 30, 2020, No. 615 dated July 25, 2022, and No. 1178 dated August 12, 2022 and No. 940 of December 1, 2023.

1.4 The number-code of the sport: 1240002411.

1.5 The objectives of the competitions are:

a) Identification of the strongest athletes among students to form sports teams from educational institutions in the field of computer sport.

b) Improving the sports skills of students through the sport of "computer sport".

1.6 Within the framework of these competitions, organizers shall ensure:

- The prohibition of any illegal influence on the outcome of sports events included in this competition;

- A ban on gambling activities in bookmakers and betting shops by betting on official sporting events in accordance with requirements set out in paragraph 3 of part 4 of article 26.2 of federal law No. 329-FZ of 04 December 2007 on Physical Culture and Sport in the Russian Federation.

1.7 This regulation is a challenge for the competition (basis for participation, including participation of athletes, coaches, and other stakeholders in the field of physical culture and sport).

2. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF ORGANIZERS OF SPORTS COMPETITIONS

2.1 The organizers of the sporting event are the Sverdlovsk regional branch of the All-Russian public organization "Russian Computer Sports Federation" (hereafter referred to as the "Federation") and the Federal State-Funded Educational Institution of Higher Learning "Ural State Economic University" (hereafter USUE).

2.2 The allocation of other rights and responsibilities, including liability for any harm caused to event participants and/or third parties, will be carried out based on the regulations for each sporting event between the Federation and USUE. Where such allocation is based on an agreement, details of that agreement (including the agreement number and date) will be included in the rules for the particular sporting event.

2.3 USUE will be responsible for ensuring public order and safety measures in accordance with Russian Federation legislation.

2.4 USUE is responsible for providing the necessary infrastructure and technical facilities on the premises that will be used for the sporting event in accordance with regulations for ensuring safety during official sporting events.

2.5 The Federation and USUE must prevent participants and event staff from displaying symbols of foreign countries and territories that have engaged in unfriendly actions against the Russian Federation, Russian entities, and individuals included in a list approved by the Government of Russia's Decree No. 430-r of May 3, 2022. This includes the use of material objects with names, state symbols, geographic boundaries of such countries and territories, and other images that identify these countries and territories.

2.6 The competition will be directly managed by the judging panel in charge of the "computer sports" category: Akubekov Konstantin Sergeevich as chief judge and Kushnarev Igor Sergeevich as chief secretary.

3. ENSURING THE SAFETY OF PARTICIPANTS AND SPECTATORS, MEDICAL SUPPORT, ANTI-DOPING PROVISION OF SPORTS COMPETITIONS

3.1 Sports competitions are conducted in accordance with Federal Law No. 329-FZ of December 4, 2007, "On Physical Culture and Sport in the Russian Federation."

Sports events may be held at venues for official sporting events that have the required infrastructure, video surveillance systems to identify individuals while they are at the venue of official sporting events, and technical equipment in compliance with the regulations for ensuring safety during official sporting events in accordance with paragraph 9 of article 37, "sports facilities," of 329-FZ.

3.2 Ensuring the safety of participants and spectators at sporting events is carried out in compliance with the requirements of the Regulations for Ensuring Safety During Official Sporting Events, approved by Resolution of the Government of the Russian Federation No. 353 of April 18, 2014.

3.3 The provision of emergency medical assistance is carried out in accordance with the regulations of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation, dated October 23, 2020, No. 1144n, "On Approval of the Procedure for Organizing Medical Care for Persons Engaged in Physical Culture and Sports (including During the Preparation and Conduct of Physical Education and Sports Events), Including the Procedure for Medical Examination of Persons Wishing to Undergo Sports Training, Engage in Physical Education and Sports in Organizations and (or) Comply with the Standards of Tests (Tests) of the All-Russian Physical Culture and Sports Complex "Ready for Work and Defense" ("GTO") and Forms of Medical Certificates on Admission to Participate in Physical Culture and Sports Events."

The eligibility of an individual involved in sports for participating in sports competitions requires the presentation of a medical certification confirming their fitness to compete. This certification is to be included in the application form for participation in the competition. Next to each athlete's name in the application, there should be a mark indicating "Eligible", which must be certified by the signature and seal of a sports medicine physician.

The application for participation must be signed by the sports medicine physician with their full name and, if applicable, their patronymic, and it must be stamped with the seal of the medical organization authorized to provide medical services related to physical therapy and sports medicine.

3.4 Participation in competitions shall only be undertaken if there is a valid insurance policy (covering sudden, unforeseeable events leading to treatment in a healthcare facility, disability, or death of the insured) provided to the relevant authorities for each competitor. This insurance may be funded through both budgetary and non-budgetary sources, in accordance with current Russian legislation.

3.6 Anti-doping measures for sports competitions shall be implemented in accordance with All-Russian Anti-Doping Regulations approved by Ministry of Sports Order No. 464 dated June 24, 2021.

In order to implement the measures outlined in the National Plan to Combat Doping in Russian Sport, as adopted by the Independent Public Anti-Doping Commission on 1st February 2017 and approved by Order of the Government of the Russian Federation No. 1456-r dated 07 October 2017, athletes and coaches participating in competitions must have a certificate confirming their knowledge of anti-doping regulations.

3.6 The requirements of these regulations are detailed in the regulations of specific sporting events and cannot conflict with them. Regulations for regional and inter-municipal sporting events are developed by federations individually for each event and approved by both the federation and other organizers. If the organizers of multiple regional and inter-municipal events are the same, a single regulation may be established for those events.

3.7. In compliance with the regulations on the organization and conduct of official sports events in the Russian Federation during the continued risk of COVID-19 transmission, as approved by the Ministry of Sports and the Chief Sanitary Officer of Russia on July 31, 2020 and other methodological guidelines established by the Federal Consumer Rights Protection Service, the Federation will:

Monitor the use of face masks by participants and event staff, except during competitive and training periods (for athletes), and also monitor the use of protective gear by participants.

Ensure compliance with a 1.5-meter social distancing between participants (athletes, staff, etc.).

Award prizes without tactile contact, while maintaining social distancing.

The event organizer, USUE, is responsible for ensuring that all participants and team representatives comply with the regulations set by the Ministry of Sports of the Russian Federation and Rospotrebnadzor. In particular, this includes:

- Conducting regular briefings with team representatives to emphasize the importance of adhering to the requirements set by the relevant authorities.

- Immediately informing team representatives in the event of any health-related issues or deviations from the prescribed protocols, including the use of personal protective equipment.

USUE also has a responsibility to ensure compliance with the following methodological recommendations issued by relevant authorities:

1. MR 3.1/2.1.0184-20: Recommendations on the organization of sports activities in the context of ongoing risks associated with the spread of COVID-19.

2. MR 3.1/2.1.0192-20: Guidelines for preventing the spread of the new coronavirus infection in sports and recreational facilities (including open and closed sporting venues, sports complexes, swimming pools, and fitness centers).

These guidelines include measures such as:

- Implementing temperature screening for participants and staff using non-contact thermometers upon entry to the facility.

The organization provides conditions for the hygienic treatment of hands using skin antiseptics in sports facilities and competition venues. Before the opening of a sports facility, and on a daily basis, it

conducts general cleaning of premises and treatment of sports equipment using disinfectants that are active against viruses. It also airs the premises every two hours and after competitions.

The organization carries out disinfection treatments every two hours in changing rooms, restrooms, and contact surfaces (such as handrails, door handles, and railings). It also restricts the entry of persons who are not involved in the competitive process into the sports facility's territory, including spectators.

5.1. THE MANAGEMENT OF THE COMPETITION. ENSURING SECURITY

5.1.1 The organizers of the competition are the Sverdlovsk regional branch of the All-Russian Public Organization "Russian Computer Sports Federation", represented by USUE.

5.1.5 Responsibility for ensuring the safety of participants and spectators during the event lies with USUE and the Sverdlovsk Regional Branch of the All-Russian Public Organization.

6. FINANCING

6.1 USUE provides financial support for competitions in accordance with the "Norms of expenditure on physical education and sports events included in the calendar of official physical education and sporting events in the Sverdlovsk Region" in terms of awarding prizes, compensation payments to the judging panel for meals based on estimates submitted by the federation.

6.2 USUE incurs expenses for organizing medical support, purchasing office supplies, renting sports facilities, ensuring public order and safety, as well as other costs associated with organizing and hosting competitions.

6.3 The general prize fund sponsor is PJSC UBRiR.

6.4 The costs of sending participants, coaches, and representatives are borne by their sending organizations (including transportation, accommodation, daily allowance, and insurance for participants).

7. CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION OF PARTICIPANTS AND SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

7.1. Preliminary applications for participation in the sports competition should be submitted by email: 66@ro.resf.ru, three days prior to the start of the event. Registration for the competition can be accessed via the following link: <http://www.bumbum.ru/registration.php?event=150498>

7.2. Confirmation of registration can be obtained on the day of the event via the Telegram chat.

7.3. Participants must provide the following documents to a.a.strashkov@usue.ru:

- Passport of a citizen of the Russian Federation or birth certificate
- Original contract of life insurance and health insurance for accidents
- Original copy of compulsory medical insurance
- If necessary, due to the current epidemiological situation, participants may need to provide a medical certificate confirming a negative laboratory test result for COVID-19.

8. THE COMPETITION PROGRAM

8.1 The venue for the competition will be online (at participants' home locations).

8.2 The meeting of the judging panel will be held on December 4, 2025 at 8:00 pm, online.

8.3 The meeting of the admissions committee will be held December 4, 2025, at 7:30 pm online.

8.4 The draw of participants will be held at 8:30 p.m. on December 4, 2025 online.

8.5 The schedule for the qualifications for the sports event is December 4–5, 2025 from 10:00 a.m. online.

8.6 The schedule for the finals of the sporting event is December 22, 2025 at the USUE Arena at 10:00 am.m.

8.7 Competitions in all events will be conducted online using the Telegram platform. Participants are required to install the Telegram app on a computer, tablet, or phone. After installation, participants must obtain a link to join the "Eurasia Esports 2025 Student" group. Upon logging in to the chat, participants will follow the instructions of a judge. The final round of competition will be held at the USUE Arena.

After the completion of the game, the outcome must be reported to the referee in order to be entered into the competition record. The winner of the match shall provide the referee with the outcome and a confirmation screen capture or replay.

9. CLASSIFICATION OF COMPETITIONS

9.1. The competitions are personal and are held in the following disciplines:

10. REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPANTS OF THE COMPETITION, ADMISSION CONDITIONS

10.1 The competition is open to students and graduates of universities, with no restrictions on sports training.

10.2 Athletes aged 14 and over are eligible to compete in age groups in accordance with the European Basketball Confederation (EBC).

10.3 Athletes participating in individual competitions are permitted to enter competitions in the real-time strategy discipline.

11. SUMMING UP CONDITIONS

11.1 The results of the competition shall be determined in accordance with the rules of the respective sport and the regulations of the competition.

11.2 The Federation shall, within 10 days of the completion of the competition, provide a report to the Main Judging Panel (GSK), including:

- A complete set of protocols
- A list of judges indicating their judicial category and position
- A list of participants, including their affiliation with a sports school/club, city, and other relevant information, as per the USUE requirements.

The documents shall be signed by the Chief Judge of the Competition.

12. AWARDING

12.1 Participants who take first, second, and third place in each sporting event will be awarded with certificates and medals.

12.2 The total prize pool for the tournament is 25,000 RUB.

- 13,000 RUB for first place
- 7,000 RUB for second place
- 5,000 RUB for third place

12.3 The award ceremony will take place at the Ural State University of Economics on March 8, 2022, in Yekaterinburg. The exact date and time will be determined by the organizing committee of the Eurasia Economic Youth Forum.

12.4 Funds will be transferred to winners' (medalists') bank accounts within two months of receiving their personal information, which they will provide via email at a.a.strashkov@usue.ru, in accordance with Russian Federation regulations for transferring funds to individuals.
