about the International Competition of Scientific Research Projects "We choose a life without addictions"

Yekaterinburg 2025



1. General regulations

1.1. This Regulation (hereinafter referred to as the Regulation) regulates the procedure for organizing and conducting the International Competition of Scientific Research Projects "We choose life without addictions" (hereinafter referred to as the Competition). The competition is held within the framework of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter referred to as the EEYF) and is implemented at the head site of the EEYF — at the Ural State University of Economics (hereinafter referred to as the USUE site). The Internet address of the EEYF website <u>www.eurasia-forum.ru</u>

1.2. The organizer of the Competition: Ural State University of Economics (USUE), unified laboratory complex of USUE.

1.3. The purpose and objectives of the Competition:

1.3.1. The purpose of the Competition is to promote a healthy lifestyle without addictions and to involve young people and children in the fight against harmful hobbies such as narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, tobacco, Internet addiction, food addiction.

1.3.2. The objectives of the Competition are:

• Describe the popularization of the values of a healthy lifestyle.

• Creation by the participants of the competition of a video clip of a social nature aimed at developing skills among young people that contribute to personal development as an element of prevention of manifestations of dependent behavior.

• To actualize the interest of young researchers in the problems of personal responsibility of a person for their health, future and life.

• To identify the attraction of public attention to the problem of dependent and codependent behavior.

• To share knowledge, ideas, and experience in using research tools;

• Drawing attention to the problem of youth dependence on psychoactive substances and implementing measures to prevent drug addiction among students of educational institutions of higher education through the organization of events involving young people in activities aimed at preventing addictive behavior;

• Promotion of a healthy lifestyle among students of educational institutions of higher education.

• Development and realization of students' creative abilities.

• To offer scientific and practical recommendations on creating additional conditions for the re-socialization of addicts and the prevention of drug addiction disorders.

2. Scientific directions (nominations) The competition

2.1. The competition is held in 3 nominations:

1) The best research project on the effects of narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, tobacco, Internet addiction on the physical development and health of adolescents and youth, their prevention.

2) The best research video, which is of a social nature and aimed at developing skills among young people that contribute to personal development as an element of prevention of manifestations of dependent behavior.



3) The best model of prevention in case of food toxicoinfection, in case of food poisoning (demonstration in the form of an experiment). The Expert Committee of the Competition has the right to allocate additional special nominations.

3. Conditions of participation in the Competition

3.1. Students, undergraduates, postgraduates, young scientists of educational institutions of higher education, academic institutes and other interested organizations of Russia and foreign countries under the age of 35 are invited to participate in the Competition (hereinafter referred to as Participants). Projects prepared by young scientists - candidates of sciences are not accepted for the competition.

3.2. Research projects for the Competition can be submitted from individual authors or from creative teams (teams of up to 3 people).

3.3. One participant (one team) has the right to submit only one project to the Competition.

3.4. The authors independently decide on which scientific direction (nomination) the project will be presented.

3.5. Projects of participants that do not meet the requirements of Section 5 of these Regulations are not accepted for participation in the competition.

3.6. There is no registration fee for participation in the competition. The costs of accommodation for nonresident participants, meals and transportation costs for participation in the face-to-face stage of the competition are paid by the participants themselves or by sending organizations. The exception is the winners of foreign/regional Competition venues.

4. Stages and dates of the Competition

4.1. The competition is an annual event and is held during the summer semester. The final dates of the Competition, as well as its main stages, are established by the order of the Rector of the Ural State University of Economics.

4.2. The competition is held in three stages.

4.2.1 The first stage (until March 20, 2025 inclusive) is the acceptance and registration of competitive research projects in the chosen field (nominations) Competition; verification of projects for compliance with the requirements for projects. The first stage is conducted by the organizing committees of the Competition of the relevant sites:

— the organizing committee of the USUE head site;

- organizing committees of foreign/regional venues.

If less than 10 competitive works have been submitted to a foreign/regional site, then the Competition at this site is considered not to have taken place, and the received works participate in the competition of the USUE head site on a general basis.

4.2.2 The second stage (qualifying) (from March 21 to March 25, 2025) is the examination of competitive research projects registered and admitted to the Competition based on the results of the first stage. Determination of the finalists of the Competition from the USUE site and the finalists of the Competition from foreign/regional sites.

— Holding the qualifying stage at the USUE site

The examination of the competitive works received through the USUE site is carried out by the expert commission of the USUE Site Competition. The Commission selects from 10 to 15 finalists in absentia. The final number of finalists from the USUE site depends on the actual number of finalists



from foreign/regional Competition sites. The lists of finalists who qualified for the final of the Competition from the USUE site are published on the Competition page of the Congress of Entrepreneurship and Engineering of the EEYF website.

The winner (first place) of the national/regional round of the Competition becomes a finalist in the international final of the Competition. He is given the opportunity to participate in the final of the Competition and other final events of the XV EEYF on April 23-25, 2025 in person. Payment for travel and accommodation is provided by the main organizer of the EEYF — USUE.

The participants who took the 2nd and 3rd place in the Competition will be solemnly awarded diplomas and memorable gifts at the foreign/regional site on April 25, 2025.

4.2.3. The third stage (final) (April 24-25, 2025) — defense and presentation of the finalists' competitive research projects; determination of the winners and prize-winners of the Competition.

At the third stage, the works of the finalists of the Competition are publicly defended

4.3. Following the results of the Competition, a collection of abstracts of the finalists' works is published. The collection is published in the form of the corresponding chapter of the annual collection of materials of the XV EEYF no later than 3 months after the Competition. The collection of EEYF materials is posted in the RSCI, on the USUE and EEYF websites.

5. Requirements for submitted documentation and rules for registration of competitive works (projects)

5.1. Research papers are submitted to the Competition in one of 3 directions corresponding to the nominations of the competition:

5.1.1 The best research project on the effects of narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, tobacco, Internet addiction on the physical development and health of adolescents and youth, their prevention.

5.1.2. The best research video, which is of a social nature and aimed at developing skills among young people that contribute to personal development as an element of prevention of manifestations of dependent behavior.

5.1.3. The best prevention model for food toxin infection, food poisoning (demonstration in the form of an experiment).

5.2. The works are submitted to the Organizing Committee of the Competition in electronic form through a special registration form on the EEYF website www.eurasia-forum.ru . Projects are submitted to the Organizing Committees of the Competition in electronic form through a special registration form on the EEYF website <u>www.eurasia-forum.ru</u>:

— participants of the main site of the Competition choose the USUE Site during registration

— the Congress of Entrepreneurship and Engineering — the competition "We choose life without dependencies";

— participants of foreign and regional sites choose the Name of the corresponding site during registration — the competition "We choose life without dependencies"

5.3. To participate in the Competition, the following set of documents must be submitted:

1) the author's application for participation in the Competition (Appendix 1) is submitted by filling out the participant's registration form on the EEYF website. If the work is prepared by a team of authors, one of the authors registers as the team captain and attaches the work, the other participants register as team members. To complete the registration, a team member can attach empty files.



2) the competition work (project) (with the title page in the form of appendix 2) is attached as an independent file to the registration form of the participant;

3) abstracts of the work reflecting the main provisions and results of the work (in the form of an appendix) — attached as an independent file to the registration form of the participant.

5.4. The competition work must meet the following requirements:

• the work must be submitted within the time limits set by the Rector of USUE and published on the EEYF website; o the work must correspond to the subject of the competition and its scientific directions (nominations);

• it is necessary to have reference material: links to sources from which quotations are used, numerical data in the text, tables, graphs, diagrams, references (at least 20 sources);

• the scientific work must be author's, the percentage of originality of the text is not less than 60%;

The work should be designed as follows: a file in the *.doc or *.rtf format, the name of the file should indicate the surname of the author(s). Times New Roman font, size — 14 pt, line spacing 1.5. All margins are 20 mm. The text is aligned in width without hyphenation. All charts and tables must be inserted into the text. The paragraph indentation is 1.25. The orientation of the sheet is bookish. Volume of work: 10-15 pages.

The list of references is drawn up in accordance with GOST R 7.0.100—2018. Footnotes to the text are given in square brackets indicating the number of the source in the list of references. Typical structure of the work: introduction; three chapters (theoretical, analytical, recommendation); conclusion and list of references.

5.5. Abstracts reflecting the general idea of the work should be prepared for each research paper. Abstracts should be designed as follows: 1.5 line spacing on A4 sheets, Times New Roman font, size — 14 pt, margins — 20 mm on each side. The volume of abstracts is no more than 3 pages. The sample design is specified in Appendix 3.

6. Criteria for the evaluation of competitive works

6.1. At the first stage of the Competition, the organizing committee admits works for further expert evaluation according to the requirements specified in Section 5 of the Regulations.

6.2. Criteria for evaluating competitive works at the second (qualifying) stage:

1) registration of work up to 10 points;

2) relevance of the research topic — up to 15 points;

3) novelty and originality of the research — up to 15 points;

4) the content of the study: scientific, technical and economic validity of the proposed solutions; consistency, scientific style and literacy of presentation; availability of applications, illustrations, graphic explanations of appropriate quality - up to 40 points;

5) the practical significance of the research results, the possibility of approbation and implementation of the results obtained -20 points.

6.3. Criteria for evaluating participants during the face-to-face defense of the work at the third (final) stage: 1) relevance of the research topic — up to 15 points; 2) the novelty and originality of the research — up to 15 points;

3) the significance of the research results — up to 20 points;



4) presentation — up to 20 points;

5) protection (answers to experts' questions) — up to 30 points.

6.4. If the winners and prize-winners of the nominations of the Competition or the Competition as a whole have the same number of points (equal), the winners and prize-winners are determined by the decision of the expert commission of the Competition.

7. Awarding the winners

7.1. Based on the results of the face-to-face defense, the 1st, 2nd and 3rd places are determined for each nomination of the Competition and then the 1st, 2nd and 3rd places are determined for the Competition as a whole.

The winners and prize-winners in each nomination of the Competition are awarded with diplomas for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in the corresponding nomination.

According to the results of the Competition, the winners and prize-winners of the Competition are generally determined, they are awarded Diplomas of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd degrees and grand orders of the Star of Eurasia for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, respectively.

The participants who took the 4th and 5th places of the Competition are awarded with Diplomas for the 4th and 5th places, respectively.

All participants of the Competition receive certificates of the finalists of the Competition in electronic form.

7.2. Winners and prize-winners (1st, 2nd and 3rd place) The Competition is awarded with cash prizes within the framework of the prize fund of the Competition, established on the basis of the order of the rector of USUE and in accordance with the protocol of the expert commission of the Competition.

Cash prizes (including payment of income tax) are transferred by the organizer of the Competition within 1.5 months to the personal accounts of the winners and prize—winners according to the details provided to the coordinator of the Competition, subject to the provision of copies (scans) of the following documents:

- printout from the personal account of the bank: bank details and personal account number, for transferring money;

— a copy of the passport of the 1st, 2nd page and the page with the registration;

— a copy of the INN or a printout of the INN data from the Internet site.

Cash prizes for foreign participants participating in the final face-to-face are given at the USUE cash desk on the day of the award.

7.3. Participants who took 1st, 2nd and 3rd place at a foreign/regional venue are awarded with diplomas for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in the national/regional tour and small orders of the "Star of EurAsia".

7.4. The awarding of all finalists of the Competition will take place within the framework of the final events of the XV EEYF on April 27, 2025 simultaneously at the USUE site and at foreign/regional Competition sites via online communication.

8. Competition Management at the USUE site



8.1 The Competition is managed by the Directorate of the EEYF and the organizing Committee of the Competition.

8.2 Chairman of the EEYF Organizing Committee - Rector of USUE:

— approves the Regulations on the Competition, signs the order on the holding of the Competition and the composition of the organizing committee of the Competition, the order on the composition of the expert commission of the Competition;

— provides general management of the organization and conduct of EEYF events, within the framework of which the Competition is held.

8.3 To organize and conduct the Competition, the organizing committee of the Competition is formed, consisting of:

— scientific supervisor of the Competition;

— Coordinator of the Competition;

- members of the expert committee of the Competition;

— representatives of the partner organizations of the Competition, — the secretary of the Competition.

8.4 Scientific Director of the Competition: — prepares the draft Regulations on the Competition, prepares amendments and additions to it;

— is the chairman (co-chairman) of the expert commission of the Competition; selects the composition of the expert commission of the Competition.

8.5 The Coordinator of the Competition:

— ensures the invitation of the members of the expert commission of the Competition;

— organizes the mailing of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and Eurasian countries;

— organizes registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of compliance of the received tender documents with the established requirements, sends the competitive works to members of expert commissions for evaluation;

— organizes and monitors the progress of the Competition;

— organizes the work of the expert commission during the international final of the Competition;

— organizes the registration of diplomas, certificates and awarding of winners and prizewinners of the Competition; organizes the collection of abstracts of competitive works of finalists of the Competition and their transfer to the Publishing House of USUE for inclusion in the collection of materials of the EEYF;

— organizes the collection of necessary documents for the issuance of cash prizes to the winners and prize-winners of the Competition;

- draws up a report on the conduct of the Competition.

8.6 An expert commission of the Competition is established to conduct an expert assessment of the competitive works. The Chairman of the expert committee of the Competition is the Director of the EEYF Congress, in which the competition takes place. The scientific director of the Competition is the co-chairman of the expert commission of the Competition. The expert commission consists of highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers, leading specialists from among the organizers of the EEYF, as well as invited experts. More than half of the members of the expert commission must be representatives of third-party organizations. The decisions of the expert commission are taken by open



voting, by a simple majority of the votes of the members of the expert commission present, are recorded, the minutes are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (appendices 4, 6).

Information on the composition of the organizing committee and expert commissions of the Competition is published annually on the Competition page of the EEYF website.

9. Competition Management at foreign/regional EEYF venues

9.1 The Competition is managed by the Organizing Committee of the foreign/regional EEYF site and the Organizing Committee of the EEYF Site Competition.

9.2 The organizing committee of the EEYF Site Competition includes:

— the coordinator of the Competition; the expert commission of the Competition consisting of at least 3 people from among the highly qualified teaching and scientific staff of the university-organizer of the site, as well as invited experts. — the secretary of the Competition.

9.3 Competition Coordinator:

- ensures the invitation of members of the expert commissions of the Competition;

— organizes the mailing of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations in their country or region of Russia;

— organizes registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of compliance of the received tender documents with the established requirements, sends the competitive works to members of expert commissions for evaluation;

— organizes the work of expert commissions during the qualifying round of the Competition;

— together with the organizing committee of the USUE site, organizes the departure of the winner of the qualifying round of the Competition to USUE to participate in the international final of the Competition (1st place), as well as the participation of the contestants who took 2nd and 3rd place in the awarding procedure on April 25, 2025 at their Competition site; organizes the transfer of the thesis to the coordinator of the USUE site Competition the works of the winner of the national/regional round of the Competition for inclusion in the collection of materials of the EEYF.

9.4. An expert commission of the foreign/regional Competition site is created to conduct an expert assessment of the competitive works.

The composition of the expert foreign/regional commission of the Competition is approved by the organizing committee of the foreign/regional site. The expert commission includes highly qualified teachers and researchers, leading specialists from among the organizers of the EEYF site, as well as invited experts. The decisions of the expert commission are taken by open voting, by a simple majority of the votes of the members of the expert commission present, are recorded, the minutes are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendix 5).

Abstracts must be attached to the competition work, in which it is necessary to indicate the main provisions and results of the work. The volume of abstracts is no more than 3 pages.

Files in the *.doc (*.docx) or *.rtf format, headed with the author's surname, are accepted for consideration. A4 format. Times New Roman font, size 14 pt, line spacing — one and a half. All margins are 20 mm. The text is aligned in width with automatic hyphenation, the orientation of the sheet is bookish. The paragraph indentation is 1.25. All charts and tables must be inserted into the text. The list of references is drawn up in accordance with GOST. Footnotes to the text are given in square brackets indicating the number of the source in the list of references.

Initials and surname of the author should be printed at the top of the page in the center.

Full name of the university (organization) is indicated in the next line, followed by the city. Below, in the middle of the line, the title is indicated, followed by keywords (no more than 5 words or phrases). Then the text is placed. At the end, the initials and surname of the supervisor, his academic degree and academic title are indicated.
