### 1. General regulations

1.1. These Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) regulate the procedure for organizing and conducting an international essay competition in English “Social Justice: Problems, Discussions, Solutions” (hereinafter referred to as the Competition).

1.2. The competition is held within the framework of the Congress of Entrepreneurship and Engineering of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter referred to as EEYF) and is implemented at the main site of EEYF - at the Ural State University of Economics (hereinafter referred to as the USUE site); as well as on foreign and regional EEYF platforms that have chosen this Competition.

The list of foreign and regional sites that have chosen this Competition is indicated on the Competition page of the Congress of Entrepreneurship and Engineering of the EEYF website, as well as on the pages of the foreign/regional sites themselves on the EEYF website.

1.3 Organizer of the Competition:

Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education " Ural State University of Economics" ( Ural State University of Economics), Department of Foreign Languages.

1.4. Co-organizers of the Competition:

Universities-organizers of foreign and regional EEYF platforms that have chosen this competition for implementation at their sites.

1.5. The goals of the competition are:

- creation of an international communication platform to attract the attention of participants to the problem of social inequality that arises for people due to their gender, age, race, ethnicity or religion, culture or disability;
- analysis and critical understanding of the problem identified by the theme of the Competition, search for possible solutions;
- increasing interest in learning English as a language of international cooperation and joint discussion of global human problems.

### 2. Scientific directions of the Competition

Competitive competitions are held separately in the following areas:

1. Justice as the primordial value of the traditional cultures of the world.
2. Historical justice and historical memory.

### 3. Conditions of participation in the Competition

3.1 Students, undergraduates, graduate students in non-linguistic (non-philological) areas of training at universities, academic institutions in Russia and foreign countries, as well as young professionals under the age of 35 are invited to participate in the Competition (hereinafter referred to as the Participants).

Works prepared by young scientists - candidates of sciences are not accepted for the competition.

Participants studying on the territory of foreign/regional EEYF sites implementing this Competition submit applications and undergo a competitive selection at the organizing university of this site. All other participants submit applications through the main platform of the EEYF - USUE.

3.2 Completed works performed individually are submitted to the competition.

3.3 One participant has the right to submit only one work to the Competition.

3.4 The author of the essay independently decides in which direction the work will be presented.

The topic and title of the essay (within the directions) are determined by the participants independently.

3.5 The working language of the competition is English.

3.6 Projects of participants that do not meet the requirements of Section 5 of these Regulations will not be accepted for participation in the Competition.

3.7 There is no registration fee for participation in the competition. Expenses for accommodation of non-resident participants, food and transportation expenses for participation in the full-time stage of the Competition are paid by the participants themselves or by sending organizations. The exception is the winners of foreign/regional competition sites.

### 4. Stages and timing of the Competition

4.1 The competition is an annual event and is held and conducted during the summer term. The final dates for the Competition, as well as its main stages, are established by order of the chairman of the EEYF organizing committee, the rector of USUE, and are published on the Competition pages of the EEYF website.

4.2 The competition is held in three stages:

4.2.1 The first stage (until March 20, 2025 inclusive) – acceptance and registration of competitive works in the chosen area of the Competition; checking the work for compliance with the requirements for the work.

The first stage is carried out by the organizing committees of the Competition of the relevant sites:

- organizing committee of the main site of USUE;
- organizing committees of foreign/regional venues.

If less than 10 competitive works are received at a foreign/regional site, regardless of the direction of the Competition, then the Competition at this site is considered not to have taken place, and the received works participate in the competition of the main site of USUE on a general basis.

4.2.2 The second stage (qualifying) (from March 21 to April 1, 2025) – examination of competitive works registered and admitted to the Competition based on the results of the first stage. Determining the finalists of the Competition from the USUE site and the finalists of the Competition from foreign/regional sites.

- Conducting the qualifying stage at the USUE site

The examination of competitive works received through the USUE platform is carried out by expert commissions of the Competition of the USUE site. The commissions select in absentia from 7 to

10 finalists in each direction. The final number of finalists from the USUE site depends on the actual number of finalists from foreign/regional sites of the Competition. Lists of finalists who qualified for the finals of the Competition in each direction are published on the Competition page of the Entrepreneurship and Engineering Congress of the EEYF website.

– Conducting qualifying stages at foreign/regional competition sites

The examination of competitive works at the EEYF sites is carried out by expert commissions of foreign/regional Competition sites.

Expert commissions select from 5 to 10 best works of participants, regardless of the scientific areas of the Competition. On April 1, 2025, the organizing committee and the expert commission of the foreign/regional site of the Competition will conduct a full-time defense of the selected works and determine the winner and prize-winners of the national/regional round of the Competition.

The winner (first place) of the national/regional round of the Competition becomes a finalist in the international final of the Competition. He is given the opportunity to participate in the finals of the Competition and other final events of the XV EEYF on April 22-24, 2025 in person. Payment for travel and accommodation is provided by the main organizer of the EEYF - USUE.

Participants who took 2nd and 3rd place will be solemnly presented with certificates and memorable gifts at a foreign/regional site on April 25, 2025.

The general list of finalists of the international final of the Competition is formed from the finalists from the USUE site and the winners of foreign/regional sites that have chosen this Competition. The general list of finalists of the Competition is published on the EEYF website, on the page of the Competition of the Congress of Entrepreneurship and Engineering from April 1 to April 10, 2025.

4.2.3 The third stage (final) (April 23-24, 2025) – defense of competitive works of the international final of the Competition; determining the winners for each area of the Competition; rewarding

The third stage is held between the finalists of the Competition through a public presentation and defense of competition works. Defense of works remotely, using online communication, is carried out in agreement with the organizing committee of the Competition. The report, presentation and defense are conducted in English.

4.3 Based on the results of the Competition, the main organizer of the EEYF publishes a collection of abstracts of the works of the Competition finalists. The collection is published in the form of the corresponding chapter of the annual collection of EEYF materials no later than 4 months after the Competition. The collection of EEYF materials is posted in the RSCI, on the USUE website and on the EEYF website.

Works recommended for publication are determined by the Competition expert commission from among all works selected for participation in the finals. For each area of the competition, the 5 best works are recommended for publication.

## **5. Registration of participants, requirements for submitted documentation and rules for registration of competitive works**

5.1 Works (essays) are submitted to the Competition in one of 2 directions corresponding to the areas of the competition:

1. Justice as the primordial value of the traditional cultures of the world.
2. Historical justice and historical memory.

5.2. The works are submitted to the Organizing Committee of the Competition in electronic form through a special registration form on the EEYF website [www.eurasia-forum.ru](http://www.eurasia-forum.ru) :

– participants of the main site of the Competition choose the USUE Site during registration – Congress of Entrepreneurship and Engineering – international essay contest in English "Social Justice: Problems, Discussions, Solutions" – one of two directions

– participants of foreign/regional sites choose the Name of the relevant site when registering – international essay contest in English "Social Justice: Problems, Discussions, Solutions" – one of two directions

5.3. To participate in the Competition the following package of documents must be submitted:

1) the author’s application for participation in the Competition (Appendix 1) – is submitted by filling out the participant’s registration form on the EEYF website.

2) competition work (essay) (with a title page in the form of Appendix 2) – attached as a separate file to the participant’s registration form;

3) abstracts of the work (according to Appendix 3) – attached as a separate file to the participant’s registration form.

5.4. All documents must be submitted in a single package by March 20, 2025, or as otherwise specified on the Competition page of the EEYF website.

The absence of any of the documents specified in clause 5.2. within the prescribed period is grounds for refusal of admission to participate in the Competition.

5.5. The competition entry must meet the following requirements:

1) the work must correspond to the topic of the Competition and one of the selected scientific areas (nominations) of the Competition;

2) must be of a research nature, reference material must be indicated: links to sources from which quotes are used, digital data in the text, tables, graphs, diagrams;

3) the work must be original, the percentage of originality of the text is at least 70%;

4) the work must be formatted as follows: a file in \*.doc or \*.rtf format, the author’s last name must be indicated in the file name. Font Times New Roman, font size – 14 pt, line spacing 1.5. All margins are 20 mm. The text is aligned in width without hyphenation. All charts and tables must be inserted into the text. Paragraph indent – 1.25. Sheet orientation is portrait. Volume of work: 5000 characters with spaces (the title page is not included in the character count).

5.6. Typical structure of the work: introduction, main part, conclusion, list of references.

Introduction: the essence and rationale for choosing a topic.

Main part (topic development): reasoned disclosure of the topic based on the collected and analyzed material (ideas, models and data). It is necessary to have reference and/or illustrative material: digital data in the text, tables, graphs, diagrams. The source material can be articles, conference materials, reports of public organizations, and statistical data.

Conclusion: generalizations and reasoned conclusions on the topic, indicating possible areas of application.

The list of used literature is drawn up in accordance with GOST R 7.0.100-2018. Footnotes to the text are given in square brackets indicating the source number in the list of references.

5) An abstract of the work must be prepared for each work. A sample abstract format is given in Appendix 3.

5.7. The Regulations of the Competition determine the possible directions of the competition work. The author defines and formulates a specific narrow topic within the direction independently.

Disclosure of the stated topic presupposes an analytical answer: what problems exist within the specified areas, how relevant is the topic considered by the author, based on the facts, why something happens (for what reason) and how it happens (processes, mechanisms), what are the possible solutions to the problem.

The competition entry may be a background analysis; critical analysis of existing concepts and theories; suggestions for ways to solve the problem.

5.8. Participants who reach the finals of the Competition make a presentation in English (no more than 7 minutes). The report is accompanied by a presentation in Microsoft PowerPoint format (no more than 15 slides).

## 6. Criteria for evaluating competitive works

6.1. The competitive selection of works for each area of the Competition is carried out separately by the Competition expert commission.


6.2. Criteria for evaluating competitive works (essays) at the second (qualifying) stage:

- organization of the text (compliance with style, clarity of structure, consistency of presentation, consistency of key theses and statements, compliance with requirements). The maximum number of points is 5.

- understanding by the competition participant of the problem reflected in the title of the topic, compliance of the essay with the chosen topic (formulation of the problem in the text of the essay, reflection of the problem in the title, correspondence of the thesis to the problem). The maximum number of points is 10.

- disclosure of the topic (personal nature of the perception of the problem and its comprehension, completeness of disclosure, argumentation of the author's point of view based on the facts of public life, literary sources and personal social experience). The maximum number of points is 5.

- speech design (lexical and grammatical diversity, compliance with language norms, spelling, grammatical and punctuation literacy). The maximum number of points is 30.

6.3. Criteria for evaluating participants during the full-time defense of work at the third (final) stage:

- confident knowledge of the material (depth of study of the topic and participation in the discussion). The maximum number of points is 10.
- quality of answers to questions. The maximum number of points is 10.
- level of communicative competence. The maximum number of points is 20.
- originality of presentation material. The maximum number of points is 10.

6.4. The winner of the Competition is the participant who scores the most points in the third (full-time, final) stage. If the winners or prize-winners of the directions of the Competition have the same number of points (equal), the decision to determine the winners and prize-winners is made by the Expert Commission of the Competition.

## 7. Winner's reward ceremony

7.1 Based on the results of the international final of the Competition, winners and prize-winners are determined for each scientific area of the Competition; they are awarded Diplomas of I, II, III degrees and large orders “Star of EurAsia” for 1, 2, and 3 places, respectively.

Participants who took 4th and 5th places in each thematic area (section) of the Competition are awarded Certificates for 4th and 5th places, respectively.

All participants of the Competition receive certificates of Competition finalists in electronic form

7.2. The winners and runners-up (1st, 2nd and 3rd place) of each scientific direction of the international final of the Competition are awarded cash prizes within the framework of the Competition prize fund, established on the basis of the order of the USUE Rector and in accordance with the protocols of the Expert Commissions of the Competition.

Cash prizes (including payment of income tax) are transferred by the Competition organizer within 1.5 months to the personal accounts of winners and prize-winners using the details provided to the Competition coordinator (Competition section), subject to the provision of copies (scans) of the following documents to the Competition organizer:

- printout from the bank’s personal account: bank details and personal account number for transferring money;
- a copy of the passport page 1, 2 and page with registration;
- a copy of the TIN or a printout of the TIN data from the website.

Cash prizes for foreign participants participating in the finals in person are issued at the USUE cash desk on the day of the award.

7.3. Participants who take 1st, 2nd and 3rd place at a foreign/regional site are awarded certificates for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in the national/regional round and small orders “Star of Eurasia”.

7.4. The awarding of all finalists of the Competition will take place as part of the final events of the XV EEYF on April 24, 2025 simultaneously at the USUE site and at foreign/regional Competition sites using online communication.

## 8. Management of the Competition on the USUE site

8.1. The Competition is managed by the EEYF Organizing Committee and the Competition Organizing Committee.

### 8.2. Chairman of the EEYF Organizing Committee - Rector of USUE:

- approves the Regulations on the Competition, signs the order on holding the Competition and the composition of the organizing committee of the Competition, the order on the composition of the expert commission of the Competition;
- carries out general management of the organization and conduct of EEYF events within the framework of which the Competition is held.

8.3. To organize and conduct the Competition, an organizing committee of the Competition is formed, consisting of:

- scientific director of the Competition;
- Competition coordinator;
- members of the expert committee of the Competition;
- representatives of organizations - partners of the Competition,
- Secretary(s) of the Competition.

### 8.4. Scientific director of the Competition:

- prepares the draft Regulations on the Competition, prepares amendments and additions to it;
- is the chairman (co-chairman) of the expert commission of the Competition;
- selects the composition of the expert commission of the Competition.


### 8.5. Competition Coordinator:

- ensures the invitation of members of the Expert Commission of the Competition;
- organizes the distribution of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and Eurasian countries;
- organizes registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of compliance of received competition documents with established requirements, sends competition works to members of expert commissions for evaluation;
- organizes and monitors the progress of the Competition;
- organizes the work of the expert commission during the international finals of the Competition;
- organizes the registration of diplomas, certificates and awarding of the winners and prize-winners of the Competition;
- organizes the collection of abstracts of competitive works of the Competition finalists and their transfer to the USUE Publishing House for inclusion in the collection of EEYF materials;
- organizes the collection of necessary documents for issuing cash prizes to the winners and prize-winners of the Competition;
- draws up a report on the Competition.

8.6. An expert commission of the Competition is created to conduct an expert assessment of competitive works.

The Chairman of the Expert Commission of the Competition is the Director of the EEYF Congress, where the competition is taking place. The co-chairman of the Expert Committee of the Competition is the scientific director of the Competition. The expert commission includes highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers, leading specialists from among the organizers of the EEYF, as well as invited experts. More than half of the members of the expert commission must be

representatives of third-party organizations. Decisions of the expert commission are made by open voting, by a simple majority of votes of the members of the expert commission present, minutes are recorded, the minutes are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendices 4, 6). Information on the composition of the organizing committee and expert commissions of the Competition is published annually on the Competition page of the EEYF website.

## **9. Management of the Competition at foreign/regional sites of the EEYF**

9.1. The Competition is managed by the organizing committee of the foreign/regional EEYF site and the organizing committee of the Competition of the EEYF site.

9.2. The organizing committee of the Competition of the EEYF site includes:

- Competition coordinator;
- an expert commission of the Competition consisting of at least 3 people from among highly qualified teaching and research workers of the university organizing the site, as well as invited experts.
- Secretary of the Competition.

9.3. Competition Coordinator:

- ensures the invitation of members of the expert commissions of the Competition;
- organizes the distribution of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations in their country or region of Russia;
- organizes registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of compliance of received competition documents with established requirements, sends competition works to members of expert commissions for evaluation;
- organizes the work of expert commissions during the qualifying round of the Competition;
- together with the organizing committee of the USUE site, organizes the departure of the winner of the qualifying round of the Competition to USUE to participate in the international final of the Competition (1st place), as well as the participation of the contestants who took 2nd and 3rd place in the award procedure on April 24, 2025 at their Competition site;
- organizes the transfer of the thesis of the work of the winner of the qualifying round of the Competition to the Competition coordinator of the USUE site for inclusion in the collection of EEYF materials.

9.4. To conduct an expert assessment of the competition entries, an expert commission is created at the foreign/regional site of the Competition.

The composition of the expert foreign/regional commission of the Competition is approved by the organizing committee of the foreign/regional site. The expert commission includes highly qualified pedagogical and scientific workers, leading specialists from among the organizers of the EEYF site, as well as invited experts. Decisions by the expert commission are made by open voting, by a simple majority of votes of the members of the expert commission present, minutes are recorded, the minutes are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendix 5).

The last name of the author must be indicated in the file name.

Files in the \*.doc (\*.docx) or \*.rtf format are accepted for consideration. The size of the A4 sheet, the orientation of the sheet is bookish. Times New Roman font, size – 14 pt, line spacing 1.5. All fields are 2 cm wide on all sides. Width alignment. The paragraph indentation is 1.25. The interval before and after the paragraph is 0 pt. The hyphenation function is disabled. The "page numbering" function is disabled.

All diagrams, tables, and figures should be inserted into the text, titled, and numbered. The relevant links are provided in the text of the article, for example: "Figure 1 shows a diagram ...", "Table 1 shows ...". Figures (jpg format only): the word "Figure" and the name are placed in the center, one empty line before and after. Tables: font size - 12. The name is placed above the table, left alignment, one empty line before and after the name.

The bibliography is arranged in accordance with GOST in alphabetical order: first, sources in Russian, then sources in a foreign language, then electronic resources. In the text, references are given in square brackets indicating the number of the source from the bibliographic list and the page, for example [3:154]; the number in the list corresponds to the reference number in the text. The bibliographic list should contain no more than 10 items. The sources indicated in the bibliographic list must strictly correspond to the subject of the essay. Bibliography: 1 empty line after the text of the article; the title is in Russian (font - 12, regular, bold, centered); list of sources (numbered list, paragraph indentation - 1.25, font - 12, regular, width alignment).
