1. General Provisions

1.1. These Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) regulate the procedure for organizing and holding student competitions in computer sports "Eurasian Games of the Future" (hereinafter referred to as the Competitions)

1.2. The competitions are held within the framework of the Digital Eurasia Congress of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter – EEYF). The Internet address of the EEYF website www.eurasia-forum.ru

1.3. Organizer of the competition:

Ural State University of Economics (hereinafter – USUE).

1.4. Co-organizers:

Universities are the organizers of foreign and regional EEYF sites that have chosen these competitions to be implemented on their sites. The list of regional venues that have chosen this competition is indicated on the Digital Eurasia Congress competition page on the EEYF website, as well as on the regional venues themselves on the EEYF website.

1.4. The purpose of the competition is to promote information security, sports programming and computer sports among young people to develop practical, algorithmic and competitive skills, as well as identify the best students and build human resources in the digital sphere.

1.5. The objectives of the competition are:

- selection of the strongest participants for the formation of student national teams;
- improving the level of technical literacy;
- involvement of students in the development of the digital economy;
- development of research, analytical and competitive skills.

1.6. Within the framework of these competitions, the organizers observe:

– the prohibition of any unlawful influence on the results of sports competitions included in these regulations;

–prohibition of participation in gambling in bookmakers and sweepstakes by betting on official sports competitions in accordance with the requirements established by paragraph 3 of Part 4 of Article 26.2 of Federal Law No. 329-FZ of 04.12.2007 "On Physical Culture and Sports in the Russian Federation".

1.7. The Regulation is a challenge to a competition (the basis for sending, including sending athletes, coaches and other participants in the field of physical culture and sports).

2. Направления (секции) Конкурса

2. Directions (sections) The competition

The competition is held in 3 independent sections.:

- 1) CTF (Capture The Flag) practice-oriented information security competitions
- 2) sports programming competitions "V Sports Programming Championship 2026"
- 3) Computer sports competitions "Eurasia Esports 2026 student"

3. Rights and obligations of Organizers of sports competitions

3.1. The organizers of the sports competition are the Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education "Ural State University of Economics" (hereinafter - USUE).

3.2. The distribution of other rights and obligations, including liability for harm caused to participants of the event and (or) third parties, is carried out on the basis of the regulations to this regulation for each sports competition between the Federation and USUE. If the distribution of these rights and obligations is carried out on the basis of an agreement, the rules of a particular sports competition contain a link to the details of such an agreement (number and date of conclusion of the agreement).

3.3. USUE is responsible for ensuring public order and public safety measures in accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation.

3.4. USUE is obliged to provide the necessary infrastructure and technical equipment in the territory that will be used for sports competitions in accordance with the rules for ensuring safety during official sports competitions.

3.5. The Federation and the USUE are obliged to prevent participants and competition personnel from demonstrating the attributes of foreign states and territories that commit unfriendly acts against the Russian Federation, Russian legal entities and individuals included in the list approved by Decree of the Government of the Russian Federation dated 05.03.2022 No. 430-r, including the use of objects of the material world with names applied to them., state symbols, geographical borders of such states and territories, and other images, allowing to identify the specified states and territories.

3.6. The direct conduct of the competition is assigned to the judging panel for the sport.

4. Ensuring the safety of participants and spectators, medical care, anti-doping provision of sports competitions

4.1. Sports competitions are held in accordance with Federal Law No. 329-FZ dated 04.12.2007 "On Physical Culture and Sports in the Russian Federation".


Sports competitions can be held at venues of official sports competitions that have the necessary infrastructure, video surveillance systems that allow the identification of individuals while they are in the venues of official sports competitions, and technical equipment in accordance with the rules for ensuring safety during official sports competitions in accordance with clause 9 of art.37 "sports facilities" 329-FZ.

4.2. The safety of participants and spectators at sports competitions is ensured in accordance with the requirements of the Rules for Ensuring Safety during Official Sports Competitions, approved by Decree of the Government of the Russian Federation No. 353 dated April 18, 2014.

4.3. Emergency medical care is provided in accordance with Order No. 1144n of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation dated 10/23/2020 "On Approval of the Procedure for Organizing Medical care for Persons Engaged in Physical Education and Sports (including during the Preparation and Conduct of physical education and Sports events), including the procedure for medical examination of persons wishing to undergo sports training, engage in physical education and sports in organizations and (or) comply with the standards of tests (tests) The All-Russian Physical Culture and Sports Complex "Ready for labor and Defense" (GTO)"and forms of medical certificates on admission to participate in physical culture and sports events."

The basis for the admission of a person involved in sports to sports competitions is the presence of a medical certificate of admission to participate in sports competitions. In the application for participation in sports competitions, a mark "Approved" is placed next to each athlete's last name, certified by the signature of a sports medicine doctor and his personal seal. The application for participation in sports competitions is signed by a sports medicine doctor with a transcript of the surname, first name, patronymic (if any) and stamped by a medical organization licensed to carry out medical activities involving physical therapy and sports medicine.

4.4. Participation in competitions is carried out only if there is an accident insurance contract (original) (i.e. sudden, unforeseen events that led to treatment at a medical institution, disability or death of the insured person), which is provided to the credentials committee for each participant of the competition. Insurance of participants of competitions can be carried out both at the expense of budgetary and extra-budgetary funds, in accordance with the current legislation of the Russian Federation.

4.5. Anti-doping support for sports competitions is carried out in accordance with the All-Russian Anti-Doping Rules approved by Order No. 464 of the Ministry of Sports of the Russian Federation dated June 24, 2021.

In order to implement a set of measures to implement the National Anti-Doping Plan in Russian Sports, adopted by the Independent Public Anti-Doping Commission on February 01, 2017, approved by order of the Government of the Russian Federation dated July 10, 2017 No. 1456-r, athletes and coaches participating in competitions have a certificate of knowledge of anti-doping rules.

4.6. The requirements of these Regulations are detailed in the Regulations of specific sports competitions and cannot contradict it. The regulations on regional and inter-municipal sports competitions are developed by the Federation individually for each sports competition and approved by the Federation and other organizers of the sports competition. If the organizers of several regional and inter-municipal sports competitions are the same persons, then one Regulation may be drawn up for such competitions.

4.7. In accordance with the regulations on the organization and conduct of official physical education and sports events on the territory of the Russian Federation in conditions of continuing risks of the spread of COVID-19, approved by the Ministry of Sports of the Russian Federation and the Chief State Sanitary Doctor of the Russian Federation on 07/31/2020, as well as other methodological recommendations established by the Federal Service for Supervision of Consumer Rights Protection and Human Welfare, The Federation provides:

- monitoring the use of personal protective equipment (mask) by participants and maintenance personnel of the competition, except for the period of competitive and training activities (for athletes), as well as monitoring the use of personal protective equipment by participants,

- monitoring the observance of a social distance of 1.5 meters between participants (staff, athletes, etc.),

- awarding without tactile contact with maintaining social distance,

- briefing with representatives of the teams on the need for participants to comply with the requirements of the Ministry of Sports of the Russian Federation, Rospotrebnadzor, and immediately inform the team representative about any deviations in their health and the use of personal protective equipment.

USUE is responsible for compliance with the methodological recommendations: MR 3.1/2.1.0184-20 (Recommendations on organizing the work of sports organizations in conditions of continuing risks of the spread of COVID-19), MR 3.1/2.1.0192-20 (Recommendations for the prevention of new coronavirus infection (COVID-19) in physical education and sports facilities (outdoor and indoor sports facilities, sports and recreation complexes, swimming pools and fitness clubs)), including:

- organizes thermometry among participants and staff entering the facility using non-contact thermometers,

- provides conditions for hygienic treatment of hands with the use of skin antiseptics at sports facilities or in competition venues,

- before the opening of the sports facility and on a daily basis conducts general cleaning of the premises and treatment of sports equipment using disinfectants active against viruses, airing the premises every 2 hours and after the competition,

- conducts disinfection of changing rooms, restrooms, and contact surfaces (handrails, door handles, railings, etc.) every 2 hours.,

- restricts the entry into the territory of the sports facility of persons not related to the provision of the competitive process, including spectators.

5. Terms of participation in the Competition

The event is held among university students of all forms aged 18 and over (hereinafter referred to as Participants), including in the following sections::

5.1. CTF practice-oriented information security competitions

5.1.1. Teams of up to four people from among university students of all forms of IT majors aged 18 and over (hereinafter referred to as Participants) are allowed to participate in the competitions.

5.1.2. One team has the right to participate in CTF competitions in only one form: Red Team (an offensive security team that identifies weaknesses at any level of protection) or Blue Team (a monitoring and investigation team that identifies and prevents any threats).

5.1.3. To participate in CTF competitions, you must fill out the registration form. The form is available on the CTF competition website.

5.1.4. There is no registration fee. The costs of accommodation for nonresident participants, meals and transportation costs for participation in the face-to-face stage of the competition are paid by the participants or organizations themselves.

5.2. Sports programming competitions "V Sports Programming Championship 2026"

5.2.1. Preliminary applications for participation in the sports competition are submitted electronically through a special registration form on the EEYF website

www.eurasia-forum.ru

5.2.2. In order to participate in the competition, the participant must submit the following set of documents:

- the author's application for participation in the Competition (Appendix 1) is submitted by filling out the participant registration form on the EEYF website, one of the authors registers as the captain of the team, the rest of the participants register as members of the team;

- if necessary, due to the epidemiological situation, each participant must submit a medical document confirming the negative result of a laboratory test for a new coronavirus infection.

5.3. Computer sports competitions "Eurasia Esports 2026 student"

5.3.1. To participate in the competition, you must fill out the registration form on the competition website.

5.3.2. It will be possible to confirm registration on the spot on the day of the competition using a Telegram chat.

5.3.3. The competition Site must be provided with the following documents: kopnin_aa@usue.ru :

- passport of a citizen of the Russian Federation, or birth certificate;
- the original of the life and health accident insurance contract;
- the original of the compulsory health insurance policy;
- if necessary, due to the epidemiological situation, each participant must submit a medical document confirming the negative result of a laboratory test for a new coronavirus infection.

6. Stages and dates of student competitions

6.1. CTF (Capture The Flag) practice-oriented information security Competitions


6.1.1. CTF competitions are an annual event and are held during the summer semester. The final dates of the CTF competition, as well as its main stages, are set by order of the Rector of the Ural State University of Economics and are posted on the CTF competition page on the EEYF website.

6.1.2. The competition is held in three stages.

The first stage is the registration of the teams and their participants. The first stage is conducted by the organizing committee of CTF competitions within the time limits set by the Directorate of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum.

The second stage is the preliminary/qualifying stage of CTF competitions in a remote format within the time limits set by the Directorate of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum. The examination of the works of the qualifying stage is carried out by the expert commission of CTF competitions / expert commissions of regional sites that supported these CTF competitions. Lists of teams that have qualified for the CTF finals are being formed. The lists of finalists are published on the CTF competition page of the EEYF website. Informational letters are being sent to the teams about reaching the final stage of the CTF competition. Participants of the teams that have passed the preliminary/qualifying stage of CTF competitions, including up to 4 teams selected from regional CTF competition venues, are invited to Yekaterinburg to participate in the CTF competition finals and participate in the final events of the EEYF.

The third stage is the (final) final of CTF competitions; determination of the winners and prize-winners of CTF competitions. The third stage is held between the finalists of CTF competitions in a face-to-face format at a venue established by the Directorate of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum.

6.2. Sports programming competitions "V Sports Programming Championship 2026"

6.3. Computer sports competitions "Eurasia Esports 2026 studentskaya"

6.3.1. Venue of the competition: Online (at the participants' home venues).

6.3.2. The meeting of the judging panel will be held on 04/12/2026 at 20:00 hours, Online:

6.3.3. The meeting of the admission commission will be held on 04/12/2026 at 19:30 hours, Online:

6.3.4. The draw of participants will take place on 04/12/2026 at 20:30 hours, Online:

6.3.5. Schedule of qualifications of the sports competition: 04/13/2026 at 10.00 Online

6.3.6. Schedule of the finals of the sports competition: 04/22/2026 at 10.00 a.m. at the USUE Arena

6.3.7. Competitions in all disciplines are held online using the Telegram platform. Participants must install the Telegram application on their computer, tablet or phone. After installing Telegram, you need to get a link to enter the Eurasia Esports 2025 Student group. By entering the chat, the participant acts according to the instructions of the judge. The final stage of the competition is held at the USUE Arena. After the end of the game, the result must be reported to the referee in order to be recorded in the competition protocol. The result and a confirmation screenshot or replay are provided by the winner of the match.

7. Requirements for registration of participants

7.1. Applications for participation in competitions are submitted through the registration system of the website. For participants of the competition, representatives of regional venues, the application is registered from the page of the regional venue of the EYF website, pre-selecting the name of the venue.

7.2. Each team member submits an application for participation through the registration system of the website, choosing the category "team participation", then "team captain" or "team member". In the "Work topic" field, everyone indicates the name of their team. The team captain attaches a file to the registration form, where all the team members are listed.

8. Management of student competitions

8.1. The competition is managed by the EYF Directorate and the competition Organizing Committee.

8.2. An Organizing Committee is formed for the organization and conduct of the competition, approved by the rector's order. The Organizing Committee consists of:

- Chairman;

Members of the organizing committee:

- head of the competition;

- Competition coordinator;

- Chairman and members of the expert commission of the competition;

- representatives of the partner organizations of the competition;

- Secretary of the competition.

8.3. The Organizing Committee carries out the general management of the organization and conduct of competitions.


8.3.1. Chairman of the Organizing Committee:

- approves the Regulations on the competition, signs the order on the conduct of the competition and the composition of the organizing committee of the competition, the order on the composition of the expert commission of the competition;

- provides general management of the organization and conduct of EYF events, within the framework of which competitions are held.

8.3.2. An expert commission of the competition is established by the chairman to conduct an expert assessment of the competitive work. The decisions of the expert commission are recorded, the minutes are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendix 3, Appendix 4).

8.3.3. Competition Coordinator:

- ensures the invitation of the members of the expert commission of the competition;
- sends information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and other countries;
- organizes the registration of participating teams;
- organizes the finals and the work of the expert commission of the competition;
- organizes the registration of diplomas, certificates and awarding of winners and prize-winners of competitions;
- draws up a report on the conduct of the competition.

9. Financing

9.1. USUE shall bear the costs of organizing medical support, the purchase of office supplies, the rental of sports facilities, the costs of ensuring public order and security, as well as other costs of organizing and conducting competitions.

9.2. The costs of sending participants, coaches, and representatives are borne by the sending organizations (including travel, accommodation, daily travel allowance, and insurance for participants).

10. Awarding of winners

10.1. Based on the results of the face-to-face defense, the winners and prize-winners in each thematic area (section) of the competition are determined, they are awarded with Diplomas of I, II, III degrees and orders for 1,2 and 3rd place, respectively.

10.2. The participants of the face-to-face stage receive certificates of the finalists of the competition.

10.3. The winners and prize-winners of each thematic area (section) are awarded with cash prizes within the framework of the prize fund of the Competition, established on the basis of the order of the Rector of USUE and in accordance with the protocols of the expert commissions of the Competition.

10.4. Cash prizes (including payment of income tax) are transferred by the organizer of the Contest within 1.5 months to the personal accounts of the winners and prize-winners according to the details provided to the coordinator of the Contest (section of the Contest), as well as upon timely provision of copies of other requested documents. Cash prizes for foreign participants are given at the cash desk of USUE on the day of the award ceremony.
