REGULATIONS

For the International Website Building Championship «IT-Constructor»

Yekaterinburg
2025



1. General Provisions

1.1 This Regulation (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulation") sets out the procedure for organizing and conducting the International Website Construction Championship "IT-Constructor" (hereinafter referred to as "the Competition").

1.2 The Competition will be held as part of the Digital Eurasia Congress of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (EEYF).

1.3 The organizers of the Competition are:

- Ural State University of Economics (hereinafter "USUE"), Scientific and Educational Center for Information Technologies.

1.4 Co-organizers of the Competition:

Universities that are organizers of foreign and regional EEYF sites have chosen to host this competition on their platforms. A list of foreign and regional websites that have selected this Competition can be found on the Digital Eurasia Congress page of the EEYF website and on the respective foreign/regional EEYF websites.

1.5 The aim of the competition is to encourage the implementation of innovative initiatives by young professionals in the fields of website design, web development and analytics.

1.6 Objectives:

- Identification of talented young people and determination of their future development potential;

- Involvement of young people in the design, planning, launch and analysis of a website;

- Analysis of positive and negative aspects in project development;

- Identification and dissemination of best practices in organizational management system design, implementation of corporate ethics and culture through the analysis of team processes and outcomes.

2. Subject of the Competition

The subject of the competitive assessment is an Internet site on a given topic developed within the allotted time of the competition by the participating team.

3. Conditions of participation in the Competition

3.1. Teams consisting of students of all forms of education, graduate students, scientists of educational organizations, academic institutes and other interested organizations in Russia and foreign countries under the age of 35 (hereinafter referred to as Participants), no more than 4 people, are allowed to participate in the Competition.

3.2. Each participant must register on the official website of the EEYF.

3.3. There is no registration fee. The costs of accommodation for nonresident participants, meals and transportation costs for participation in the face-to-face stage of the competition are paid independently by participants or organizations.



4. Stages and timing of the Competition

4.1 The Competition is an annual event, and the final dates and main stages are determined by the order of the Rector of Ural State University of Economics.

4.2 The competition will be held in two stages:

4.2.1 The first stage will involve the acceptance and registration of application forms for participation in the competition. This stage will take place within the timeframe specified by the Directorate of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum, and the lists of participating teams for the second (full-round) stage will be published on the competition page of the EEYF website. In case a team member is unable to attend the competition in person due to any reason, the captain of the team may substitute them with another participant meeting the requirements outlined in Section 3 of these Regulations.

4.2.2 The second (full-time) stage involves completing the task of creating a website based on a topic chosen from those proposed by the organizers. This stage also includes the determination of winners and prize winners.

4.3 Participation in the competition can also be done using remote technologies. Registered participants will have access to USUE's cloud resources based on the Microsoft Office 365 platform, and will connect to interactive sessions as part of the events through teams created within Microsoft Teams.

5. Requirements for registration of participants

5.1 At the first stage of the competition, participants submit an online application for participation through the EEYF's website, www.eurasia-forum.ru. For participants from foreign/regional sites, the application can be submitted from the foreign/regional page of the EEYF website. Each team member of a participant submits their application (Appendix 1) by completing the online registration form on the EEYF website. The team captain registers under the name "captain", and indicates the team's name/motto in the "topic of work" field. The other team members register under their own names, also indicating the team's name/motto.

5.2 The application must be submitted within the specified timeframe on the EEYF website.

6. Criteria for evaluating competition works

6.1. During the second (in-person) stage of the Competition, the expert commission of the competition evaluates the final work of the competitors - the created website according to the following criteria:

- practical feasibility and social significance - 30 points;
- creative implementation (design) - 30 points;
- originality of thinking - 20 points;
- website presentation - 20 points.

6.3. The expert commission makes a decision based on the sum of points.

6.4. If the winners and runners-up of the Competition have the same number of points, the decision to determine the winners and runners-up remains with the Expert Commission of the Competition.

6.5. The expert commission has the right to award individual teams with special nominations.



7. Competition Management

7.1 The competition is managed by the directorate of the EEYF (hereinafter referred to as the "Directorate") and the organizing committee for the competition.

7.2 For the purpose of organizing and conducting the competition, a Organizing Committee has been formed, approved by order of the Rector. The Organizing Committee comprises:

- A chairman;
- A co-chair;
- Members of the organizing committee:
 - Scientific director of the competition;
 - Coordinator(s) for the competition;
 - Chairman and members of the expert committee for the competition;
 - Representatives of partner organizations for the competition, and
 - The secretary for the competition

7.3 The Organizing Committee ensures overall management of the organization and conduct of the competition.

7.3.1 The chairman of the Organizing Committee shall:

- Approves the Regulations for the Competition, issues the order for holding the Competition and establishes the composition of the organizing committee for the Competition as well as the order on the membership of the expert panel for the Competition;

- Provides general management of the organization and administration of EEYF events within which the Competition will be held.

7.3.2 Co-Chair of the Organizing Committee:

- Exercises direct responsibility for the organization and management of EEYF, in collaboration with the Scientific Director of the Competition, and determines the membership of the Expert Panel for the Competition.

7.3.3 An Expert Panel will be established to conduct a professional evaluation of the submitted entries.

The chair of the expert panel for the competition is the director of the congress within which the competition takes place. The panel of experts for the competition consists of highly qualified educators, leading scholars, and specialists from the organizing committee of the EEYF and the competition, as well as external experts.

The panel is composed of between 5 and 7 members, with more than half being representatives from external organizations. Decisions of the panel are recorded and signed by the chair, secretary, and members of the panel (see Appendix 3).

7.3.4 Scientific supervisor of the competition:

- Prepares the regulations for the competition and submits them to the rector for approval.
- Co-chairs the expert panel.
- Selects the members of the expert panel.
- develops and approves challenging tasks for participants on behalf of the chair of the expert panel.

7.3.5 The Competition Coordinator, in collaboration with their assistant and the working team:

- issues invitations to members of the competition's expert committee;
- distributes information letters to educational, research, and scientific institutions in the Russian Federation and abroad;

- facilitates the registration and verification process for received submissions against established criteria;
- oversees the organization of the final stage and the operation of the competition expert panel;



- administers the issuance of diplomas, certifications, and recognition of award winners at the event;
- compiles a report on the execution of the competition.

8. Awarding of the winners

8.1. Based on the decision of the expert panel, winners and medalists are determined and awarded with Diplomas of I, II and III degrees and medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places, respectively.

All participants are granted certificates of finalist status in the Competition.

8.2. The winners and medalists will be awarded cash prizes from the prize pool established by the order of the Rector of the USUE and according to the protocols of the expert panels of the Competition. If the winner or medalist of the Competition is a team, the cash prize will be divided equally among all team members.

The founder of the competition will transfer cash prizes (including any applicable income taxes) to the winners' and prize-winners' personal accounts within 1.5 months, based on the details provided by the competition coordinator. Copies of the necessary documentation will be provided in a timely manner. Cash prizes for international participants will be disbursed at the cash desk of USUE on the day of award.
