## 1. General Provisions

1.1 These Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) regulate the organization and conduct of the International Student Article Competition "Modern Economic Theory and Social Development: Fundamental and Interdisciplinary Research" (hereinafter referred to as the Competition).

1.2 The competition is held within the framework of the Congress of Economists and Financiers of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter referred to as the EEYF) and is implemented at the EEFM head office – at the Ural State University of Economics (hereinafter referred to as the USUE site); as well as at foreign and regional sites of the EEYF that selected this Competition.

The list of foreign and regional venues that have chosen this Competition is indicated on the Competition page of the Congress of Economists and Financiers on the EEYF website, as well as on the pages of the foreign/regional venues themselves on the EEYF website.

1.3 The organizer of the competition is the Ural State University of Economics (USUE), Department of Economic Theory and Applied Sociology.

1.4 Co-organizers of the Competition:

Universities-organizers of foreign and regional EEYF sites that have chosen this competition to be implemented on their sites.

1.5 Partners of the competition:

Institute of Economics of the Ural Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences;

Ural Branch of the Free Economic Society of Russia.

1.6 The purpose of the competition is to create an information platform for students to exchange opinions and experiences in solving economic problems from the perspective of various schools and trends, in particular, neoclassical economics and current trends in heterodox economic theory, to consider the prospects for the interaction of modern economics with the achievements of psychological, mathematical, and sociological sciences.

1.7 Objectives of the Competition:

attracting the attention of young people to the new requirements for specialists in the context of increasing complexity of scientific knowledge and the growing demand for interdisciplinary approaches to solving social problems;

Generalization of various areas of practical application of modern economic theory;

generalization of problems and development of recommendations on the possibility of using the theoretical provisions of modern economics in the analysis and evaluation of real socio-economic processes and phenomena.

## 2. Scientific directions (sections) of the Competition


The thematic Sections of the Competition are determined annually in accordance with the subject(s) EEYF and are published on the Competition page on the EEYF website ([www.eurasia-forum.ru](http://www.eurasia-forum.ru)).

Scientific articles for the 2025 Contest are sent in the following areas::

The history of economic studies: analysis of the works of economists, scientific trends (schools); the formation of economic thought in individual countries and regions; current trends and problems of modern economic theory;

Theory and methodology of economics: an overview of the essence of individual economic categories and patterns; development of models of economics (economic growth, consumer behavior,

equilibrium analysis, etc.); analysis of the advantages and disadvantages of individual theoretical concepts in modern economics;

Behavioral economics and economic psychology: research of models of behavioral economic theory, stages of its development; analysis of individual cognitive distortions; analysis of household financial behavior; analysis of the capital market based on the concepts of behavioral finance;

Economic sociology: concepts of analysis of socio-economic processes, development of the theory of sociological analysis; applied research on the socio-demographic characteristics of a modern Russian entrepreneur; analysis of the impact of demographic changes on the development of small and medium-sized businesses, analysis of socio-economic problems of society (poverty, income, welfare, wages, etc.); economic interests of various groups population;

Modern problems of economic systems development: theories of economic development, technological structures; the role of knowledge and the process of cognition in human activity and the formation of needs; value paradigm of development; philosophy of economy; Industry 5.0, digitalization of the economy; integration of production, science and education.

### 3. Terms of Participation in the Competition

3.1. Bachelor's, specialist's and Master's degree students studying in educational institutions in Russia and abroad under the age of 35 are invited to participate in the Competition (hereinafter referred to as Participants).

Articles prepared by young scientists, postgraduates and candidates of sciences, are not accepted for the competition. All participants submit applications through the main site of the EEYF –USUE.

3.2. Scientific articles can be submitted to the Competition only from individual authors.

3.3. One participant has the right to submit only one article to the Contest.

3.4. The author of the article independently decides on which scientific field of the Competition the work will be presented.

3.5. Articles by participants that do not meet the requirements of clause 5 of these Regulations will not be accepted for participation in the Competition.

3.6. There is no registration fee for participation in the Contest. The costs of accommodation for nonresident participants, meals and transportation costs for participation in the face-to-face stage of the competition are paid by the participants themselves or by the sending organizations. The exception is the winners of foreign/regional Competition sites.


### 4. Procedure and Schedule of the Competition

4.1. The competition is an annual event and is held during the summer semester. The final dates of the Competition, as well as its main stages, are set by order of the Chairman of the EEYF Organizing Committee, the Rector of USUE and are published on the pages of the Competition on the EEYF website.

4.2. The competition is held in three stages.

4.2.1. The first stage (up to and including March 20, 2026) is the acceptance and registration of competitive research works; verification of works for compliance with the requirements for the work.

The first stage is conducted by the organizing committees of the Competition of the respective sites:

- the Organizing Committee of the USUE head site Competition;
- the organizing committees of the foreign/regional sites Competition.

If less than 10 competitive works have been submitted to a foreign/regional site, then the Competition at this site is considered to have failed, and the received works participate in the competition of the USUE head site on a general basis.

4.2.2. The second stage (qualifying) (from March 21 to April 1, 2026) is the examination of competitive research papers registered and admitted to the Competition based on the results of the first stage. Determination of the finalists of the Competition from the USUE site and the finalists of the Competition from foreign / regional sites.

- Conducting the qualifying stage at the USUE site

The examination of the competitive works received through the USUE site is carried out by the expert commission of the USUE Site Competition. The Commission selects from 10 to 15 finalists in absentia. The final number of finalists from the USUE site depends on the actual number of finalists from foreign/regional Competition sites. The lists of finalists who qualified for the final of the Competition are published on the Competition page of the Congress of Economists and Financiers on the EEF website.

- Conducting qualifying stages at foreign/regional Competition venues

The examination of competitive works at the sites of the EEYF is carried out by expert commissions of foreign/ regional Competition sites. Expert commissions select 5-10 best participants of the national/regional round of the Competition. On April 1, 2026, the organizing Committee and the expert commission of the foreign/regional Competition site will conduct an in-person defense of the selected works and determine the winner and prize-winners of the national/regional round of the Competition.

The winner (first place) of the national/regional round of the Competition becomes a finalist in the international final of the Competition. He is given the opportunity to participate in the final of the Competition and other final events of the XVI EEYF on April 22-23, 2026 in person. The main organizer of the EEYF, USUE, provides payment for travel and accommodation.

On April 23, 2026, certificates and memorable gifts will be solemnly presented to participants who took 2nd and 3rd place in the Competition at a foreign/regional venue.


The general list of finalists of the international final of the Competition is formed from the finalists from the USUE site and the winners of the foreign/regional sites that selected this Competition. The general list of finalists of the Competition is published on the EEYF website, on the page of the Competition of the Congress of Economists and Financiers from April 1 to April 10, 2026.

4.2.3. The third stage (final) (April 22-23, 2026) is the defense of competitive works (scientific articles) of the international final of the Competition; the determination of the winners of the Competition; awarding.

The third stage is held between the finalists of the international final of the Competition through a public face-to-face defense of the competition papers at a special meeting in the presence of members of the expert commission of this Competition. The protection of works remotely, using online communication, is carried out in coordination with the organizing committee of the Competition.

4.3. Following the results of the Competition, the main organizer of the EEYF publishes a collection of scientific articles by the finalists of the Competition.

## **5. Participant Registration, Requirements for Submitted Documentation, and Rules for Formatting Competition Works (Scientific Articles)**

5.1 Scientific articles are submitted to the Competition in one of the areas of the competition:

The history of economic studies: analysis of the works of economists, scientific trends (schools); the formation of economic thought in individual countries and regions; current trends and problems of modern economic theory;

Theory and methodology of economics: an overview of the essence of individual economic categories and patterns; development of models of economics (economic growth, consumer behavior, equilibrium analysis, etc.); analysis of the advantages and disadvantages of individual theoretical concepts in modern economics;

Behavioral economics and economic psychology: research of models of behavioral economic theory, stages of its development; analysis of individual cognitive distortions; analysis of household financial behavior; analysis of the capital market based on the concepts of behavioral finance;

Economic sociology: concepts of analysis of socio-economic processes, development of the theory of sociological analysis; applied research on the socio-demographic characteristics of a modern Russian entrepreneur; analysis of the impact of demographic changes on the development of small and medium-sized businesses, analysis of socio-economic problems of society (poverty, income, welfare, wages, etc.); economic interests of various groups population;

Modern problems of economic systems development: theories of economic development, technological structures; the role of knowledge and the process of cognition in human activity and the formation of needs; value paradigm of development; philosophy of economy; Industry 5.0, digitalization of the economy; integration of production, science and education.

The Competition papers (scientific articles) are submitted to the Organizing Committee of the Competition in electronic form through a special registration form on the EEYF website. [www.eurasia-forum.ru](http://www.eurasia-forum.ru):

– participants of the main site of the Competition choose at registration: The USUE site – The Congress of Economists and Financiers – the competition "Modern Economic Theory and Development of Society: fundamental and interdisciplinary research";

– participants of foreign/ regional sites choose at registration: The name of the corresponding site – the competition "Modern Economic theory and Development of Society: fundamental and interdisciplinary research"

5.2. The following set of documents must be submitted to participate in the Competition:

1) the author's application for participation in the Competition (Appendix 1) is submitted by filling out the participant registration form on the EEYF website;


2) the competition paper (scientific article), designed in accordance with the requirements of Appendix 2, is attached as a separate file to the registration form of the participant.;

5.3. All documents must be submitted in a single package by March 20, 2026, or another one specified on the Competition page of the EEYF website.

The absence of any of the documents specified in clause 5.2., within the prescribed period, is the basis for refusal of admission to participate in the Competition.

5.4. The competitive work must meet the following requirements:

1) the scientific article must correspond to the issues of the Competition and its thematic areas corresponding to section 2 of the Regulations.;

2) a scientific article must have a reference device: references to sources from which citations are used, numerical data in the text, tables, graphs, diagrams, a list of references (at least 5 sources);

3) the scientific article must be author's, the percentage of originality of the text must be at least 70%;

4) the work should be designed as follows: a file in \*.doc or \*.rtf format, the last name of the author(s) should be indicated in the file name; 1.5 line spacing on A4 sheets, Times New Roman font, size – 14 pt, margins – 20 mm on each side; sheet orientation – bookstore. The text should be aligned in width without hyphenation. The length of the article is no more than 5 pages.

All diagrams and tables must be inserted into the text. The list of references (bibliographic list) is drawn up in accordance with GOST R 7.0.100–2018. Footnotes to the text are given in square brackets indicating the number of the source in the list of references.

The standard structure of the work (scientific article): introduction; purpose of the study; brief literary review; research methods; research results; conclusions; references.

The initials and surname of the author should be printed at the top of the page in the center. The full name of the university (organization) is indicated in the next line, followed by the city. Below, in the middle of the line, the title is indicated, followed by an abstract (at least 3 sentences) and keywords (no more than 5 words and phrases). Next is the text of the scientific article. The initials and surname of the supervisor, his academic degree and academic title are indicated at the end of the article.

## 6. Criteria for Evaluating Competition Works (Articles)

6.1. At the first stage of the Competition, the expert commission of the Competition admits the competitive works (scientific articles) to participate in the qualifying round in accordance with the requirements specified in clause 5 of the Regulations.

6.2. Criteria for evaluating competitive works at the second (qualifying) stage:

1) registration of the work – up to 10 points;

2) relevance of the research topic – up to 15 points;

3) novelty and originality of the research – up to 15 points;


4) the content of the research: scientific, technical and economic validity of the proposed solutions; logical, scientific style and literacy of presentation; availability of appendices, illustrations, graphic explanations of appropriate quality – up to 40 points;

5) the practical significance of the research results, the possibility of testing and implementing the results obtained; for theoretical articles – the presence of a scientific result – 20 points.

The lists of finalists are displayed on the Contest page. Information letters about reaching the finals are sent to the finalist participants.

If the finalist cannot personally participate in the final of the Competition, he is given the opportunity to publicly defend the competition work remotely, in the form of a webinar. If the finalist cannot participate in the final of the Competition remotely, the participant who took the 16th place according to the results of the second (qualifying) stage of the Competition will be entered into the finalists.

6.3. Criteria for evaluating participants during the face-to-face defense of a competitive paper (scientific article) at the third (final) stage:

- 1) relevance of the research topic - up to 15 points;
- 2) novelty and originality of the research – up to 15 points;
- 3) significance of the research results – up to 20 points;
- 4) presentation – up to 20 points;
- 5) protection (answers to expert questions) – up to 30 points.

6.4. If the winners and prize-winners of the Competition have the same number of points, the decision on determining the winners and prize-winners is made by the expert commission of the Competition.

## 7. Awarding the winners

7.1. Based on the results of the international final of the Competition, the winners and prize-winners of the Competition as a whole are determined, they are awarded with Diplomas of I, II, III degrees and the grand Orders of the Star of Eurasia for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, respectively.

The participants who took the 4th and 5th places of the Competition are awarded with Diplomas for the 4th and 5th places, respectively.

All participants in the final of the Competition receive certificates of the finalists of the Competition in electronic form.

7.2. The winners and prize-winners (2nd and 3rd place) of the international final of the Competition are awarded with cash prizes within the framework of the prize fund of the Competition, established on the basis of the order of the Rector of USUE and in accordance with the minutes of meetings of the expert commissions of the Competition.

Cash prizes (including income tax) are transferred by the organizer of the Contest within 1.5 months to the personal accounts of the winners and prize-winners according to the details provided to the coordinator of the Contest, provided copies (scans) of the following documents are provided:

- printout from the bank's personal account: bank details and personal account number for money transfer;
- a copy of the passport of the 1st and 2nd pages and the registration page;
- a copy of the INN or a printout of the INN data from the website.


Cash prizes for foreign participants participating in the final face-to-face are given at the cash desk of USUE on the day of awarding.

7.3. Participants who take 1st, 2nd and 3rd place at a foreign/ regional venue are awarded with diplomas for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in the national / regional round and the small orders of the "Star of Eurasia".

7.4. The awarding of all finalists of the Competition will take place within the framework of the final events of the XVI EEYF on April 23, 2026 simultaneously at the USUE site and at foreign / regional sites of the Competition via online communication.

## 8. Management of the Competition at the Ural State University of Economics Venue

8.1. The Competition is managed by the EEYF Organizing Committee and the Competition Organizing Committee.

8.2. Chairman of the EEYF Organizing Committee - Rector of USUE:

- approves the Regulations on the Competition, signs the order on the conduct of the Competition and the composition of the organizing committee of the Competition, the order on the composition of the expert commission of the Competition;
- carries out the general management of the organization and conduct of the EEYF events within which the Competition is held.

8.3. The organizing committee of the Competition is formed to organize and conduct the Competition, consisting of:

- Scientific director of the Competition;
- coordinator of the Competition;
- members of the expert committee of the Competition;
- representatives of the partner organizations of the Competition,
- the secretary(s) of the Competition.

8.4. Scientific Director of the Competition:

- prepares the draft Regulations on the Competition, prepares amendments and additions to it;
- is the chairman (co-chairman) of the expert commission of the Competition;
- selects the composition of the expert commission of the Competition.

8.5. The Coordinator of the Competition:


- ensures the invitation of the members of the expert commission of the Competition;
- organizes the distribution of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and Eurasian countries;
- organizes registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of the compliance of the received tender documents with the established requirements, sends the competitive work to the members of the expert commissions for evaluation;
- organizes and monitors the progress of the Competition;
- organizes the work of the expert commission during the international final of the Competition;
- organizes the registration of diplomas, certificates and awarding of winners and prize-winners of the Competition;
- organizes the collection of abstracts of competitive works by the finalists of the Competition and their transfer to the USUE Publishing House for inclusion in the collection of EEYF materials;
- organizes the collection of necessary documents for the issuance of cash prizes to the winners and prize-winners of the Competition;
- draws up a report on the Competition.

8.6. An expert commission of the Competition is established to conduct an expert assessment of the competitive works.

The Chairman of the expert committee of the Competition is the Director of the EEYF Congress, which hosts the competition. The scientific director of the Competition is the co-chairman of the expert commission of the Competition. The expert commission consists of highly qualified teachers and researchers, leading experts from among the organizers of the EEYF, as well as invited experts. More than half of the members of the expert commission must be representatives of third-party organizations. The decisions of the expert commission are made by open voting, by a simple majority of the votes of the members of the expert commission present, are recorded, and the minutes are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendices 3, 4).

Information on the composition of the organizing committee and expert commissions of the Competition is published annually on the Competition page of the EEYF website.

## **9. Management of the Competition at International/Regional EEYF Venues**

9.1. The Competition is managed by the Organizing Committee of the foreign/regional EEYF site and the Organizing Committee of the EEYF Site Competition.

9.2. The Organizing Committee of the EEYF Site Competition includes:

- coordinator of the Competition;
- the expert commission of the Competition consisting of at least 3 people from among highly qualified pedagogical and scientific staff of the university-the organizer of the site, as well as invited experts.

- the secretary of the Competition.

9.3. The Coordinator of the Competition:

- ensures the invitation of the members of the expert commissions of the Competition;
- organizes the mailing of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations in their country or region of Russia;
- organizes registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of the compliance of the received competition documents with the established requirements, sends the competition papers to the members of the expert commissions for evaluation;
- organizes the work of expert commissions during the selection round of the Competition;
- together with the organizing committee of the USUE site, organizes the departure of the winner of the qualifying round of the Competition to USUE to participate in the international final of the Competition (1st place); as well as the participation of the contestants who took 2nd and 3rd place in the awarding procedure on April 25, 2025 at their site of the Competition;
- organizes the transfer of the thesis of the winner of the national/regional round of the Competition to the coordinator of the USUE Competition site for inclusion in the collection of materials of the EEFM.

9.4. An expert commission of the foreign/regional Competition site is created to conduct an expert assessment of the competitive works.

The composition of the expert foreign/regional commission of the Competition is approved by the organizing committee of the foreign/regional venue. The expert commission includes highly qualified teaching and research staff, leading experts from among the organizers of the EEYF site, as well as invited experts. The decisions of the expert commission are made by open voting, by a simple majority of the votes of the members of the expert commission present, are recorded, and the minutes are signed by the chairman, secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendix 4).

## Requirements for the preparation of abstracts of competitive works

The competition work must be accompanied by abstracts in which it is necessary to indicate main provisions and results of the work. Abstracts ***should not exceed 3 pages***.

***entitled with the author's last name***, are accepted for consideration. A4 format. Times font New Roman, font size 14 pt, line spacing – one and a half. All margins are 20 mm. The text is aligned in width with automatic hyphenation. Sheet orientation is portrait. Paragraph indent – 1.25. All charts and tables must be inserted into the text. The list of references is drawn up in accordance with GOST. Footnotes to the text are given in square brackets indicating the source number in the list of references.

The author's initials and surname should be printed at the top center of the page. The next line indicates the full name of the university (organization), then the city. 
