## **1. General Provisions**

1.1. These Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) regulate the organization and conduct of the International Online Olympiad "Accounting and Analytical Theory and Practice in Digital Transformation" (hereinafter referred to as the Olympiad).

1.2. The Olympiad is held within the framework of the Congress of Economists and Financiers of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter referred to as the EEYF) and is implemented at the EEYF's parent site, Ural State University of Economics (hereinafter referred to as the USUE site); as well as at foreign and regional sites of the EEYF that have chosen this Olympiad.

The list of foreign and regional venues that have chosen this Olympiad is indicated on the Olympiad page of the Congress of Economists and Financiers on the EEYF website, as well as on the pages of the foreign and regional venues themselves on the EEYF website.

1.3. Organizer of the Olympiad:

Ural State University of Economics (USUE), Institute of Economics and Finance, Department of Accounting and Auditing.

1.4. Co-organizers of the Olympiad:

Foreign and regional EEYF sites that have chosen this Olympiad to be implemented on their sites.

1.4. Partners of the Olympiad:

- Auditing company "Trust Technologies"
- Ural branch of the Free Economic Society of Russia, Yekaterinburg.

1.5. The purpose of the Olympiad is to improve the quality of students' professional training, further improve their professional competence, and create a competitive environment that promotes the development of participants' potential in the professional field.

1.6. The objectives of the Olympiad

are to stimulate young people to new ideas, proposals, and dialogue between countries and peoples.;

- to stimulate the interest of young people in the economic processes taking place in the world;
- contribute to the formation of motivation to acquire systematic knowledge in the field of accounting and analytical support.

## **2. Thematic directions of the Olympiad**

All tasks of the Olympiad provide assessment of professional competencies in the following disciplines: "Accounting Theory", "Organization Economics", "Digitalization of Accounting", "Taxes and Taxation", "Economic Analysis", "Legal Reference Systems in Economics", etc.

## **3. Conditions of participation in the Olympiad, registration of participants**

3.1. Students (undergraduates, postgraduates) and persons interested in modern trends in the field of digitalization of accounting and analytical support under the age of 35 (hereinafter referred to as Participants) are invited to participate in the Olympiad.

3.2. Participation in the Olympiad is individual and remote, on the Internet.

3.3. Applications for participation in the Olympiad are accepted through the registration system of the EEFM website [www.eurasia-forum.ru](http://www.eurasia-forum.ru). The application form is listed in Appendix 1.

Participants, representatives of foreign/ regional venues of the Olympiad, choose the appropriate venue when registering for participation in the Olympiad, all other participants choose the USUE site.

3.4. Applications for participation are submitted within the time period specified on the Olympiad page of the EEFM website.

3.5. There is no registration fee for participation in the Olympiad.

#### **4. Stages and timing of the Olympiad**

4.1. The Olympiad is an annual event and is held during the summer semester. The final dates of the Olympiad, as well as its main stages, are set by order of the Chairman of the EEYF Organizing Committee, the Rector of USUE, and are published on the pages of the Olympiad on the EEYF website.

4.2. The Olympiad is held in three stages.

4.2.1. The first stage (up to and including April 1, 2026) is the registration of participants and verification of compliance with the requirements for participants in the Olympiad (Section 3 of these Regulations).

The first stage is conducted by the organizing committees of the Olympiad (USUE sites and foreign/regional sites that have chosen this Olympiad) within the time limits set by the Directorate of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum and published on the EEYF website.

4.2.2. The second (preparatory) stage (from April 1 to April 10, 2026) – the address of the specialized Olympiad website and instructions for completing tasks are sent to the e-mail addresses of all Olympiad participants indicated during registration on the EEYF website.

Information letters are sent by the organizing committees of the site where the participant is registered.

There is no qualifying round for the participants of this Olympiad. All participants who meet the requirements of Section 3 of these Regulations participate in the final of the Olympiad.

4.2.3 The third (final) stage (April 22, 2026) is conducted remotely, on the main competition day of the EEFM, in the form of testing performed by participants on the specialized website of the Olympiad. Access to the tasks opens. The test task completion time is 40 minutes. The number of questions is 30. The number of attempts is 1.

According to the test results, the winner and prize-winners of the Olympiad are determined, who took the first, second and third places respectively in terms of the number of points scored, as well as the participants who took the 4th and 5th places of the International Online Olympiad as a whole.

At the same time, the winners and prize-winners of each foreign/regional Olympiad site are determined. They are determined by the number of points scored among the participants of the site.

On April 23, 2026, the winners and prize-winners of the Olympiad as a whole and the qualifying rounds of foreign/regional venues will be awarded in person.. The simultaneous award ceremony is broadcast via video conferencing.

## **5. Procedure for conducting the final stage and criteria for evaluating participants' olympiad assignments.**

5.1. For the final of the Olympiad, the scientific supervisors of the Olympiad prepare test tasks on the theory and practice of accounting and analytical support in the context of digital transformation.

5.2. The number of questions is 30. The number of test attempts is 1. The correctness of the answers to the test questions is evaluated. 1 point is given for the correct answer to each question, the maximum number of points is 30. If the same number of points is scored, the time to complete the test will be taken into account; the participant who completes the test faster will have priority.

5.3. All assignments provide for an assessment of the performance of professional competencies in the following disciplines: "Accounting Theory", "Organizational Economics", "Digitalization of Accounting", "Taxes and Taxation", "Economic Analysis", "Legal reference systems in Economics", etc

5.4. To conduct an expert assessment of the test results of participants An expert commission of the Olympiad is being created. All decisions of the expert commission are recorded and signed by the Chairman, members and secretary of the expert commission (Appendix 2).

5.5. The list of participants who took 1st to 5th places in the overall standings of the Olympiad and participants who took 1st to 3rd places within the same venue are published on the pages of the Olympiad on the EYF website. Information letters on the results of the Olympiad are sent by e-mail to the participants.

## **6. Awarding the winners**

6.1. According to the results of the final round, the winner and prize-winners of the Olympiad are determined. They are awarded Diplomas of I, II, III degrees and the grand Orders of the Star of Eurasia for 1,2 and 3rd place, respectively. The participants who took the 4th and 5th places are also determined. They are awarded with diplomas for 4th and 5th places.

All participants of the Olympiad who have scored more than 50% of the correct answers to the Olympiad tasks receive electronic certificates of participants of the Olympiad.

Additionally, among the participants who participated through foreign/regional platforms, 1st to 3rd places of foreign/regional platforms are determined. They are awarded with diplomas for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places at the respective Olympic venues, as well as commemorative small orders of the Star of Eurasia

6.2. The winner and prize-winners (2nd and 3rd place) of the final round of the Olympiad are awarded with cash prizes within the framework of the Olympiad prize fund established by the order of the USUE Rector and in accordance with the protocol of the Olympiad Expert commission.

Cash prizes (including income tax) are transferred by the organizer of the Olympiad within 1.5 months to the personal accounts of the winner and prize-winners according to the details

provided to the coordinator of the Olympiad, provided that the following documents are submitted to the organizer of the competition:

- printout from the personal account of the bank: bank details and personal account number, for the transfer of money;
- a copy of the passport of the 1st, 2nd page and the registration page;
- a copy of the INN or a printout of the INN data from the website.

Cash prizes for foreign participants participating in the finals via online communication are transferred to the banking details of the bank, which is a partner bank of the Russian bank.

6.3. The awarding of all the finalists of the Olympiad will take place within the framework of the final events of the XVI EEYF on April 23, 2026 simultaneously at the USUE site and at foreign/regional venues of the Olympiad via offline communication.

## **8. 7. Management of the Competition on the USUE site**

7.1. The Olympiad is managed by the EEYF Organizing Committee and the Olympiad Organizing Committee.

7.2. Chairman of the EEYF Organizing Committee, Rector of USUE:

- approves the Regulations on the Olympiad, signs the order on the holding of the Olympiad and the composition of the Organizing committee of the Olympiad, the order on the composition of the expert commission;
- carries out general management of the organization and conduct of EEYF events, within which the Olympiad is held.

7.3. For the organization and holding of the Olympiad, the Organizing committee of the Olympiad is formed, which includes:

- scientific supervisor(s) of the Olympiad;
- coordinator of the Olympiad;
- members of the Olympiad Expert Committee;
- representatives of the partner organizations of the Olympiad,
- the Secretary of the Olympiad.

7.4. Scientific Supervisor(s) of the Olympiad:

- prepares draft Regulations on the Olympiad, amendments and additions to it;
- is the Chairman (co-chairman) of the expert commission of the Olympiad;
- selects the composition of the expert commission of the Olympiad;
- prepares Olympiad test tasks.

7.5. The Olympiad Coordinator:

- ensures the invitation of the members of the Olympiad Expert Committee;
- organizes the mailing of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and the countries of Eurasia;
- organizes registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of compliance of received applications with the established requirements;
- organizes and monitors the progress of the Olympiad;
- organizes the registration of diplomas and certificates; awarding of winners and prize-winners of the Olympiad;

– organizes the collection of necessary documents for the issuance of cash prizes to the winners and prize-winners of the Olympiad;

– draws up a report on the Olympiad.

7.6. An expert commission is established to conduct an expert assessment of the test results of the participants.

The Chairman of the Olympiad Expert Commission is the Director of the EEYF Congress, which hosts the Olympiad. The expert commission consists of highly qualified representatives of the scientific and business community; Russian and foreign experts in the field of accounting and analytical support in the context of digital transformation from higher educational institutions of the Russian Federation, academic science, audit companies; business practitioners. More than half of the members of the expert commission must be representatives of third-party organizations.

The expert commission may also include representatives of the co-organizing countries that have chosen this Olympiad to be implemented at their foreign/regional venues.

All decisions of the expert commissions are recorded and signed by the Chairman (co-chairman), secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendix 2).

Information about the composition of the Organizing committee and the expert commission of the Olympiad is published annually on the Olympiad page of the EEYF website.

## 8. Management of the Olympiad at foreign/regional sites of the EEYF

8.1. The Olympiad is managed by the Organizing committee of the foreign/regional EEFM site and the coordinator of the Olympiad of the EEYF site.

8.2. Coordinator of the Olympiad at the EEYF site:

– organizes the mailing of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations of their country / region of Russia;

– organizes registration (through the registration system of the EEYF website) and verification of compliance of received applications with the established requirements;

– organizes participants who have applied to participate in the Olympiad through a foreign/regional platform to complete the final stage of the Olympiad remotely in a timely manner;

– sends information letters to the winners of the site, who took 1st to 3rd places among the participants of the site, about participation in the awarding procedure, which will take place on the territory of the main university of the site on April 23, 2026.




