1. General regulations

1.1. These Regulations on the International Olympiad "Expert" (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) regulate the procedure for organizing and conducting the International Olympiad "Expert" (hereinafter referred to as the Olympiad).

1.2. The Olympiad is held within the framework of the Congress of Management and Law of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum (hereinafter referred to as EEYF) and is implemented at the main site of EEYF - at the Ural State University of Economics (hereinafter referred to as the USUE site), as well as at foreign/regional sites that have chosen this Olympiad.

The list of foreign and regional venues that have chosen this Olympiad is indicated on the Olympiad page of the EEYF website, as well as on the pages of the foreign/regional venues themselves on the EEYF website.

1.3. Internet address of the EEYF website www.eurasia-forum.ru

1.4. Organizer of the Olympics:

Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education "Ural State University of Economics" (Ural State University of Economics), Department of Competition Law and Antimonopoly Regulation .

1.4. Co-organizers of the Olympics:

Universities-organizers of foreign and regional EEYF platforms that have chosen this competition for implementation at their sites.

1.5. Olympic partners:

- Office of the Federal antimonopoly services in Sverdlovsk regions;
- Department of the Federal Treasury for the Sverdlovsk Region;
- Ural branch of the Free Economic Society of Russia.

1.6. The purpose of the Olympiad is to identify and develop young people's creative abilities and interest in research work, as well as the formation of professional competencies in the field of analytical and expert-analytical activities.

1.7. Objectives of the Olympics:

- identification of talented youth, development of participants' creative approaches to solving non-standard problem problems and interest in research work;
- stimulating young people to new ideas, proposals, dialogue in various communicative situations, promoting scientific knowledge;
- developing the ability to evaluate decisions made within the framework of analytical and expert activities;
- creating conditions for the development of human resources in expert-analytical, research, administrative, managerial and entrepreneurial activities.

2. Conditions for participation in the Olympics, Registration of participants

2.1. Bachelor's, specialist's and master's students from universities in Russia and foreign countries, as well as employees of interested organizations under the age of 35 (hereinafter referred to as Participants) are invited to participate in the Olympiad.

2.2. Only individual participation is allowed in the Olympics.

2.2.1. Applications for participation in the Olympiad are submitted **until March 20, 2026** through the website registration system (Appendix 1).

Participants of the Olympiad, representatives of foreign/regional venues, when registering, first select their venue, and then the name of the Olympiad.

2.3. There is no registration fee for participation in the Olympics. Expenses for accommodation of non-resident participants, food and transportation expenses for participation in the full-time stage of the Olympics are paid by the participants themselves or by sending organizations. The exception is the winners of foreign/regional Olympic venues.

3. Stages and timing of the Olympics

3.1. The Olympics is an annual event. The specific dates for the Olympics, as well as its main stages, are established by order of the rector of the Ural State University of Economics (Ural State University of Economics).

3.2. The Olympics are held in three stages.

3.2.1. **The first stage is registration of participants (until March 20, 2026 inclusive)** and verification of compliance with the requirements for participants in the Olympiad (Section 2 of these Regulations).

The first stage is carried out by the organizing committee of the Olympiad within the time frame established by the directorate of the Eurasian Economic Youth Forum and published on the EEYF website.

After registering on the EEYF website, the participant is sent a login and password for access to the specialized resource of the Olympiad, as well as instructions for working with tasks, to the email address he specified.

3.2.2. **The second stage is (qualifying round).** It is carried out remotely in the form of solving cases and writing detailed answers on a specialized Olympiad resource **from March 21 to March 31, 2026.**

The task completion time is 90 minutes. Number of cases – 10. Number of attempts to pass – 1.

– Conducting the qualifying round at the USUE site

Examination of completed tasks on a specialized Olympiad resource. Conducted by the expert commission of the Olympics at the USUE site. The commission selects **from 15 to 20** finalists in absentia . The final number of finalists from the USUE site depends on the actual number of finalists from foreign/regional Olympic sites. Lists of finalists who made it to the finals of the Olympiad are published on the Olympiad page of the EEYF Congress of Management and Law.

– Conducting qualifying stages at foreign/regional Olympic venues

Examination of completed tasks on a specialized Olympiad resource. The examination is carried out by expert commissions of foreign/regional Olympic sites together with the expert commission of the

USUE site. Expert commissions select participants who took 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in the national/regional round of the Olympics. Lists of winners and runners-up are published on the pages of the relevant Olympiad sites on the EEYF website.

The participant who takes 1st place in the qualifying round of the Olympics is given the opportunity to participate **in the international finals of the Olympics in person (April 22-23, 2026)**. Payment for travel and accommodation of the winner of the qualifying round is provided by the main organizer of the EEYF - USUE.

Participants who took 2nd and 3rd place will be solemnly presented with certificates and memorable gifts at a foreign/regional site **on April 23, 2026**.

The general list of finalists of the international finals of the Olympiad is formed from the finalists from the USUE site and the winners of foreign/regional sites that chose this Olympiad. The general list of finalists of the Olympiad is published on the EEYF website, on the Olympiad page of the Congress of Management and Law.

3.3. The third stage - (final round) is held in person at USUE on April 22, 2026. Work in the finals takes place in teams of 2 or 3 people, which are formed by drawing lots among the participants present. As a result of the work, the winning teams and medal teams of the Olympics are determined. Participation in the finals of the Olympiad is held in person at the USUE site.

4. Final procedure and evaluation criteria

4.1. The third (final) round of the Olympics includes:

4.1.1. Testing on issues of legal regulation of the fundamentals of expert activity in the Russian Federation. Number of questions – 10. Number of attempts to pass the test – 1.

The correctness of answers to test questions is assessed. 1 point is given for the correct answer to each question, the maximum number of points is 10.

4.1.2. Solving cases on issues of law enforcement in relation to the regulation of competition issues, monopolies, and the implementation of economic rights of citizens.

The correctness of the choice of legal acts to resolve the incident, the level of analysis of the experience of current law enforcement practice, international experience in solving similar problems, and the validity of the conclusions made are assessed. The maximum number of points is 20.

4.1.3. Analysis of the legal act and proposals for introducing current changes.

The relevance of proposed changes to legislation is assessed in accordance with current legal and political realities, the evidence base, and the quality of presentation of the project. The maximum number of points is 20.

4.2. Based on the sum of points for all three tasks, the expert commission determines the winning team and the Olympic medal teams.

4.3. If the number of points scored by the participants in the Olympiad is equal, the decision to recognize the winner and medalists of the Olympiad is made at the discretion of the expert commission.

5. Winner's reward ceremony

5.1. Based on the results of the final round, the winner and medalists of the Olympics are determined. They are awarded Diplomas of 1st, 2nd, 3rd degree and the Order of the "Star of Eurasia" for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, respectively.

All participants in the final round receive certificates of Olympic finalists in electronic form.

5.2. Winners and runners-up (1st, 2nd and 3rd place) of the Olympiad are awarded cash prizes within the framework of the Olympiad prize fund, established on the basis of the order of the rector of USUE and in accordance with the protocol of the Olympiad expert commission.

Cash prizes (including payment of income tax) are transferred by the Competition organizer within 1.5 months to the personal accounts of winners and prize-winners using the details provided to the Competition coordinator, subject to the submission of the following documents to the Competition organizer:

- printout from the bank's personal account: bank details and personal account number for transferring money;
- a copy of the passport page 1, 2 and page with registration;
- a copy of the TIN or a printout of the TIN data from the website.

The amount of the cash prize is published on the Olympiad page of the EEYF website and is divided among all team members in equal shares.

5.3. Cash prizes for foreign participants participating in the finals in person are issued at the USUE cash desk on the day of the award.

5.4. Participants who take 1st, 2nd and 3rd place at a foreign/regional site are awarded certificates for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in the national/regional round and small orders "Star of Eurasia".

5.5. The awarding of all finalists of the Olympiad will take place as part of the final events of the XVI EEYF **on April 23, 2026** simultaneously at the USUE site and at foreign/regional sites of the Competition using online communication.

6. Managing the Olympics

6.1. The Olympiad is managed by the EEYF Directorate and the Olympiad Organizing Committee.

6.2. To organize and conduct the Olympiad, an Organizing Committee is formed, approved by order of the rector of USUE. The Organizing Committee includes:

– Chairman of the EEYF;

– co-chairman of the EEYF;

Members of the organizing committee:

– scientific director of the Olympics;

– coordinator(s) of the Olympics;

– Chairman and members of the Olympic expert commission;

– representatives of Olympic partner organizations,

- Secretary of the Olympics.

6.3. The Organizing Committee provides general management of the organization and conduct of the Olympics.

6.3.1. Chairman of the organizing committee:

– approves the Regulations on the Olympics, signs the order on holding the Olympics and the composition of the organizing committee of the Olympics, the order on the composition of the expert commission;

– carries out general management of the organization and conduct of EEF events, within the framework of which the Olympiad is held.

6.3.2. Co-chairman of the organizing committee:

– carries out direct management of the organization and conduct of the EEYF, together with the scientific director of the Olympiad, forms the composition of the expert commission of the Olympiad.

6.3.3. An expert commission is created to conduct an expert assessment of the teams.

The chairman of the expert commission of the Olympiad is the director of the EEF Congress, where the Olympiad is taking place. The expert commission includes highly qualified representatives of the scientific and business community; Russian and foreign experts in the field of jurisprudence, economics, expert activity and business analysis from higher educational institutions of the Russian Federation, countries of the near and far abroad, academic science, business practitioners. More than half of the members of the expert commission must be representatives of third-party organizations.

All decisions of the expert commissions are recorded and signed by the chairman (co-chairman), secretary and members of the expert commission (Appendix 2, 3, 4).

6.3.4. Scientific director of the Olympics:

– prepares a draft Regulation on the Competition and submits it to the rector for approval, prepares changes and additions to it;

– is a co-chairman of the Olympic expert commission;

– selects the composition of the Olympic expert commission;

– approves the assignments for the Olympiad participants from the chairman of the expert commission.

6.3.5. Competition Coordinator(s):

– ensures the invitation of members of the Olympiad expert commission;

– organizes the distribution of information letters to educational, research and scientific organizations of the Russian Federation and foreign countries;

– ensures the operation of a specialized resource for conducting the qualifying round of the Olympics;

– organizes the final and the work of the expert commission during the final of the Olympiad;

– organizes the registration of diplomas and awarding of the winners and prize-winners of the Olympics;

– compiles a report on the Olympics.

6.4. Information on the composition of the organizing committee and expert commission of the Olympiad is published annually on the Olympiad page of the EEYF website.
